Fifth Sunday of Easter

May 7, 2023

Dear Parishioners,

As we begin the month of May this weekend, we honor our Blessed Mother. Devotion to our Blessed Mother helps us with our devotion to her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. First, **devotion to Mary can help us remain together as one.** During the days between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost, Mary was in the Upper Room with the Apostles, waiting for the Promise of the Father - the Holy Spirit. She kept them together as a group. When we pray the Rosary together - in the church as a parish family, or at home with our family and friends, we are inviting the Blessed Mother to keep us united as one. **Second, devotion to Mary protects us from the devil.** The devil does not like Mary. In the first Book of the Bible - the Book of Genesis, we read that there was enmity between Mary and the devil, between her offspring (all of us) and the devil. By praying the "Hail Mary" prayer frequently, or by simply asking Mary to be with us each day, we are protecting ourselves from the devil and his works. Devotion to Mary helps us avoid temptations and occasions of sin. **Third, devotion to Mary helps us remain consecrated in the truth, who is Jesus Christ.** God chose to become one of us in Jesus Christ, through Mary. Devotion to Mary always leads us to devotion to her Son Jesus. Mary only desires to lead us closer to Jesus. We have God as our Father, and we have Mary as our Mother. Mary is also an Image of the Church, as well as Spouse of the Holy Spirit. As we prepare during this Easter season for the great Feast of Pentecost (May 28), which is the Birthday of the Church, let us ask the Holy Spirit and our Blessed Mother to help us grow in our love for Jesus Christ. God Bless!

THE ONLY WAY HOME TO ABBA

“If you really knew Me, you would know My Father also.” —John 14:7

We have been created by and for God the Father. Our happiness will not be complete until we are home with our Father. Every person has a hole in his heart that only God the Father can fill.

However, all human beings have a fallen, wounded nature by which we are alienated from God the Father. This puts us in an impossible situation. We cannot relate properly to the very Person Whom we cannot live without. Consequently, we are cut off from life, love, joy, peace, hope, etc.

Considering our innate desire for God the Father and yet our alienation from Him, we are shocked and filled with joy to hear the words of Jesus: “I am the Way, and the Truth, and the Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me” (Jn 14:6). Jesus is the Way to the Father, because He “is the Reflection of the Father's glory, the exact Representation of the Father's being” (Heb 1:3). In fact, Jesus is in the Father and the Father is in Him (Jn 14:11). Therefore, to see Jesus is to see the Father (Jn 14:9).

Jesus is the Way to overcome our alienation from the Father. He is our Savior. In Jesus, we are not separated from the Father but baptized into Him (see Mt 28:19). Jesus is our Hope, our Life, our only Way to the Father.

Prayer: Abba, I live in You and for You.

Promise: “Do not let your hearts be troubled. Have faith in God and faith in Me.” —Jn 14:1

Praise: Praise the risen Jesus, Who died for His enemies and loves them with an everlasting love. Hosanna to the King of Love!


Presentation Ministries

Quinto Domingo de Pascua

Queridos feligreses,
Al comenzar el mes de mayo este fin de semana, honramos a nuestra Santísima Madre. La devoción a nuestra Santísima Madre nos ayuda con nuestra devoción a su Hijo, nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Primero, **la devoción a María puede ayudarnos a permanecer juntos como uno.** Durante los días entre el jueves de la Ascensión y Pentecostés, María estaba en el Cenáculo con los Apóstoles, esperando la Promesa del Padre, el Espíritu Santo. Ella los mantuvo juntos como un grupo. Cuando rezamos el Rosario juntos, en la iglesia como familia parroquial, o en casa con nuestra familia y amigos, estamos invitando a la Santísima Madre a mantenernos unidos como uno solo. Segundo, **la devoción a María nos protege del demonio.** Al diablo no le gusta María. En el primer Libro de la Biblia, el Libro del Génesis, leemos que había enemistad entre María y el diablo, entre su descendencia (todos nosotros) y el diablo. Al rezar con frecuencia la oración del "Ave María", o simplemente al pedirle a María que esté con nosotros todos los días, nos estamos protegiendo del diablo y sus obras. La devoción a María nos ayuda a evitar tentaciones y ocasiones de pecado. Tercero, **la devoción a María nos ayuda a permanecer consagrados en la verdad, que es Jesucristo.** Dios eligió hacerse uno de nosotros en Jesucristo, a través de María. La devoción a María nos lleva siempre a la devoción a su Hijo Jesús. María sólo desea acercarnos a Jesús. Tenemos a Dios como nuestro Padre, y tenemos a María como nuestra Madre. María es también Imagen de la Iglesia, así como Esposa del Espíritu Santo. Mientras nos preparamos durante este tiempo de Pascua para la gran Fiesta de Pentecostés (28 de Mayo), que es el Cumpleaños de la Iglesia, pidamos al

Espíritu Santo y nuestra Santísima Madre que nos ayuden a crecer en nuestro amor por Jesucristo. ¡Dios los bendiga!

LA TENTACIÓN DE HACER EL BIEN

“De esa manera, podremos dedicarnos a la oración y al ministerio de la Palabra” (Hechos 6:4).

“La Palabra de Dios no está encadenada” (2 Tim 2:9), sin embargo, los mensajeros de la Palabra de Dios si pueden ser encadenados. Frecuentemente somos encadenados por nuestros pecados, el egoísmo, o el miedo. Sin embargo, podemos ser encadenados en maneras muy sutiles. Por ejemplo, el demonio trató de encadenar a los apóstoles haciéndolos creer que necesitaban reducir sus oraciones y el ministerio de la Palabra para que en vez usaran su tiempo para tratar de solucionar con desacuerdos entre miembros de la iglesia antigua (Hch 6:2ss). Satanás los tentó convenciéndolos en que eran obras buenas y necesarias. Es más, satanás no les dijo que abandonaran por completo el ministerio de la Palabra, únicamente que suspendieran por un corto tiempo. Sin embargo, en cuanto nos desviamos, aunque sea un poco, de nuestro plan otorgado por Dios (aun si lo hacemos ejecutando buenas acciones), ya no estamos haciendo la voluntad de Dios. Cuando cedemos, aunque sea un centímetro, por un instante, ese centímetro se convierte en kilómetros que duran para siempre.

Por lo tanto:

- Haz las obras de Dios, no únicamente obras buenas (véase Lc 10:38-42).
- Haz nada menos que Su voluntad (véase Sal 143:10).
- No interrumpas o pospongas las obras de Dios. Hazlas ahora (véase 2 Co 6:2).
- No te canses de proclamar Su Palabra en todo momento (2 Tim 4:2).

Oración: Señor Padre, por Tu gracia viviré mi vocación por completo.

Promesa: “No se inquieten. Crean en Dios y crean también en Mí” (Jn 14:1).

Alabanza: Alabanza a Jesucristo resucitado, Quien murió por Sus enemigos y los ama con un amor eterno. ¡Hosanna al Rey del Amor!


