Dear Parishioners,

In our lives here on earth, there is **suffering**. The question is, “*what do we do with the suffering that comes our way?*” This is where we can look to the lives of the Saints. The Saints lived holy lives. When they sinned, they went to the Sacrament of Confession to have their sins forgiven. They loved to tell others about Jesus and our beautiful Catholic Faith. When they suffered, they offered their suffering to God. They also asked God to use their suffering for the salvation of others. One such example of this is **Saint John Paul II**, whose feast day is this weekend (October 22nd). Saint John Paul II was born in Krakow, Poland in 1920. When he was nine years old, his mother died. When he was twelve years old, his brother died, and when he was 20 years old, his father died. He had to study secretly to become a priest because of Hitler and Nazism. He was even hit by a Nazi truck and left to die on the road. He suffered through communism as well. Three years after he was elected Pope in 1981, he was shot by a terrorist, and almost died. In his later years, he suffered tremendously through Parkinson’s Disease. He also suffered a lot spiritually as Pope - suffering for the whole Church and the sins of her members. Through all of this suffering - his loved ones dying, Nazism and Communism, physical sufferings, and spiritual as well - John Paul II offered it all up to God, becoming a Saint himself, and example and for all of us to follow. May we be inspired by his life, use all of our sufferings to draw closer to the Lord and become future Saints as well. Saint John Paul II, pray for us! God Bless!



CLOUD-PIERCING PRAYER-POWER

"The prayer of the lowly pierces the clouds." —Sirach 35:17

Are you in a fog? Is your mind cloudy and confused? Do you feel as if there's heavy cloud-cover when you pray? Even if you are praying in the clouds, you can pierce the clouds, come out of the fog, and come into the light when you:

- serve God (Sir 35:16). Rejoice to be a slave of Jesus (Col 3:24) — to do His will, not yours.
- serve God willingly (Sir 35:16). Go beyond Sunday obligation and a minimalist, mediocre Christianity. "Everyone must give according to what he has inwardly decided; not sadly, not grudgingly, for God loves a cheerful giver" (2 Cor 9:7).
- become lowly (Sir 35:17). Repent of pharisaic arrogance (Lk 18:11), beat your breast, and pray: "O God, be merciful to me, a sinner" (Lk 18:13).

The lowly, willing servant of God has a love for God and a faith in Him that can shake and transform the world. The prayer of a servant of God "is powerful indeed" (Jas 5:16). Decide to become a lowly, willing servant of God. Pray with Mary: "I am the servant of the Lord. Let it be done to me as you say" (Lk 1:38).

Prayer: Father, do in me what You must in order to do through me what You will.

Promise: "I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. From now on a merited crown awaits me; on that Day the Lord, just Judge that He is, will award it to me — and not only to me, but to all who have looked for His appearing with eager longing." —2 Tm 4:7-8

Praise: "No one can come to Me unless the Father Who sent Me draws him; I will raise him up on the last day" (Jn 6:44). Alleluia! Thank You, risen Jesus.

30 Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

23 de Octubre 2022

Queridos feligreses,
En nuestras vidas aquí en la tierra, hay **sufrimiento**. La pregunta es, "*¿qué hacemos con el sufrimiento que se nos presenta?*" Aquí es donde podemos mirar la vida de los Santos. Los santos vivieron vidas santas. Cuando pecaron, acudieron al Sacramento de la Confesión para que les perdonaran sus pecados. Les encantaba contarles a otros acerca de Jesús y nuestra hermosa Fe Católica. Cuando sufrían, ofrecían su sufrimiento a Dios. También le pidieron a Dios que usara su sufrimiento para la salvación de otros. Un ejemplo de esto es **San Juan Pablo II**, cuya fiesta es este fin de semana (22 de octubre). San Juan Pablo II nació en Cracovia, Polonia en 1920. Cuando tenía nueve años, murió su madre. Cuando tenía doce años, murió su hermano, y cuando tenía 20 años, murió su padre. Tuvo que estudiar en secreto para convertirse en sacerdote debido a Hitler y al nazismo. Incluso fue atropellado por un camión nazi y dejado a morir en el camino. También sufrió a través del comunismo. Tres años después de haber sido elegido Papa en 1981, un terrorista le disparó y casi muere. En sus últimos años, sufrió tremadamente con la enfermedad de Parkinson. También sufrió mucho espiritualmente como Papa, sufriendo por toda la Iglesia y los pecados de sus miembros. A través de todo este sufrimiento - la muerte de sus seres queridos, el nazismo y el comunismo, los sufrimientos físicos y también espirituales - Juan Pablo II lo ofreció todo a Dios, convirtiéndose él mismo en un santo, un ejemplo y para que todos nosotros lo siguiéramos. Ruego que seamos inspirados por su vida, usemos todos nuestros sufrimientos para acercarnos más al Señor y convertirnos también en futuros santos. ¡San Juan Pablo II, ruega por nosotros! ¡Dios los bendiga!



He knew that he was a sinner and that he needed God's help. Do you think that God was pleased with the tax collector's prayer?

Being humble isn't a sad or bad thing. It means knowing that all the good things we have and do come from God. Being humble also lets us be sorry for the selfish things we have done, because it lets us admit that it was our own fault and God can help us overcome our selfishness.






