# 32nd Sunday Ordinary Time

## November 6, 2022

Dear Parishioners,

In 2016, the Church put forth an Instruction of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith regarding **burial of the dead and conservation of ashes in case of cremation**, entitled "*Ad Resurgendum cum Christo*". I would like to point out a few key themes from this instruction for your consideration, as we continue to pray during this month of November for the souls of our faithful departed. Cremation has become a very common practice, and is becoming more widespread, as well as another phenomenon in which the ashes ("cremated remains"), are being kept in people's houses or even worse, conserved in jewelry or even being scattered in nature. This Church document "*recommends the pious custom be kept of burying the bodies of the deceased*", whether "*in a cemetery or other sacred place*". Burial "*is the most fitting way to express faith and hope in bodily resurrection*". Cremation "*is not prohibited unless it was chosen for reasons contrary to Christian Doctrine, but the ashes must normally be kept in a cemetery or sacred place. It is necessary to avoid pantheistic or naturalistic ambiguities; therefore, the dispersion of ashes in the air, on the earth, in water or other way, or to convert the ashes into commemorative memories is not permitted*". The document reflects the Church's care so that the bodies of the faithful deceased "*inspire respect and charity and can express appropriately the Christian meaning of death and hope in the resurrection of the body*". My brothers and sisters, if you happen to have the cremated remains of your loved one in your house or in a piece of jewelry, or anywhere else that is not a sacred place, please contact your local cemetery to bury the cremated remains in their proper place. *May the souls all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.* God bless!

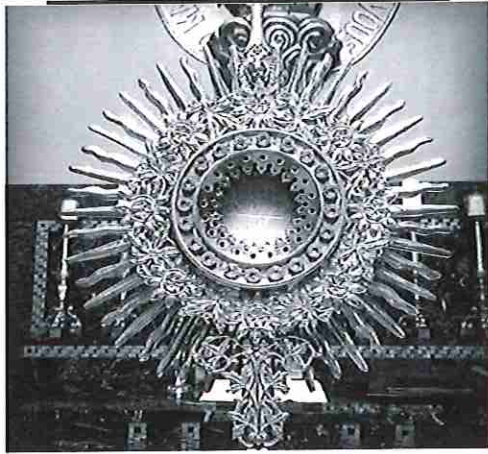

## ***32 Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario*** ***6 de Noviembre 2022***

Queridos feligreses,

En 2016, la Iglesia presentó una Instrucción de la Congregación para la Doctrina de la Fe sobre **el entierro de los muertos y la conservación de las cenizas en caso de cremación**, titulada "*Ad resurgendum cum Christo*". Me gustaría señalar algunos temas clave de esta instrucción para su consideración, mientras continuamos orando durante este mes de Noviembre por las almas de nuestros fieles difuntos. La cremación se ha convertido en una práctica muy común, y cada vez más extendida, así como otro fenómeno en el que las cenizas ("restos cremados"), están siendo guardadas en las casas de las personas o peor aún, conservadas en joyas o incluso esparcidas en la naturaleza. Este documento de la Iglesia "*recomienda que se mantenga la piadosa costumbre de enterrar los cuerpos de los difuntos*", ya sea "*en un cementerio u otro lugar sagrado*". El entierro "*es la forma más adecuada de expresar la fe y la esperanza en la resurrección corporal*". La cremación "*no está prohibida a menos que se haya elegido por razones contrarias a la Doctrina Cristiana, pero las cenizas normalmente deben mantenerse en un cementerio o lugar sagrado. Es necesario evitar ambigüedades panteístas o naturalistas; por tanto, no se permite la dispersión de cenizas en el aire, en la tierra, en el agua o de otra forma, ni convertir las cenizas en memorias conmemorativas*". El documento refleja el cuidado de la Iglesia para que los cuerpos de los fieles difuntos "*inspiren respeto y caridad y puedan expresar adecuadamente el significado cristiano de la muerte y la esperanza en la resurrección de los cuerpos*". Mis hermanos y hermanas, si tienen los restos cremados de su ser querido en su casa o en una joya, o en cualquier otro lugar que no sea un lugar sagrado, comuníquese con su cementerio local para enterrar los restos cremados en su lugar apropiado. lugar. ***Que las almas de todos los fieles difuntos, por la misericordia de Dios, descansen en paz. ¡Dios los bendiga!***

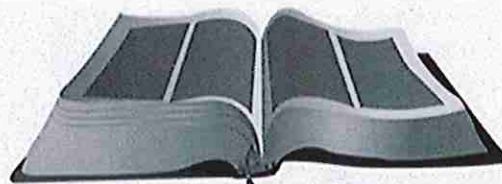

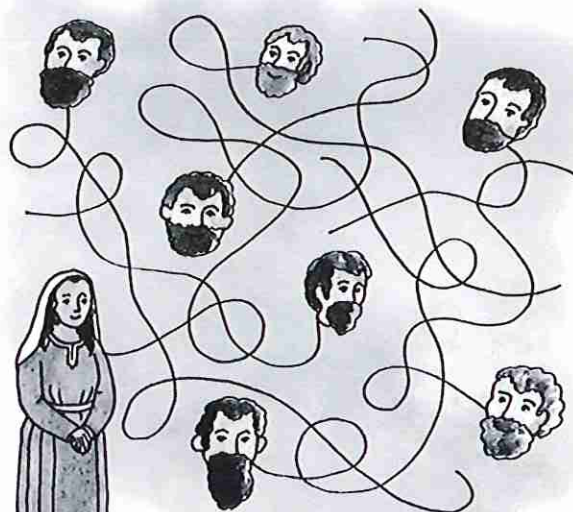
