THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

JUNE 19, 2022

Dear Parishioners,

Happy and Blessed Feast Day of the Body and Blood of Christ, also known in Latin as "**Corpus Christi**" ("The Body of Christ"). Almost 2000 years ago, Jesus had His Last Supper with His Apostles. *"For on the night He was betrayed, He Himself took bread, and, giving You thanks, He said the blessing, broke the bread and gave it to His disciples, saying: 'TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND EAT OF IT, FOR THIS IS MY BODY, WHICH WILL BE GIVEN UP FOR YOU' ". Then Jesus took the chalice and said similar words, "...FOR THIS IS THE CHALICE OF MY BLOOD,.....DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME".* This was the first Catholic Mass, and every time the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is offered, we are obeying Jesus' command to "**DO THIS IN MEMORY OF HIM**". The bread and the wine are changed into the Body and Blood of Christ, and a miracle takes place at every Mass. Although the physical appearance of the bread and wine does not change, their substances do. This is why we call this moment at Mass **transubstantiation**, for the "substances" of bread and wine are "transformed". This happens through the power of the Holy Spirit and Jesus' Own words. Listen to the powerful words of St. John Vianney, whose statue is in our church: *"All the good works in the world are not equal to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass because they are the works of men; but the Mass is the work of God. Martyrdom is nothing in comparison for it is but the sacrifice of man to God; but the Mass is the sacrifice of God for man."* We can grow in our appreciation of so great a GIFT through **Adoration** of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, taking time to adore Jesus in the Tabernacle of our church, or any Catholic church that we may visit. Also, every Friday, we have Eucharistic Adoration here in our church from 9am - 7pm. From St. John Vianney: *"I throw myself at the foot of the Tabernacle like a dog at the foot of his Master."* My brothers and sisters, let us never take this GIFT of Jesus' Real Presence for granted, but through our active participation at Mass, as well as with our prayers in the church, let us strive to truly be a Eucharistic people. On this **Father's Day** weekend, let us also thank God our Heavenly Father for all of our "fathers" - our earthly fathers, our spiritual fathers (priests), our godfathers, and all men who have been that good example for us to follow in our walk with the Lord. *Saint Joseph, foster father of Jesus, pray for us!*

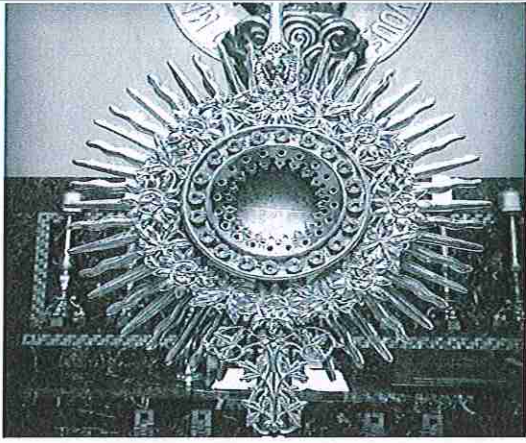

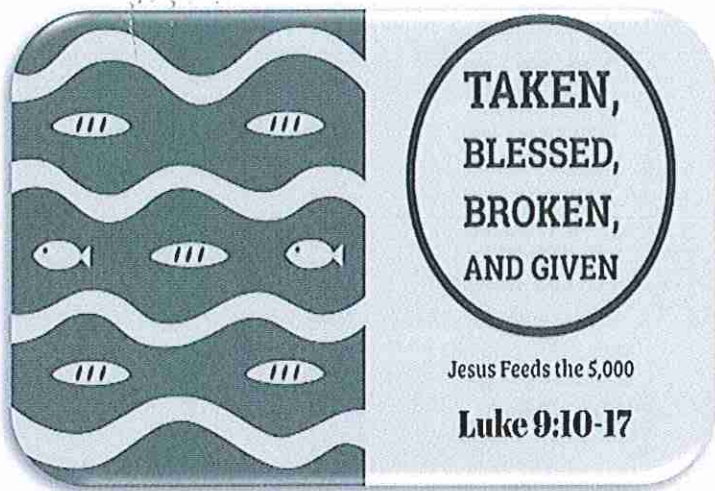

Sunday but in light of this special
celebration for our Dioceses I
would like to encourage you to
attend this Mass.**



“A LIVING SACRIFICE” (RM 12:1)

“This is My body, which is for you.” —1 Corinthians 11:24 The Mass makes present the once-and-for-all sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. Therefore, to enter into the spirit of the Mass, we must “proclaim the death of the Lord” (1 Cor 11:26) and offer our bodies to the Lord as living sacrifices (Rm 12:1). The spirit of the Mass is the spirit of sacrifice. Thus it is important to fast before Mass, deny ourselves, and take up our crosses each day (Lk 9:23) with the intention of uniting ourselves to Jesus crucified (see Gal 2:19) and sacrificed (see Heb 9:26). Through our “good deeds and generosity” (Heb 13:16), we make sacrifices pleasing to the Lord. We can unite these sacrifices with Jesus’ sacrifice on Calvary and fill up in our own bodies what is lacking in the “sufferings of Christ” (Col 1:24). The Holy Mass is not the proclamation and perpetuation of our sacrifices but rather of His sacrifice. However, the Mass is the participation of our sacrifices in His. Live the Mass. Live a life of sacrifice. Through Jesus, “let us continually offer God a sacrifice of praise” (Heb 13:15).

Prayer: Father, do a miracle of multiplication in today’s Mass (see Lk 9:16ff).

Promise: “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. Do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of Me.” —1 Cor 11:25

Praise: “Now, since the children are men of blood and flesh, Jesus likewise had a full share in ours, that by His death he might rob the devil, the prince of death, of his power” (Heb 2:14). Glorified Jesus, You become truly present in Holy Communion. We humbly adore You. Presentation Ministries

“UNA VICTIMA VIVA” (ROMANOS 12:1)

“Esto es mi Cuerpo, que se entrega por ustedes” (1 Corintios 11:24). La Misa hace presente el sacrificio definitivo de Jesús en la cruz. Por lo tanto, para entrar en el espíritu de la Misa, se nos pide que “proclamarán la muerte del Señor hasta que Él vuelva” (1 Co 11:26) y también “ofrecerse a ustedes mismos como una víctima viva” (Rom 12:1). El espíritu de la Misa es el espíritu de sacrificio. Por eso es importante ayunar antes de la Misa, negarnos a nosotros mismos y cargar nuestras cruces cada Día (Lc 9:23) con la intención de unirnos con Jesús crucificado (ver Gál 2:19) y sacrificado (ver Heb 9:26). Por medio de nuestras buenas obras y generosidad (Heb 13:16), hacemos sacrificios agradables al Señor. Podemos unir estos sacrificios con el sacrificio de Jesús en el Calvario y llenar en nuestros propios cuerpos lo que falta en los “padecimientos de Cristo” (Col 1:24).

La Santa Misa no es la proclamación y perpetuación de nuestros sacrificios sino más bien de Su sacrificio. Sin embargo, la Misa es la participación de nuestros sacrificios en los Suyos. Viva la Misa. Viva una vida de sacrificio. Por medio de Jesús, “ofrezcamos sin cesar a Dios un sacrificio de alabanza” (Heb 13:15).

Oración: Padre, haz un milagro de multiplicación en la Misa de hoy (ver Lc 9:16ss).

Promesa: “Esta copa es la Nueva Alianza que se sella con mi Sangre. Siempre que la beban, háganlo en memoria Mía” (1 Co 11:25).

Alabanza: “Y ya que los hijos tienen una misma sangre y una misma carne, Él también debía participar de esa condición, para reducir a la impotencia, mediante Su muerte, a aquel que tenía el dominio de la muerte, es decir, al demonio” (Heb 2:14). Jesús glorificado, se hace verdaderamente presente en la Sagrada Comunión. Te adoramos humildemente.

El Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo

19 de Junio de 2022

Queridos feligreses,

Feliz y Bendita Fiesta del Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, también conocida en latín como "**Corpus Christi**" ("*El Cuerpo de Cristo*"). Hace casi 2000 años, Jesús tuvo su última Cena con sus apóstoles. *"Porque en la noche en que fue traicionado, Él mismo tomó pan y, dándote gracias, dijo la bendición, partió el pan y se lo dio a sus discípulos, diciendo: 'TOMEN Y COMAN TODOS DE EL, PORQUE ESTO ES MI CUERPO, QUE SERA ENTREGADO POR USTEDES'".* Entonces Jesús tomó el cáliz y dijo palabras similares, *"... PORQUE ESTE ES EL CÁLIZ DE MI SANGRE, HAGAN ESTO EN LA CONMEMORACION MÍA"*. Esta fue la primera Misa Católica, y cada vez que se ofrece el Sacrificio de la Misa, estamos obedeciendo el mandato de Jesús de *"HAGAN ESTO EN MEMORIA DE ÉL"*. El pan y el vino se transforman en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, y se produce un milagro en cada Misa. Aunque la apariencia física del pan y el vino no cambia, sus sustancias sí lo hacen. Es por eso que llamamos a este momento **transubstanciación**, porque las "sustancias" del pan y el vino se "transforman". Esto sucede a través del poder del Espíritu Santo y las propias palabras de Jesús. Escuche las poderosas palabras de San Juan Vianney, cuya estatua está en nuestra iglesia: *"Todas las buenas obras en el mundo no son iguales al Santo Sacrificio de la Misa porque son obras de hombres; pero la Misa es la obra de Dios. El martirio no es nada en comparación, ya que es solo el sacrificio del hombre a Dios, pero la Misa es el sacrificio de Dios por el hombre"*. Podemos crecer en nuestra apreciación de un DON tan grande a través de la **Adoración de Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento**, tomándonos el tiempo para adorar a Jesús en el Tabernáculo de nuestra iglesia, o en cualquier iglesia Católica que podamos visitar. Todos los viernes, tenemos la Adoración Eucarística en nuestro iglesia de 9am a 7pm. De San Juan Vianney: *"Me arrojé al pie del Tabernáculo como un perro al pie de su Maestro"*. Mis hermanos y hermanas, apreciemos siempre este DON de la Presencia Real de Jesús en la Eucaristía, a través de nuestra participación en la Misa, así como con nuestras oraciones en la Iglesia. En este fin de semana del **Día del Padre**, agradezcamos también a Dios nuestro Padre Celestial por todos nuestros "padres": nuestros padres terrenales, nuestros padres espirituales (sacerdotes), nuestros padrinos y todos los hombres que han sido ese buen ejemplo para que nosotros sigamos en nuestro caminar con el Señor. *¡San José, padre adoptivo de Jesús, ruega por nosotros!*

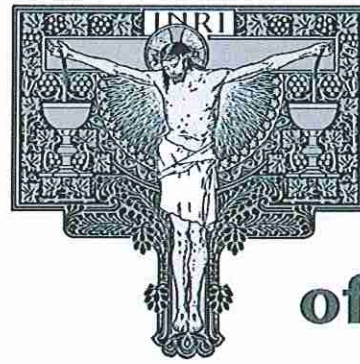
Today is the feast day of the Body and Blood of Jesus.

The Body and Blood of Christ

When Jesus went back to Heaven He didn't want to leave us all alone, so He gave Himself to us in the Holy Eucharist. First He gave Himself to the Apostles at the Last Supper, and today He gives Himself to us in Holy Communion.

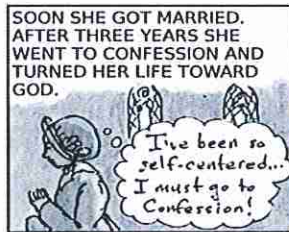
Normally when we eat something it gets absorbed into our body. But receiving Jesus in Holy Communion does something different. It makes us more into Jesus' Body! It brings our soul closer to God and closer to all the other people in the Church. That's what "Communion" means.

When we go to Communion in a state of grace we can get so much more grace from God. Our venial (small) sins can be taken away and we can get more strength to do His will. In fact, the time that your prayers are the most powerful is right after you receive Holy Communion, when Jesus is right inside you. He is your closest friend and only wants what is good for you. When you go to Communion remember Who you just received and don't forget to thank Him for coming to you!

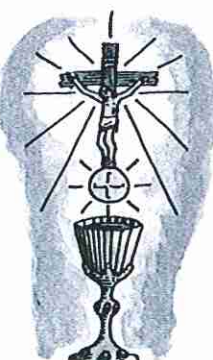
