Dear Parishioners,

This Thursday, August 4th, is the Feast Day of Saint John Vianney, the patron Saint of parish priests. We have his statue in our church, near the door that leads to the bathrooms. Born in Lyons, France, in 1786, he heard the Lord calling him to the vocation to the priesthood as a young man. Once he entered the seminary, he struggled with his studies, specifically in learning Latin. Instead of giving up, he sought out help in private tutoring. He persevered through this difficulty and was ordained a priest. Fr. Vianney's first parish assignment was to a church in the little town of Ars, France. It was a very difficult assignment because the people had become indifferent and quite comfortable with their style of living. They didn't seem to want to grow in their relationship with the Lord. Through his preaching, his mortification, prayer and good works, Fr. Vianney won over the hearts of his parishioners, enkindling within them a desire to give themselves more to the Lord. In the winter months, he would hear Confessions for almost twelve hours a day, and during the summer months, he would be there for sixteen hours a day. He ate and slept very little, doing penance for his sins and for the sins of others. With the help of two women, he established a home for girls called "La Providence". Many people came back to the Lord through Saint John Vianney.

From "The Saint of the Day" publication:

"Indifference toward religion, coupled with a love for material comfort, seem to be common signs of our times. A person from another planet observing us would not likely judge us to be pilgrim people, on our way to somewhere else. John Vianney, on the other hand, was a man on a journey with his goal before him at all times." My brothers and sisters, let us always remember that we are a pilgrim people, on a journey to Heaven. Let us allow the Lord to work in our lives, making time for Him each day through prayer, through weekly reception of His Body and Blood at Mass, and frequent reception of His forgiveness in the Sacrament of Confession. May Saint John Vianney enkindle within each one of us the desire to grow in our relationship with the Lord, and may he intercede for all of us who are priests (especially Fr. Rowley and myself), that we may always be faithful in our vocations in serving you as the people God. God bless! Saint John Vianney, pray for us!

FOOL'S GOLD

"All things are vanity!" —Ecclesiastes 1:2

King Solomon, who is credited with writing the book of Ecclesiastes, was one of the richest people in history (see 1 Kgs 10:14ff). He had seven hundred wives and three hundred concubines (1 Kgs 11:3). He could get anything he wanted any time he wanted. Many people today are trying hard to become more like Solomon. They want to be able to relax "for years to come," "eat heartily, drink well," and enjoy themselves (Lk 12:19). Solomon, who ought to know, says they are fools (see Lk 12:20), for "all things are vanity!" (Eccl 1:2)

"What profit does he show who gains the whole world and destroys himself in the process?" (Lk 9:25) "You are not to spend what remains of your earthly life on human desires but on the will of God. Already you have devoted enough time to what the pagans enjoy" (1 Pt 4:2-3). Therefore, "set your heart on what pertains to higher realms where Christ is seated at God's right hand. Be intent on things above rather than on things of earth" (Col 3:1-2).

Prayer: Father, send the Holy Spirit to help me get in touch with reality.

Promise: "What you have done is put aside your old self with its past deeds and put on a new man, one who grows in knowledge as he is formed anew in the image of his Creator." —Col 3:9-10

Praise: "Praised be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, He Who in His great mercy gave us new birth; a birth unto hope which draws its life from the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead" (1 Pt 1:3). Alleluia!

Queridos feligreses,
Este jueves 4 de agosto es la festividad de **San Juan Vianney**, patrón de los párrocos. Tenemos una estatua de él en nuestra Iglesia, cerca de la puerta que conduce a los baños. Nacido en Lyon, Francia, en 1786, escuchó al Señor llamarlo a la vocación al sacerdocio cuando era joven. Una vez que ingresó al seminario, luchó con sus estudios, específicamente con el aprendizaje del latín. En lugar de darse por vencido, buscó ayuda en clases particulares. Perseveró a través de esta dificultad y fue ordenado sacerdote. Padre La primera asignación parroquial de Vianney fue a una iglesia en el pequeño pueblo de Ars, Francia. Fue una tarea muy difícil porque la gente se había vuelto indiferente y bastante cómoda con su estilo de vida. No parecían querer crecer en su relación con el Señor. A través de su predicación, su mortificación, oración y buenas obras, el Padre Vianney se ganó el corazón de sus feligreses, encendiendo en ellos el deseo de entregarse más al Señor. En los meses de invierno, escuchaba confesiones durante casi doce horas al día, y durante los meses de verano, estaba allí durante diecisésis horas al día. Comía y dormía muy poco, haciendo penitencia por sus pecados y por los pecados de los demás. Con la ayuda de dos mujeres, estableció un hogar para niñas llamado "La Providencia". Mucha gente volvió al Señor a través de San Juan Vianney. De la publicación "El santo del día": "*La indiferencia hacia la religión, junto con el amor por las comodidades materiales, parecen ser signos comunes de nuestro tiempo. Una persona de otro planeta que nos observe probablemente no nos juzgaría como peregrinos, en nuestro camino hacia otro lugar. Juan Vianney, por otro lado, era un hombre en un viaje con su meta por delante en todo momento*". Mis hermanos y hermanas, recordemos siempre que somos un pueblo peregrino, en camino al Cielo. Dejemos que el Señor obre en nuestras vidas, haciendo tiempo para Él cada día a través de la oración, a través de la recepción semanal de Su Cuerpo y Sangre en la Misa, y la recepción frecuente de Su perdón en el Sacramento de la Confesión. Que San Juan Vianney encienda en cada uno de nosotros el deseo de crecer en nuestra relación con el Señor, y que interceda por todos los que somos sacerdotes (especialmente por el Padre Rowley y por mí), para que seamos siempre fieles en nuestras vocaciones en servirte como el pueblo de Dios. ¡Dios les bendiga! *San Juan Vianney, ruega por nosotros!*



Jesus teaches us not to be greedy



In today's Gospel reading, a man tells Jesus that his brother is being unfair to him. But Jesus knows that the man is just being greedy, so He tells him the parable of the rich farmer. One year he had such a good harvest that he couldn't fit it all into his barns. He tore down his old barns and built new ones, so that he could store his food for many years. But just when he thought he would be able to rest and enjoy his food, God told him that he would die.

This parable is a warning against being greedy. Jesus is not saying that we should not save some food or that we shouldn't save our money. He is just telling us to remember that we are going to die one day, and then everything we saved is going to be useless for us. He wants us to use the things we have wisely, but not be too attached to them.




