

**29TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME
OCTOBER 17, 2021**

Dear Parishioners,

This past Monday, October 12th, was the Feast Day of **Blessed Carlos Acutis**. Carlo was born in London, England, on May 3, 1991 to parents from Milan, Italy. He was a pious child, attending daily Mass, frequently praying the rosary, and making weekly confessions. Carlo's mother, Antonia Salzano, said that, "*Jesus was the center of his day. He really had Jesus in his heart, really the pureness*". Priests and nuns would tell her that the Lord had a special plan for her son. Carlo did little things with faithfulness, love and joy. He was filled with a burning love for the Lord, especially in the Eucharist. His friends remember him saying, "*Every day I live the Holy Communion as a constant dialogue with Jesus, as an authentic hope. The Eucharist is my freeway to heaven!*" Carlo Acutis is most remembered for documenting Eucharistic miracles from all over the world, dating back from medieval times right up to those that took place just a few years ago. All of his work is available on a [website](#) that he built before he died. In addition to his love for the Lord and his programming and computer skills, Carlo loved to play video games and soccer. He also had a great love for others. His mother said: "*His immense generosity made him interested in everyone: the foreigners, the handicapped, children, beggars. To be close to Carlo was to be close to a fountain of fresh water*". Carlo was continually filled with joy and was very kind and generous to those around him. Carlo said: "*Think of Jesus as one among you, your best friend or your brother, as well as a man who needs your help. To me being a Christian is to observe the world and bring my joy, my strength to others...If you see a friend struggling, help him or her, don't leave them alone, don't close your eyes*". After being diagnosed with leukemia, Carlo offered all his suffering up for the Church and for the Pope. During his illness, he said: "*I'm happy to die because I've lived my life without wasting even a minute of it doing things that wouldn't have pleased God*". Carlo died of leukemia at the age of 15 years old. **Blessed Carlos Acutis, pray for us!** God bless!






GOOD AND BAD SUFFERING

“Through His suffering, My Servant shall justify many, and their guilt He shall bear.” —Isaiah 53:11
 The Lord removes some sufferings from our lives to make room for other sufferings which are redemptive. He heals us to free us to be vulnerable and exposed to hurt. He gives us the grace to love ourselves, so we have courage to be hated and persecuted for the sake of the Gospel (see 2 Tm 1:8). He blesses us with self-acceptance and a good self-image so we will be able to suffer rejection and contempt. Jesus wants to forgive and heal us, and thereby deliver us from all useless suffering. “He went about doing good works and healing all who were in the grip of the devil” (Acts 10:38). Jesus has declared war on sickness, suffering, and bondage. “It was to destroy the devil’s works that the Son of God revealed Himself” (1 Jn 3:8). This does not mean that suffering has no part in God’s plan of salvation. Suffering in the pattern of Jesus’ death is good, redemptive, and to be sought after in prayer (Phil 3:10). This suffering is for the kingdom (2 Thes 1:5) and fills up what is lacking in the sufferings of Christ for the sake of His Body, the Church (Col 1:24).

Prayer: Jesus, I ask to suffer and know how to suffer in the pattern of Your death (Phil 3:10).

Promise: “For we do not have a High Priest Who is unable to sympathize with our weakness, but One Who was tempted in every way that we are, yet never sinned.” —Heb 4:15

Praise: “Indeed, this is the will of My Father, that everyone who looks upon the Son and believes in Him shall have eternal life. Him I will raise up on the last day” (Jn 6:40). Praise Jesus!

SUFRIMIENTOS BUENOS Y MALOS

“Mi Servidor justo justificará a muchos y cargará sobre sí las faltas de ellos” (Isaías 53:11).

El Señor quita algunos sufrimientos de nuestras vidas para dejar lugar a otros sufrimientos que son redentores. Él nos sana para liberarnos de ser vulnerables y estar expuestos al dolor. Él nos da la gracia de amarnos a nosotros mismos, para que tengamos el valor de ser odiados y perseguidos por causa del Evangelio (ver 2 Tim 1:8). Nos bendice con la auto aceptación y una buena imagen de nosotros mismos para que podamos sufrir el rechazo y el desprecio. Jesús quiere perdonarnos y curarnos, y así librarnos de todo sufrimiento inútil. “El pasó haciendo el bien y curando a todos los que habían caído en poder del demonio” (Hch 10:38). Jesús ha declarado la guerra a la enfermedad, el sufrimiento y la servidumbre. “Y el Hijo de Dios se manifestó para destruir las obras del demonio” (1 Jn 3:8). Esto no significa que el sufrimiento no forme parte del plan de salvación de Dios. Sufrir en el patrón de la muerte de Jesús es bueno, redentor y debe ser buscado en la oración (Fil 3:10). Este sufrimiento es por el reino (2 Tes 1:5) y llena lo que falta en los sufrimientos de Cristo por el bien de Su Cuerpo, la Iglesia (Col 1:24). Jesús pregunta: “¿Pueden beber el cáliz que Yo beberé y recibir el bautismo que Yo recibiré?” (Mc 10:38)

Oración: Jesús, te pido sufrir y saber como sufrir en el patrón de Tu muerte (Fil 3:10).

Promesa: “Porque no tenemos un Sumo Sacerdote incapaz de compadecerse de nuestras debilidades; al contrario, Él fue sometido a las mismas pruebas que nosotros, a excepción del pecado” (Heb 4:15).

Alabanza: “Esta es la voluntad de Mi Padre: que el que ve al Hijo y cree en Él, tenga Vida eterna y que Yo lo resucite en el último día” (Jn 6:40). ¡Alabado sea Jesús! Presentation Ministries

DOMINGO 29 DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO OCTUBRE 17, 2021

Queridos feligreses,

El pasado lunes, 12 de Octubre, fue la Fiesta del **Beato Carlos Acutis**. Carlo nació en Londres, Inglaterra, el 3 de Mayo de 1991 de padres de Milán, Italia. Era un niño piadoso, asistía a Misa todos los días, rezaba el Rosario con frecuencia y hacía Confesiones semanales. La madre de Carlo, Antonia Salzano, dijo que *"Jesús fue el centro de su día. Realmente tenía a Jesús en su corazón, realmente la pureza"*. Los sacerdotes y las monjas le decían que el Señor tenía un plan especial para su hijo. Carlo hacía pequeñas cosas con fidelidad, amor y alegría. Estaba lleno de un amor ardiente por el Señor, especialmente en la Eucaristía. Sus amigos lo recuerdan diciendo: *"Todos los días vivió la Sagrada Comunión como un diálogo constante con Jesús, como una auténtica esperanza. ¡La Eucaristía es mi camino al cielo!"* Carlo Acutis es más recordado por documentar los milagros Eucarísticos de todo el mundo, que se remontan desde la época medieval hasta los que tuvieron lugar hace apenas unos años. Todo su trabajo está disponible en un sitio web que construyó antes de morir. Además de su amor por el Señor y sus habilidades en programación y computación, a Carlo le encantaba jugar videojuegos y fútbol. También tenía un gran amor por los demás. Su madre dijo: *"Su inmensa generosidad hizo que se interesara por todos: los extranjeros, los discapacitados, los niños, los mendigos. Estar cerca de Carlo era estar cerca de una fuente de agua dulce"*. Carlo estaba continuamente lleno de alegría y era muy amable y generoso con quienes lo rodeaban. Carlo dijo: *"Piensa en Jesús como uno entre ustedes, su mejor amigo o su hermano, así como un hombre que necesita su ayuda. Para mí ser cristiano es observar el mundo y llevar mi alegría, mi fuerza a los demás... Si ves a un amigo luchando, ayúdalo, no lo dejes solo, no cierras los ojos"*. Después de ser diagnosticado con leucemia, Carlo ofreció todo su sufrimiento por la Iglesia y por el Papa. Durante su enfermedad, dijo: *"Estoy feliz de morir porque he vivido mi vida sin perder ni un minuto haciendo cosas que no agradarían a Dios"*. Carlo murió de leucemia a la edad de 15 años. **Beato Carlos Acutis, ¡ruega por nosotros!**





Great People Serve Others!


In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells us that the people who are really great are those who serve. Here are some really great people:


