Summer Reflection

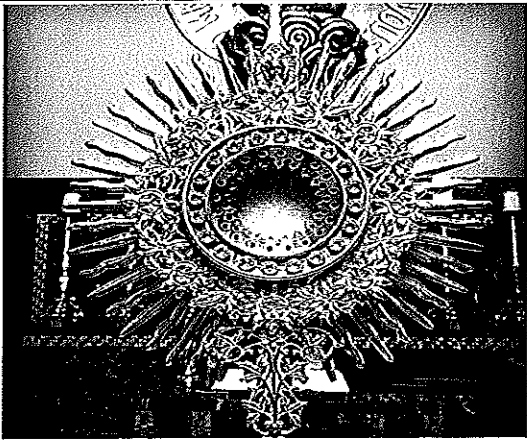

PRAYER IS EVEN BETTER

“Mary has chosen the better portion and she shall not be deprived of it.” —Luke 10:42

Hospitality was a responsibility and privilege highly valued by the Jewish people. In offering hospitality, we may be entertaining angels (Heb 13:2) or even God Himself (Gn 18:17ff). Abraham and Sarah, for example, offered hospitality to God and two angels. As a result, God promised them they would miraculously have a son, although both were almost a hundred years old (see Gn 18:10ff). Hospitality is the breeding ground of promise, blessing, and miracles.

As awesome as hospitality is, Jesus claimed that prayer is even better (Lk 10:42). This was a surprising revelation. Jesus even maintained the necessity of praying always (Lk 18:1; cf 1 Thes 5:17). He did this Himself, praying early in the morning and late at night (Mk 1:35; Lk 22:39ff). Jesus prayed in such a new way that people who had prayed for years asked Him to teach them to pray (Lk 11:1).

After Jesus ascended into heaven, His disciples caught onto Jesus’ message on prayer and “devoted themselves to constant prayer” for nine days (Acts 1:14). The Church was born after this nine-day gestation period of prayer. From that point on, the Spirit has empowered the followers of Jesus to devote themselves to prayer (see Acts 2:42).

Prayer: Jesus, teach me to pray (Lk 11:1). Holy Spirit, help me overcome my weakness in prayer (Rm 8:26).

Promise: “Even now I find my joy in the suffering I endure for you. In my own flesh I fill up what is lacking in the sufferings of Christ for the sake of His body, the church.” —Col 1:24

Praise: “As a proof that the One Whom He raised from the dead would never again see the decay of death, God declared, ‘I will give You the benefits assured to David under the covenant’ ” (Acts 13:34). Alleluia!

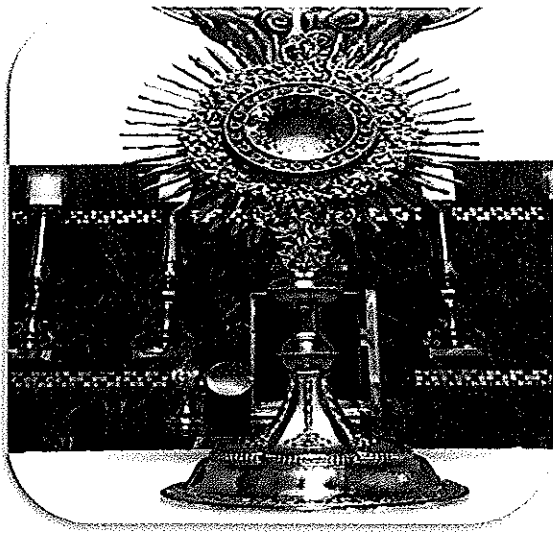

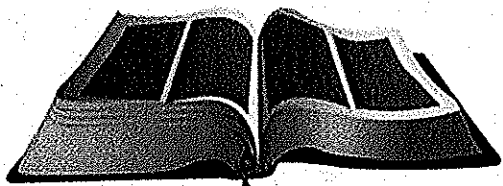




Adoración Eucarística

Gracias a Dios que nos busca y nos llama para conocerle y amarle a través de muchos medios, hoy nos invita a través de cursos Bíblicos, que son un medio eficaz para llegar a muchas familias que a un no conocen del amor de Dios, como cada día Dios transforma nuestras vidas a través de decir solo "si quiero conocerte ". Es para toda la familia todos los Martes a las 7:30 en el sótano de la parroquia.

LA ORACIÓN ES AÚN MEJOR

"María eligió la mejor parte que no le será quitada" (Lucas 10:42).

La hospitalidad fue una responsabilidad y un privilegio muy valorado por el pueblo judío. Al ofrecer hospitalidad, podemos estar entreteniendo a ángeles (Heb 13:2) o incluso a Dios mismo (Gn 18:17ss). Abraham y Sara, por ejemplo, ofrecieron hospitalidad a Dios y a dos ángeles. Como resultado, Dios les prometió que milagrosamente tendrían un hijo, aunque ambos tenían casi cien años (ver Gn 18:10ss). La hospitalidad es el caldo de cultivo de promesas, bendiciones y milagros.

Tan impresionante es la hospitalidad, que Jesús afirmó que la oración es aún mejor (Lc 10:42). Esta fue una revelación sorprendente. Jesús mantuvo la necesidad de orar siempre (Lc 18:1; ver 1 Tes 5:17). Él mismo hizo esto, orando temprano en la mañana y tarde en la noche (Mc 1:35; Lc 22:39ss). Jesús oró de una manera tan nueva que las personas que habían orado durante años le pidieron que les enseñara a orar (Lc 11:1).

Después de que Jesús ascendió al cielo, sus discípulos captaron el mensaje de Jesús sobre la oración y "se dedicaron a la oración constante" durante nueve días (Hch 1:14). La Iglesia nació después de este período de oración de nueve días de gestación. A partir de ese momento, el Espíritu ha dado poder a los seguidores de Jesús para que se dediquen a la oración (ver Hch 2:42).

Oración: Jesús, enséñame a orar (Lc 11:1). Espíritu Santo, ayúdame a superar mi debilidad en la oración (Rom 8:26).

Promesa: "Ahora me alegro de poder sufrir por ustedes, y completo en mi carne lo que falta a los padecimientos de Cristo, para bien de Su Cuerpo, que es la Iglesia" (Col 1:24).

Alabanza: "Que Dios lo ha resucitado de entre los muertos y que no habrá de someterse a la corrupción, es lo que el mismo Dios ha declarado diciendo: 'Cumpliré las santas promesas hechas a David, aquellas que no pueden fallar'" (Hch 13:34). ¡Aleluya!

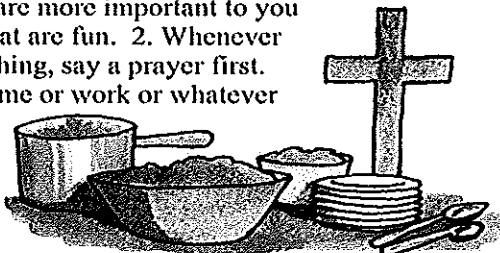

Putting Jesus First

Jesus went to Martha and Mary's house for dinner one day and while Martha got the food ready her sister Mary just sat near Jesus to listen to Him. Martha was upset because she had so much work to do and Mary wasn't helping at all. It doesn't sound quite fair, does it?

But Jesus told Martha that there was only one thing that was important, and that Mary had chosen it. Mary had chosen to be with Him and listen to Him. Martha was concerned about all the details- making good food and setting things out nicely, but she wasn't thinking about Jesus.

Jesus was not saying that cooking or working in the house is bad. He was only showing Martha and Mary that we need to put God first in everything. Here are a couple of ways you can keep God first: 1. Always make sure that things like going to Mass and saying your prayers are more important to you than things that are fun. 2. Whenever you do something, say a prayer first. Offer your game or work or whatever you are doing for the glory of God.

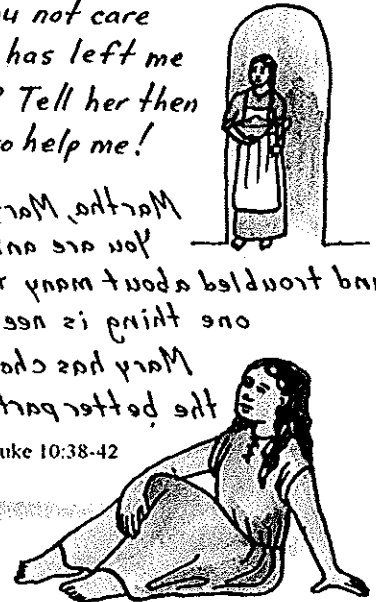

SAINT LAWRENCE OF BRINDISI JULY 21

LAWRENCE WAS BORN IN ITALY IN 1559 AND WAS BAPTIZED WITH THE NAME JULIUS CAESAR. HIS PARENTS DIED WHEN HE WAS QUITE YOUNG.

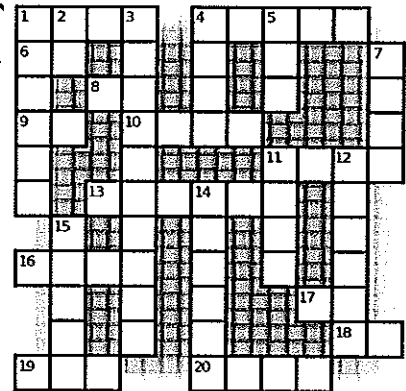
Father, we need you to come. There's a big argument.
