Dear Parishioners,

This Thursday, August 4th, is the Feast Day of **Saint John Vianney**, the patron Saint of parish priests. We have his statue in our church, near the door that leads to the bathrooms. Born in Lyons, France, in 1786, he heard the Lord calling him to the vocation to the priesthood as a young man. Once he entered the seminary, he struggled with his studies, specifically in learning Latin. Instead of giving up, he sought out help in private tutoring. He persevered through this difficulty and was ordained a priest. Fr. Vianney's first parish assignment was to a church in the little town of Ars, France. It was a very difficult assignment because the people had become indifferent and quite comfortable with their style of living. They didn't seem to want to grow in their relationship with the Lord. Through his preaching, his mortification, prayer and good works, Fr. Vianney won over the hearts of his parishioners, enkindling within them a desire to give themselves more to the Lord. In the winter months, he would hear Confessions for almost twelve hours a day, and during the summer months, he would be there for sixteen hours a day. He ate and slept very little, doing penance for his sins and for the sins of others. With the help of two women, he established a home for girls called "La Providence". Many people came back to the Lord through Saint John Vianney. From "The Saint of the Day" publication: *"Indifference toward religion, coupled with a love for material comfort, seem to be common signs of our times. A person from another planet observing us would not likely judge us to be pilgrim people, on our way to somewhere else. John Vianney, on the other hand, was a man on a journey with his goal before him at all times."* My brothers and sisters, let us always remember that we are a pilgrim people, on a journey to Heaven. Let us allow the Lord to work in our lives, making time for Him each day through prayer, through weekly reception of His Body and Blood at Mass, and frequent reception of His forgiveness in the Sacrament of Confession.

May Saint John Vianney enkindle within each one of us the desire to grow in our relationship with the Lord, and may he intercede for all of us who are priests, that we may always be faithful in our vocations in serving you as the people God. God bless! *Saint John Vianney, pray for us!*

GOD'S VOMITING

“When he found one really valuable pearl, he went back and put up for sale all that he had and bought it.” - Matthew 13:46

Many people don't want to put all their eggs into one basket. So they become “Christians” but still keep one foot in the world. This way, if Jesus isn't real, at least they haven't wasted their whole lives for Him. They rationalize that if Jesus is the meaning of life, they're at least church members, without losing the “fun” of the world.

This is the most common approach to Christianity in America. It makes Jesus feel like throwing up (Rv 3:15-16). Jesus died on the cross for us. He poured out every drop of blood and breathed His last breath for us. As we kneel before the crucified Jesus, we realize that it is sacrilegious to give Him anything less than everything. The kingdom of God is like a buried treasure or a precious pearl (Mt 13:44-46). The cost of discipleship is everything. We may not have much, but we each have an “all” - and that all is what we must give.

The first commandment is: *“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind”* (Lk 10:27).

Prayer: Father, *“give Your servant, therefore, an understanding heart to judge Your people and to distinguish right from wrong”* (1 Kgs 3:9).

Promise: *“We know that God makes all things work together for the good of those who love”* Him. - Rm 8:28

Praise: Praise You, risen Jesus, *“The Way, and the Truth, and the Life”* (Jn 14:6).
Alleluia!

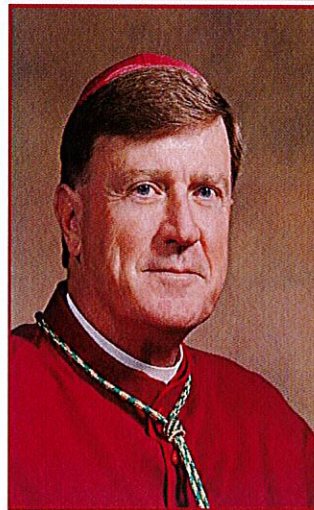
St. Theresa Shrine 100th Anniversary Celebration

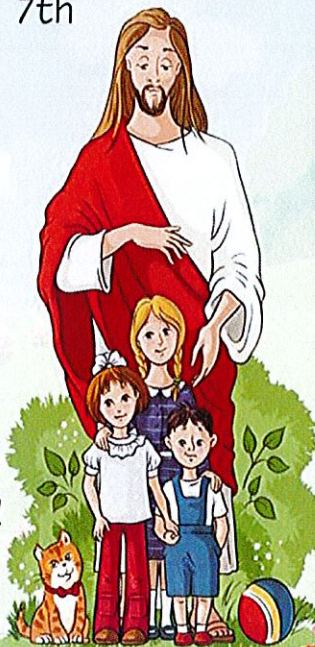

XVII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

30 de Julio, 2023

Queridos feligreses,

Este martes, 4 de Agosto es la Fiesta de **San Juan Vianney**, patrón de los párrocos. Tenemos una estatua de él en nuestra Iglesia, cerca de la puerta que conduce a los baños. Nacido en Lyon, Francia, en 1786, escuchó al Señor llamarlo a la vocación al sacerdocio cuando era joven. Una vez que ingresó al seminario, luchó con sus estudios, específicamente con el aprendizaje del latín. En lugar de darse por vencido, buscó ayuda en clases particulares. Perseveró a través de esta dificultad y fue ordenado sacerdote. Padre La primera asignación parroquial de Vianney fue a una iglesia en el pequeño pueblo de Ars, Francia. Fue una tarea muy difícil porque la gente se había vuelto indiferente y bastante cómoda con su estilo de vida. No parecían querer crecer en su relación con el Señor. A través de su predicación, su mortificación, oración y buenas obras, el Padre Vianney se ganó el corazón de sus feligreses, encendiendo en ellos el deseo de entregarse más al Señor. En los meses de invierno, escuchaba confesiones durante casi doce horas al día, y por dieciséis horas al día durante los meses de verano. Comía y dormía muy poco, haciendo penitencia por sus pecados y por los pecados de los demás. Con la ayuda de dos mujeres, estableció un hogar para niñas llamado "La Providencia". Mucha gente volvió al Señor a través de San Juan Vianney. De la publicación "El santo del día": *"La indiferencia hacia la religión, junto con el amor por las comodidades materiales, parecen ser signos comunes de nuestro tiempo. Una persona de otro planeta que nos observe probablemente no nos juzgaría como peregrinos, en nuestro camino hacia otro lugar. Juan Vianney, por otro lado, era un hombre en un viaje con su meta por delante en todo momento"*. Mis hermanos y hermanas, recordemos siempre que somos un pueblo peregrino, en camino al Cielo. Dejemos que el Señor obre en nuestras vidas, haciendo tiempo para Él cada día a través de la oración, a través de la recepción semanal de Su Cuerpo y Sangre en la M Sacramento de la Confesión. Que San Juan isa, y la recepción frecuente de Su perdón en el

Vianney encienda en cada uno de nosotros el deseo de crecer en nuestra relación con el Señor, y que interceda por todos los que somos sacerdotes, para que seamos siempre fieles en nuestras vocaciones en servirle como el pueblo de Dios. ¡Dios los bendiga! *San Juan Vianney, ruega por nosotros!*

EL VÓMITO DE DIOS

“Y al encontrar una de gran valor, fue a vender todo lo que tenía y la compró” (Mateo 13:46).

Mucha gente no quiere poner todos los huevos en un canasto. Y siguen siendo cristianos, pero todavía con un pie en el mundo. De esta manera, si Jesús no es real, por lo menos no habían perdido todas sus vidas por Él. Ellos racionalizan que, si Jesús es el sentido de la vida, ellos por lo menos son miembros de la iglesia, pero sin perder la “diversión” del mundo.

Esto es el método más común de cristianismo en América. Esto hace sentir enfermo a Jesús (Ap 3:15-16). Jesús murió en la cruz por nosotros. Él derramó cada gota de sangre y respiró su última respiración para nosotros. Arrodillado ante Jesús crucificado, nos damos cuenta que es sacrílego darle a Él algo menos que todo.

El reino de Dios es como un tesoro enterrado o como una perla preciosa (Mt 13:44-46). El costo de un discípulo es dar todo. Tal vez no tenemos mucho, pero todos tenemos un “todo” – y ese “todo” es lo que tenemos que dar. El primer mandamiento dice: “Amarás al Señor, tu Dios, con todo tu corazón, con toda tu alma, con todas tus fuerzas” (Lc 10:27).

Oración: Padre, “concede entonces a tu servidor un corazón comprensivo, para juzgar a tu pueblo, para discernir entre el bien y el mal” (1 Reyes 3:9).

Promesa: “Sabemos, además, que Dios dispone, todas las cosas para el bien de los que lo aman, de aquellos que Él llamó según Su designio” (Rom 8:28).

Alabanza: Alabanzas a Ti, Jesús resucitado, “el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida” (Jn 14:6). ¡Aleluya!

The Kingdom of Heaven is Like...



In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells the disciples what the Kingdom of Heaven is like. He says it is like a buried treasure, that when a man finds it, he sells everything he has and buys the field where it is hidden. He also says it is like a pearl of great price, that when a merchant finds it he sells all he has and buys it.

These parables tell us how precious the Kingdom of Heaven is. Jesus is explaining that it is more important than anything else in our lives. The men in the parables sold EVERYTHING they had to get the treasures.

But what is the Kingdom of Heaven? Is it a country with a king and subjects? Well it is, sort of, but you can't see it. Jesus is the King and His people are the people who choose Him as their King. The laws of the kingdom are God's laws, and the enemy is the devil who is trying to take all the souls. Always remember that belonging to God's Kingdom is more important than everything else in your life!

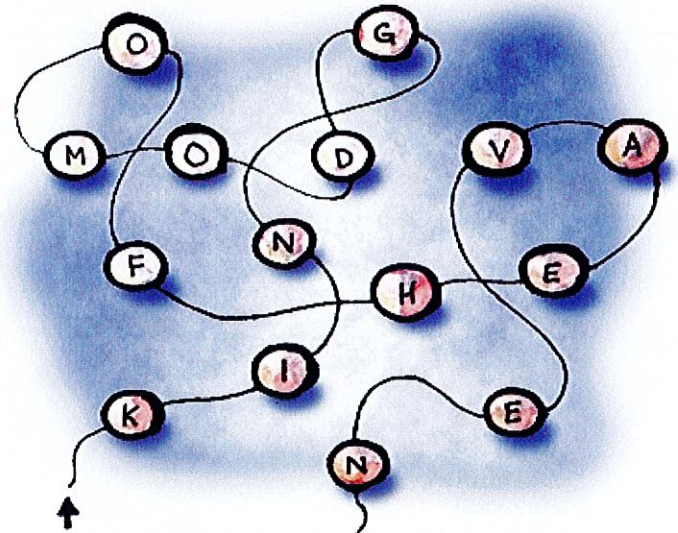

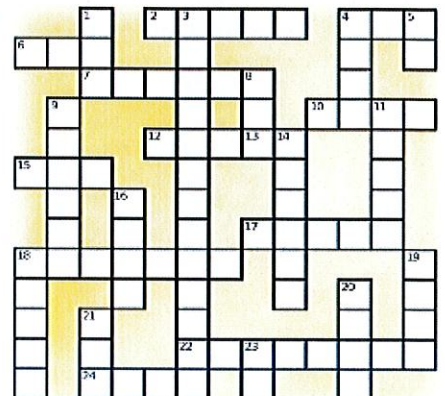


