Dear Parishioners,

This past Friday, November 11th, was **Veteran's Day**. Our veterans made the **sacrifice** of serving our country and protecting her freedom. I would like to share the story of an inspiring veteran, who was also a Catholic priest. **Fr. Vincent Capodanno (1929-1967)**, grew up in the nineteen thirties and forties in a large Italian-American family on Staten Island. He joined the Maryknoll missionary order, and upon ordination to the priesthood in 1958, he served in Taiwan and later Hong Kong. In the mid-60's, he volunteered to serve as a Naval/Marine Corps chaplain in Vietnam. In his new assignment, Father Capodanno found a parish among the "needy." He sought the lonely Marines, the "grunts" who were exposed to death, suffering, and sacrifice. He felt a compelling desire to be with these forgotten parishioners in their greatest hours of need. On April 30, 1966, Father Capodanno began a sixteen-month tour with the 7th and 5th Marine Regiments where he became *"the best known and sought after chaplain in the Marine Corps"*. *"What set Father Vincent apart was the way he lived his ministry with the Marines,"* writes Father Mode. *"He was not a religious leader who did his job and then returned to the comfort of his own circle. He lived as a grunt Marine. Wherever they went, he went. Whatever burdens they had to carry, he shared the load. No problem was too large or too small to take to Father Vincent - he was available to them day and night."* The soldiers responded to his devotion and soon he became affectionately known to his Marines as "the Grunt Padre." On September 4, 1967, the helicopter carrying him to the site of battle crashed during a large-scale offensive named Operation Swift. The 5th Marines found themselves in dire straits, outnumbered 5-to-1 by 2,500 North Vietnamese regular troops. Although wounded three times in the course of the battle, Fr. Capodanno refused to be medevacked. Like a ray of hope in the midst of the storm, he went up and down the line caring for the wounded and anointing the dying. During the fierce fighting, the chaplain spotted a wounded corpsman hit by a burst of automatic fire and unable to move. Fr. Capodanno ran to his aid and began to care for his wounds. A Viet Cong machine gunner opened fire. With 27 bullet wounds in his spine, neck, and head, the Grunt Padre fell in battle, serving his men to the end. On May 21, 2006 Fr. Capodanno was declared Servant of God and his cause

for canonization is currently under way. *Servant of God Fr. Vincent Capodanno, pray for us, and help us to be willing to sacrifice for God and for one another.* God Bless!

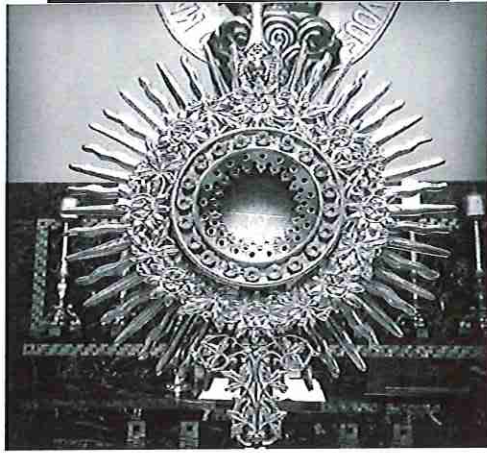

St. Rose Philippine Duchesne, Virgin (Feast day - **November 18**)
Born in Grenoble, France, in 1769, Rose joined the Society of the Sacred Heart. In 1818, when she

was forty-nine years old, Rose was sent to the United States. She founded a boarding school for daughters of pioneers near St. Louis and opened the first free school west of the Missouri. At the age of seventy-one, she began a school for Indians, who soon came to call her "the woman who is always praying". Her biographers have also stressed her courage in frontier conditions, her singlemindedness in pursuing her dream of serving Native Americans, and her self-acceptance. This holy servant of God was beatified by Pope Pius XII in 1940 and canonized by Pope John Paul II in 1988.

Queridos feligreses,

El pasado viernes 11 de Noviembre fue el **Día del Veterano**. Nuestros veteranos hicieron el **sacrificio** de servir a nuestro país y proteger su libertad. Me gustaría compartir la historia de un veterano inspirador, que también fue sacerdote Católico. **Padre Vincent Capodanno (1929-1967)**, creció en los años treinta y cuarenta en una gran familia ítalo-estadounidense en Staten Island. Se unió a la orden misionera de Maryknoll y, tras su ordenación sacerdotal en 1958, sirvió en Taiwán y luego en Hong Kong. A mediados de la década de 1960, se ofreció como voluntario para servir como capellán de la Armada y el Cuerpo de Marines en Vietnam. En su nueva misión, el Padre Capodanno encontró una parroquia entre los "necesitados". Buscó a los marines solitarios, los "gruñidos" que estaban expuestos a la muerte, el sufrimiento y el sacrificio. Sintió un deseo apremiante de estar con estos feligreses olvidados en sus horas de mayor necesidad. El 30 de abril de 1966, el Padre Capodanno inició una gira de dieciséis meses con los 7º y 5º Regimientos de Infantería de Marina, donde se convirtió en *"el capellán más conocido y solicitado de la Infantería de Marina"*. *"Lo que diferenció al Padre Vincent fue la forma en que vivió su ministerio con los Marines"*, escribe el Padre Mode. *"Él no era un líder religioso que hacía su trabajo y luego regresaba a la comodidad de su propio círculo. Vivió como un soldado de infantería de marina. Dondequiera que ellos iban, él iba. Cualquiera que fueran las cargas que tenían que llevar, él compartía la carga. Ningún problema era demasiado grande o demasiado pequeño para llevarlo al Padre Vincent: él estaba disponible para ellos día y noche"*. Los soldados respondieron a su devoción y pronto lo conocieron cariñosamente como "el Padre Grunt". El 4 de Septiembre de 1967, el helicóptero que lo llevaba al lugar de la batalla se estrelló durante una ofensiva a gran escala llamada Operación Swift. El 5.º de la Infantería de Marina se encontró en una situación desesperada, superado en número 5 a 1 por 2.500 soldados regulares norvietnamitas. Aunque herido tres veces en el curso de la batalla, el Padre Capodanno se negó a ser evacuado y, como un rayo de esperanza en medio de la tormenta, recorrió la línea de arriba a abajo cuidando a los heridos y ungiendo a los moribundos. Durante la feroz lucha, el capellán vio a un soldado herido alcanzado por una ráfaga de fuego automático e incapaz de moverse. El Padre Capodanno corrió en su ayuda y comenzó a cuidar sus heridas. Un ametrallador del

Viet Cong abrió fuego. Con 27 heridas de bala en la columna vertebral, cuello y cabeza, el Padre Grunt cayó en batalla, sirviendo a sus hombres hasta el final. El 21 de Mayo de 2006 el Padre Capodanno fue declarado "Siervo de Dios" y su causa de canonización está en curso. *Siervo de Dios Padre Vincent Capodanno, ruega por nosotros, y ayúdanos a estar dispuestos a sacrificarnos por Dios y por los demás.*
¡Dios los bendiga!

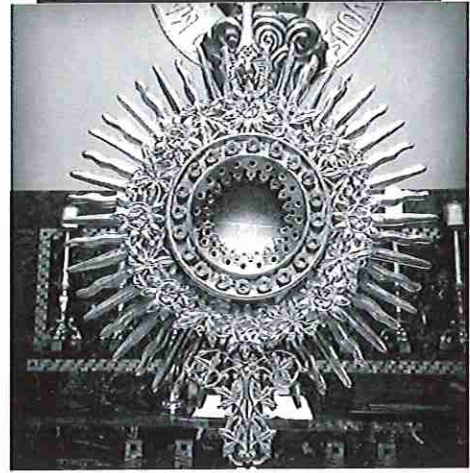

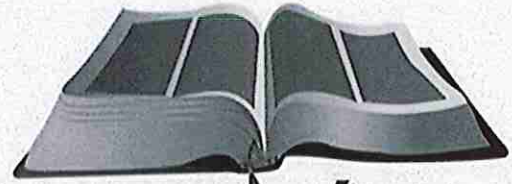

God is With Us to the End

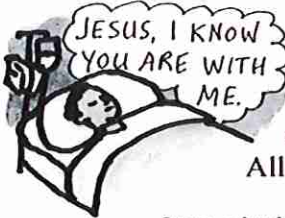
