# *Twelfth Sunday of Ordinary Time*

## *June 25, 2023*

Dear Parishioners,

This Saturday (June 24th) is the **Solemnity of the Birth of Saint John the Baptist**. On Sunday, we will gather together for a luncheon as a parish community, to celebrate our Patron Saint. **Who was Saint John the Baptist?** First, *he was the miracle child* of Zechariah and Elizabeth. He was a “miracle” because his mother Elizabeth became pregnant with him when she was elderly. John was sanctified in his mother’s womb when our Blessed Mother Mary visited her while pregnant with Jesus. This beautiful meeting between the two pregnant mothers shows us *the joy of motherhood with the sacredness of life in the womb*. Secondly, *John the Baptist clearly knew his purpose in life*. His entire life was a preparation for Jesus - his cousin and his Lord. As soon as Jesus began His public ministry, John the Baptist pointed others towards Him, saying: *“Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world”*. With great humility, John the Baptist led others to Jesus and away from himself. *The greatest gift that we can give another person is to point them to Jesus and the Kingdom of Heaven*. Thirdly, *Saint John the Baptist was not afraid to speak the truth*. John the Baptist was killed for standing up for *the truth about Marriage*. He told King Herod *the truth* - that his adulterous relationship with his brother’s wife was wrong. The king did not want to hear the truth, and so he had John killed. The truth about Marriage is that it is permanent, only between one man and one woman, and must be blessed by the Lord in a Sacrament in the Church (i.e. a civil “marriage” is not a marriage before the eyes of God). We live in a society that does not always want to hear the truth, and yet as disciples of Jesus Christ who is the Way, the *Truth*, and the Life, *we must never be afraid to speak the truths of our faith with courage and love*. The sacredness of every human life, our purpose on earth in getting to Heaven, and courageously speaking the truth - these are three lessons that we can learn from our Patron Saint. *Saint John the Baptist, pray for us!* God bless!

# FEAR NOT

**“Do not be afraid of anything.” —**

## **Matthew 10:31**

Our reaction to fear will be among the best or worst aspects of our lives. We will either let ourselves be manipulated by fear into sinful compromises and eventual damnation, or we will refuse to be controlled by fear and eventually push it out of our lives (see 1 Jn 4:18). Therefore, Jesus repeatedly commands us: “Do not let them intimidate you” (Mt 10:26). “Do not fear those who deprive the body of life but cannot destroy the soul” (Mt 10:28). “Do not be afraid of anything” (Mt 10:31).

Our response to fear should be faith. Jesus told Jairus after his daughter died: “Do not fear, only believe” (Mk 5:36, RSV-CE). When his friends had turned against him in vengeance, Jeremiah had the faith to fearlessly proclaim: “The Lord is with me, like a mighty Champion: my persecutors will stumble, they will not triumph” (Jer 20:11). Even when we are enduring our own agony in the garden or suffering on our own Calvary, by faith we can refuse to be manipulated by fear. We can “say with confidence: ‘The Lord is my Helper, I will not be afraid; what can man do to me?’” (Heb 13:6) By faith we can proclaim: “The Lord is my life’s Refuge; of whom should I be afraid?...Though an army encamp against me, my heart will not fear” (Ps 27:1, 3). Fear not.

**Prayer:** Father, may my awareness that You are in me make me fearless. May Your love push fear out of my life (see 1 Jn 4:18).

**Promise:** “For if by the offense of the one man all died, much more did the grace of

God and the gracious gift of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound for all.” —Rm 5:15

**Praise:** Praise You, risen Jesus, Victor over death. You are “the Resurrection and the Life” (Jn 11:25). Alleluia!

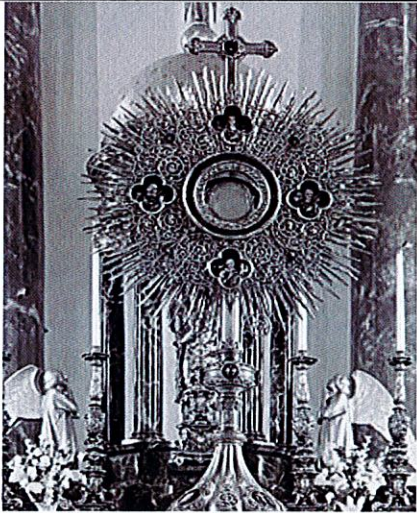

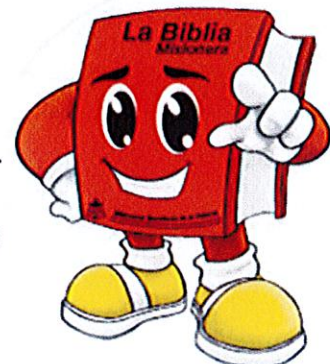

# *Decimosegundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario*

## *25 de Junio, 2023*

Queridos feligreses,

Este sábado (24 de Junio) es la Solemnidad del Nacimiento de San Juan Bautista. El domingo nos reuniremos para un almuerzo como comunidad parroquial, para celebrar a nuestro Santo Patrono.

**¿Quién fue San Juan Bautista?** Primero, *fue el hijo milagroso* de Zacarías e Isabel. Fue un "milagro" porque su madre Isabel quedó embarazada de él cuando era anciana. Juan fue santificado en el vientre de su madre cuando nuestra Santísima Madre María la visitó mientras estaba embarazada de Jesús. Este hermoso encuentro entre las dos madres embarazadas nos muestra **la alegría de la maternidad con lo sagrado de la vida en el vientre**. En segundo lugar, *Juan el Bautista conocía claramente su propósito en la vida*. Toda su vida fue una preparación para Jesús - su primo y su Señor. Tan pronto como Jesús comenzó su ministerio público, Juan el Bautista señaló a otros hacia Él, diciendo: *"Este es el Cordero de Dios que quita los pecados del mundo"*. Con gran humildad, Juan el Bautista llevó a otros a Jesús y lejos de sí mismo. **El mayor regalo que podemos darle a otra persona es señalarle a Jesús y al Reino de los Cielos**. En tercer lugar, *San Juan Bautista no tenía miedo de decir la verdad*. Juan el Bautista fue asesinado por defender *la verdad sobre el Matrimonio*. Le dijo al rey Herodes la verdad: que su relación adúltera con la esposa de su hermano estaba mal. El rey no quería escuchar la verdad, y por eso hizo matar a Juan. La verdad sobre el Matrimonio es que es permanente, solo entre un hombre y una mujer, y debe ser bendecido por el Señor en un Sacramento en la Iglesia (es decir, un **"matrimonio" civil no es un matrimonio ante los ojos de Dios**). Vivimos en una sociedad que no siempre quiere escuchar la verdad y, sin embargo, como discípulos de Jesucristo, que es el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida, *nunca debemos tener miedo de decir las verdades de nuestra fe con valentía y amor*. La santidad de cada vida humana, nuestro propósito en la tierra para llegar al Cielo y decir la verdad con valentía: estas son tres lecciones que podemos aprender de nuestro Santo Patrón.

**¡San Juan Bautista, ruega por nosotros!** ¡Dios los bendiga!

# NO TEMAS

## “No teman” (Mateo 10:31).

Nuestra reacción al miedo siempre estará entre los mejores o peores aspectos de nuestras vidas. O nos dejaremos manipular por el miedo hacia compromisos pecaminosos y una eventual condenación, o nos negaremos a ser controlados por el miedo y eventualmente lo expulsaremos de nuestras vidas (ver 1 Jn 4:18). Por eso, Jesús nos manda repetidamente: “No les teman” (Mt 10:26). “No teman a los que matan el cuerpo, pero no pueden matar el alma” (Mt 10:28). “No teman” (Mt 10:31).

Nuestra respuesta al miedo debe ser la fe. Jesús le dijo a Jairo después de la muerte de su hija: “No temas, basta que creas” (Mc 5:36). Cuando sus amigos se volvieron contra él en venganza, Jeremías tuvo la fe para proclamar sin miedo: “El Señor está conmigo como un guerrero temible: por eso mis perseguidores tropezarán y no podrán prevalecer” (Jer 20:11). Incluso cuando estamos soportando nuestra propia agonía en el jardín o sufriendo nuestro propio Calvario, por fe podemos negarnos a ser manipulados por el miedo. “De manera que podemos decir con plena confianza: ‘El Señor es mi Protector, no temeré. ¿Qué podrán hacerme los hombres?’” (Heb 13:6) Por la fe podemos proclamar: “El Señor es el baluarte de mi vida, ¿ante quién temblaré?... Aunque acampe contra mí un ejército, mi corazón no temerá” (Sal 27:1, 3). No temas.

**Oración:** Padre, que mi conciencia de que Tú estás en mí me haga valiente. Que Tu amor saque el miedo de mi vida (ver 1 Jn 4:18).

**Promesa:** “Porque si la falta de uno solo provocó la muerte de todos, la gracia de

Dios y el don conferido por la gracia de un solo hombre, Jesucristo, fueron derramados mucho más abundantemente sobre todos” (Rom 5:15).

**Alabanza:** Alabado seas, Jesús resucitado, vencedor de la muerte. Ustedes son “la Resurrección y la Vida” (Jn 11:25). ¡Aleluya!
