# **Seventh Sunday of Easter**

## **May 21, 2023**

Dear Parishioners,

A few weeks ago in the bulletin, I wrote about the **Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist** - Jesus in Holy Communion - Jesus truly present in His Body and Blood. I shared the beginning of a reading from **Saint Justin, Martyr**, who lived from 100 - 165 (1900 years ago!). It was from "the first apology in defense of the Christians", entitled "**The Celebration of the Eucharist**". Here is the rest of that same reading: *"On Sunday we have a common assembly of all our members, whether they live in the city or the outlying districts. The recollections of the apostles or the writings of the prophets are read, as long as there is time. When the reader has finished, the president of the assembly speaks to us; he urges everyone to imitate the examples of virtue we have heard in the readings. Then we all stand up together and pray. On the conclusion of our prayer, bread and wine and water are brought forward. The president offers prayers and gives thanks to the best of his ability, and the people give assent by saying, 'Amen.' The Eucharist is distributed, everyone present communicates, and the deacons take it to those who are absent. The wealthy, if they wish, may make a contribution, and they themselves decide the amount. The collection is placed in the custody of the president, who uses it to help the orphans and widows and all who for any reason are in distress, whether because they are sick, in prison, or away from home. In a word, he takes care of all who are in need. We hold our common assembly on Sunday because it is the first day of the week, the day on which God put darkness and chaos to flight and created the world, and because on that same day our savior Jesus Christ rose from the dead. For he was crucified on Friday and on Sunday he appeared to his apostles and disciples and taught them the things that we have passed on for your consideration."*

**Notice how we have continued this same Holy Sacrifice of the Mass almost 2000 years later**, with the readings, homily by the priest (or deacon), the collection during Mass, and Holy Communion also being brought to the sick by either myself, the deacon, or one of our extraordinary ministers.

My brothers and sisters, we have such a beautiful Catholic Faith that Jesus gave us. As we prepare to celebrate the Birthday of our Church next Sunday on Pentecost, let us ask the Holy Spirit to fill us with gratitude, as well as the strength to be faithful members of the Body of Christ. God Bless!

# LOOK UP AND GO OUT

**"No sooner had He said this than He was lifted up before their eyes in a cloud which took Him from their sight." —Acts 1:9**

The apostles asked Jesus: "Lord, are You going to restore the rule to Israel now?" (Acts 1:6) They were interested in knowing the time Jesus would restore the kingdom. Jesus responded: "The exact time it is not yours to know" (Acts 1:7). Then Jesus proceeded to bring up what He was interested in — not so much the time but the persons responsible for restoring the kingdom. The apostles had assumed Jesus would do the restoring. Jesus shocked them by asserting that they were to do the job. Before the apostles could try to shift the responsibility back onto Jesus, He ascended, leaving the apostles "holding the bag," that is, having the responsibility of making disciples of all the nations (see Mt 28:19). However, Jesus did not leave His Church powerless. He promised us the Spirit's power (Acts 1:8) and His presence "always, until the end of the world!" (Mt 28:20)

Jesus' Ascension means that we, the members of the Church, take up where Jesus has left off. The responsibility for evangelizing the world is ours; the power of the Holy Spirit is ours; and the privilege of living and dying for His kingdom is ours. Because He has gone up, we must go out. Go now.

**Prayer:** "God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory," grant us "a spirit of wisdom and insight to know" You clearly (Eph 1:17).


**Promise:** "He has put all things under Christ's feet and has made Him, thus exalted, Head of the Church, which is His body: the fullness of Him Who fills the universe in all its parts." —Eph 1:22-23

**Praise:** "Then, after speaking to them, the Lord Jesus was taken up into heaven and took His seat at God's right hand" (Mk 16:19). Praise Jesus Who ascended!


## Eucharistic Adoration

# **Séptimo Domingo de Pascua**

## **21 de Mayo, 2023**

Queridos feligreses,

Hace unas semanas en el boletín escribí sobre el **Sacramento de la Sagrada Eucaristía** - Jesús en la Sagrada Comunión - Jesús verdaderamente presente en Su Cuerpo y Sangre. Compartí el comienzo de una lectura de **San Justino, mártir**, que vivió del 100 al 165 (¡hace 1900 años!). Era de “la primera apología en defensa de los cristianos”, titulada **“La Celebración de la Eucaristía”**. Aquí está el resto de esa misma lectura: *“El domingo tenemos una asamblea común de todos nuestros miembros, ya sea que vivan en la ciudad o en los distritos periféricos. Se leen las memorias de los apóstoles o los escritos de los profetas, siempre que haya tiempo. Cuando el lector ha terminado, nos habla el presidente de la asamblea; insta a todos a imitar los ejemplos de virtud que hemos escuchado en las lecturas. Entonces todos nos ponemos de pie juntos y oramos. Al concluir nuestra oración, se presentan pan, vino y agua. El presidente ofrece oraciones y da gracias lo mejor que puede, y el pueblo asiente diciendo: ‘Amén’. Se distribuye la Eucaristía, todos los presentes comunican y los diáconos la llevan a los ausentes. Los ricos, si lo desean, pueden hacer una contribución, y ellos mismos deciden la cantidad. La colecta se pone bajo la custodia del presidente, quien la utiliza para ayudar a los huérfanos y viudas ya todos los que por cualquier motivo se encuentran en apuros, ya sea por enfermedad, en prisión o fuera de casa. En una palabra, él cuida de todos los que están en necesidad. Celebramos nuestra asamblea común el domingo porque es el primer día de la semana, el día en que Dios ahuyentó las tinieblas y el caos y creó el mundo, y porque ese mismo día nuestro salvador Jesucristo resucitó de entre los muertos. Porque fue crucificado el viernes y el domingo se apareció a sus apóstoles y discípulos y les enseñó las cosas que hemos pasado para vuestra consideración.” Observe cómo hemos continuado este mismo Santo Sacrificio de la Misa casi 2000 años después, con las lecturas, la homilía del sacerdote (o diácono), la colecta durante la Misa y la Sagrada Comunión también siendo llevada a los enfermos por mí mismo, el diácono, o uno de nuestros ministros extraordinarios. Mis hermanos y*

hermanas, tenemos una Fe Católica tan hermosa que Jesús nos dio. Mientras nos preparamos para celebrar el Cumpleaños de nuestra Iglesia el próximo domingo de Pentecostés, pidamos al Espíritu Santo que nos llene de gratitud, así como de la fortaleza para ser miembros fieles del Cuerpo de Cristo. ¡Dios los bendiga!

# MIRA HACIA ARRIBA, Y HECHA A ANDAR

**“Dicho esto, los Apóstoles lo vieron elevarse, y una nube lo ocultó de la vista de ellos” (Hechos 1:9).**

Los apóstoles le preguntaron a Jesús: “Señor, ¿es ahora cuando vas a restaurar el reino de Israel?” (Hch 1:6) Estaban interesados en saber la hora en que Jesús restauraría el reino. Jesús respondió: “No les corresponde a ustedes conocer el tiempo” (Hch 1:7). Luego, Jesús procedió a mencionar lo que le interesaba: no tanto el tiempo, sino las personas responsables de restaurar el reino. Los apóstoles habían asumido que Jesús haría la restauración. Jesús los sorprendió al afirmar que ellos eran los que harían el trabajo. Antes de que los apóstoles pudieran tratar de devolver la responsabilidad a Jesús, Él ascendió, dejando a los apóstoles “sosteniendo la bolsa”, es decir, teniendo la responsabilidad de hacer discípulos de todas las naciones (ver Mt 28:19). Sin embargo, Jesús no dejó a Su Iglesia impotente. Él nos prometió el poder del Espíritu (Hch 1:8) y Su presencia “siempre con ustedes hasta el fin del mundo” (Mt 28:20).

La Ascensión de Jesús significa que nosotros, los miembros de la Iglesia, retomamos donde Jesús la había dejado. La responsabilidad de evangelizar el mundo es nuestra; el poder del Espíritu Santo es nuestro; y el privilegio de vivir y morir por Su reino es nuestro. Porque Él ha ascendido, nosotros debemos salir. Vamos ahora.

**Oración:** “Que el Dios de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, el Padre de la gloria, les conceda un espíritu de sabiduría y de

revelación que les permita conocerlo verdaderamente (Ef 1:17).

**Promesa:** “Él puso todas las cosas bajo sus pies y lo constituyó, por encima de todo, Cabeza de la Iglesia, que es Su Cuerpo y la Plenitud de Aquel que llena completamente todas las cosas” (Ef 1:22-23).

**Alabanza:** “Después de decírles esto, el Señor Jesús fue llevado al cielo y está sentado a la derecha de Dios” (Mc 16:19). ¡Alabado sea Jesús que ascendió!






But Jesus didn't go away and leave us without any help. Nine days after He went into Heaven He sent the Holy Spirit, who would help and guide His followers.


