Dear Parishioners,

This Tuesday, May 20th, Bishop Lewandowski will be installed as the Tenth Bishop of our Diocese. From the Diocese of Providence website: **Biography of Most Reverend Bruce A. Lewandowski, C.Ss.R.** "A native of Toledo, Ohio, His Excellency was born to the late Frances (Czelusta) and Robert Lewandowski on June 8, 1967, the second of four children to grow up on their family farm. Since 2020, he has served as Auxiliary Bishop of Baltimore as well as Vicar for Hispanic Catholics and Vicar for Baltimore City for the Archdiocese of Baltimore. Bishop Lewandowski grew up in a parish with priests of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, a missionary religious order known as the Redemptorists, and later in 1985 graduated from the order's Saint Mary's Seminary High School in North East, Pennsylvania. In September 1988, he entered the Redemptorist order professing first vows, and completed his formation and education at Saint Alphonsus College in Suffield, Connecticut where he earned a Bachelor of Arts in philosophy, Holy Redeemer College in Washington, and then Washington Theological Union where he earned a Master of Divinity degree. Bishop William Curlin, then-Bishop of Charlotte, ordained him to the Sacred Priesthood in the Basilica Shrine of the Immaculate Conception on May 7, 1994. As a Redemptorist priest, then-Father Lewandowski ministered as an Associate Pastor of Saint Cecilia Parish in East Harlem, New York (1994-1999); Pastor of Immaculate Conception Parish in South Bronx, New York (1999 to 2002); in missionary service as Assistant Pastor of Our Lady of the Assumption Parish in Vieux Fort, Saint Lucia, West Indies (2002 to 2005); Pastor of Our Lady of the Visitation Parish in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania (2005 to 2011); Vicar for Cultural Ministries for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia (2011 to 2015); and Pastor of Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish in Baltimore (2015 to 2020). In 2019, Archbishop William Lori, Archbishop of Baltimore, named him archdiocesan Vicar for Hispanic Catholics. The Holy Father, Pope Francis, named then-Father Lewandowski as an Auxiliary Bishop of Baltimore and Titular Bishop of Croae on June 10, 2020. He was consecrated to the episcopacy in the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen in Baltimore on August 18, 2020, by Archbishop

William Lori, with Bishop Adam Parker and Bishop John McIntyre as co-consecrators. Drawing on a prayer of Saint Francis of Assisi later adapted by the founder of his Redemptorist order, Saint Alphonsus Liguori, Bishop Lewandowski took for his episcopal motto 'because by your Holy Cross'. In 2021, Archbishop Lori named him archdiocesan Vicar for Baltimore City. Bishop Lewandowski is fluent in Spanish and Portuguese and is a brother to Sister Mary Francis Lewandowski, CSSF; Paula Chupp (James); and Joseph Lewandowski." Let us pray for our new Bishop. God Bless!

HARD LESSONS

“We must undergo many trials.” —Acts 14:22

At the close of the very first Christian missionary journey, Sts. Paul and Barnabas instructed their disciples: “We must undergo many trials if we are to enter into the reign of God” (Acts 14:22). Trials, in fact, many trials, are a given for a disciple, even though Jesus gives a yoke that is easy and a burden that is light (Mt 11:30).

Life is hard. This is not the Lord’s idea. He did not make original sin, “death or mourning, crying out or pain” (Rv 21:4; see Wis 1:13). He will eventually abolish all these evils. By our sins, we have made life hard, and the Lord has permitted this to continue.

By sin, we harden our hearts. Hard objects can be broken up by other harder objects (see Prv 27:17). The Lord can use hard lives to break up and open up our hard hearts. So He lets us “learn the hard way” so that we might repent (see Mk 1:15), give our lives to Him, and not enter the everlasting hardness of hell.

“Oh, that today you would hear His voice: ‘Harden not your hearts’ ” (Ps 95:7-8). Repent of any hardness of heart and go to Confession. If your heart is so hard that you refuse to repent, may the hard life you are making for yourself shatter the hardness of your heart.

Then, if we open our hearts to the Lord, He will let us share in the hard sufferings of His cross (see 1 Pt 4:13) so as to open the hardest hearts.

Prayer: Jesus, You gave us Mary to be our mother shortly before You died on the cross

(Jn 19:26-27). Let Mary teach me the hard facts and sublime joys of the cross.

Promise: This is how all will know you for My disciples: your love for one another.” — Jn 13:35

Praise: “Rejoice always” (1 Thes 5:16). “He has been raised up!” (Lk 24:6) Thank You, Jesus!

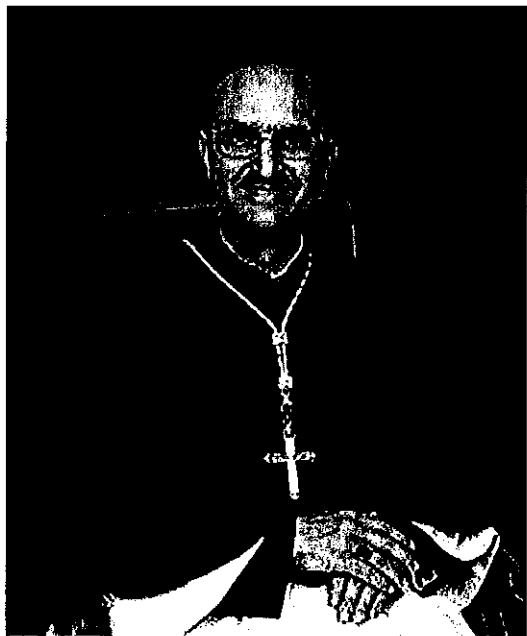

Este martes 20 de mayo, el Obispo Lewandowski será instalado como Décimo Obispo de nuestra Diócesis. Del sitio web de la Diócesis de Providence: **Biografía del Reverendísimo Bruce A. Lewandowski, C.Ss.R.** “Originario de Toledo, Ohio, Su Excelencia nació de Frances (Czelusta) y Robert Lewandowski el 8 de junio de 1967, el segundo de cuatro hijos que crecieron en la granja familiar. Desde 2020, se ha desempeñado como Obispo Auxiliar de Baltimore, así como Vicario para los Católicos Hispanos y Vicario para la Ciudad de Baltimore para la Arquidiócesis de Baltimore. El Obispo Lewandowski creció en una parroquia con sacerdotes de la Congregación del Santísimo Redentor, una orden religiosa misionera conocida como los Redentoristas, y más tarde, en 1985, se graduó de la escuela secundaria Saint Mary's Seminary de la orden en el noreste de Pensilvania. En septiembre de 1988, ingresó en la orden Redentorista profesando los primeros votos y completó su formación y educación en Saint Alphonsus College en Suffield, Connecticut, donde obtuvo una Licenciatura en Artes en Filosofía, Holy Redeemer College en Washington, y luego Washington Theological Union, donde obtuvo una Maestría en Divinidad. grado. El obispo William Curlin, entonces obispo de Charlotte, lo ordenó al Sagrado Sacerdocio en la Basílica Santuario de la Inmaculada Concepción el 7 de mayo de 1994. Como sacerdote redentorista, el entonces padre Lewandowski ejerció el ministerio como pastor asociado de la parroquia Santa Cecilia en East Harlem, Nueva York (1994-1999); párroco de la parroquia Inmaculada Concepción en el sur del Bronx, Nueva York (1999 a 2002); en servicio misionero como pastor asistente de la parroquia Nuestra Señora de la Asunción en Vieux Fort, Santa Lucía, Indias Occidentales (2002 a 2005); párroco de la parroquia Nuestra Señora de la Visitación en Filadelfia, Pensilvania (2005 a 2011); vicario de ministerios culturales de la Arquidiócesis de Filadelfia (2011 a 2015); y párroco de la parroquia Sagrado Corazón de Jesús en Baltimore (2015 a 2020). En 2019, el arzobispo William Lori, arzobispo de Baltimore, lo nombró Vicario arquidiocesano para los Católicos Hispanos. El Santo Padre, el papa Francisco, nombró al entonces padre Lewandowski obispo auxiliar de Baltimore y obispo titular de Croae el 10 de junio de 2020. Fue consagrado al episcopado en la Catedral de María Nuestra Reina en Baltimore el 18 de agosto de 2020 por el Arzobispo William Lori, con los Obispos Adam Parker y John McIntyre como co-consagrantes. Basándose en

una oración de san Francisco de Asís, posteriormente adaptada por el fundador de su orden redentorista, san Alfonso María de Liguorio, el obispo Lewandowski adoptó como lema episcopal ‘porque por tu Santa Cruz’. En 2021, el arzobispo Lori lo nombró vicario arquidiocesano de la ciudad de Baltimore. El obispo Lewandowski habla español y portugués con fluidez y es hermano de la hermana Mary Francis Lewandowski, CSSF; y de Paula Chupp. (James); y Joseph Lewandowski.” Vamos a orar por nuestro nuevo Obispo. ¡Que Dios los bendiga!

LECCIONES DIFÍCILES

"Es necesario pasar por muchas tribulaciones" (Hechos 14:22).

Al final del primer viaje misionero cristiano, Pablo y Bernabé instruyeron a sus discípulos: "Es necesario pasar por muchas tribulaciones para entrar en el Reino de Dios" (Hch 14:22). Las pruebas, de hecho, muchas pruebas, son un hecho para un discípulo, aunque Jesús da un yugo que es suave y una carga que es liviana (Mt 11:30).

La vida es difícil. Esta no es la idea del Señor. Él no cometió el pecado original, "muerte o lágrimas, queja o dolor" (Ap 21:4; ver Sab 1:13). Él con el tiempo abolirá todos estos males. Por nuestros pecados, hemos hecho la vida difícil, y el Señor ha permitido que esto continúe.

Por el pecado, endurecemos nuestros corazones. Los objetos duros pueden ser destrozados por otros objetos más duros (ver Prov 27:17). El Señor puede usar vidas difíciles para romper y abrir nuestros corazones duros. Así que Él nos permite "aprender por las malas" para que podamos arrepentirnos (ver Mc 1:15), entregar nuestra vida a Él y no entrar en la dureza eterna del infierno.

"Ojalá hoy escuchen la voz del Señor: 'No endurezcan su corazón'" (Sal 95:7-8).

Arrepiéntete de cualquier dureza de corazón y ve a confesarte. Si tu corazón es tan duro que te niegas a arrepentirte, que la vida dura que te estás haciendo destruya la dureza de tu corazón.

Entonces, si abrimos nuestro corazón al Señor, Él nos hará partícipes de los duros sufrimientos de Su cruz (ver 1 Pe 4:13) para abrir los corazones más duros.

Oración: Jesús, Tú nos diste a María para que fuera nuestra madre poco antes de morir en la cruz (Jn 19:26-27). Que María me enseñe los hechos difíciles y las alegrías sublimes de la cruz.

Promesa: "En esto todos reconocerán que ustedes son Mis discípulos: en el amor que se tengan los unos a los otros" (Jn 13:35).

Alabanza: "Estén siempre alegres" (1 Tes 5:16). "No está aquí, ha resucitado" (Lc 24:6). ¡Gracias, Jesús!

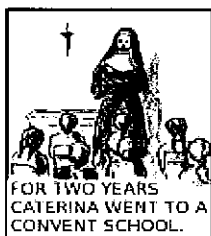
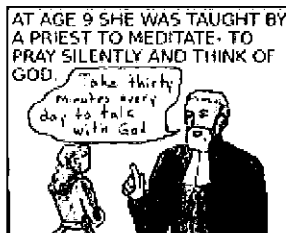
