Second Sunday of Advent February 28, 2021

Dear Parishioners,

On December 8, 2020, Pope Francis declared a special Year of St. Joseph to run through December 8, 2021. This marks the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX. Pope Francis began the year with a new Apostolic Letter entitled *Patris Corde (With a Father's Heart)*. Pope Francis said he was establishing the year so that "every member of the faithful, following his example, may strengthen their life of faith daily in the complete fulfillment of God's will." Pope Francis said the coronavirus pandemic has heightened his desire to reflect on St. Joseph, as so many people during the pandemic have made hidden sacrifices to protect others, just as St. Joseph quietly protected and cared for Mary and Jesus. "Each of us can discover in Joseph - the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence - an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble," the pope wrote. He also said he wanted to highlight St. Joseph's role as a father who served his family with charity and humility, adding, "Our world today needs fathers." Over the next few months, I will be sharing from Pope Francis' Apostolic Letter on Saint Joseph. Also, there will be a vigil candle in front of the statue of Saint Joseph that will be lit each week for a different family of our Parish and their intentions. IN GOD WE TRUST?

“God put Abraham to the test.” —Genesis 22:1 Lent is a season of being put to the test (see Mt 4:1; Gn 22:1). God, “the Tester of our hearts” (1 Thes 2:4), brings us to obedience school this Lent. He is testing us to see if we trust His promises or if our hearts are far from Him and we’ve just been giving Him “lip service” (Mk 7:6). Three days ago, the Church proclaimed Jesus’ promise that God wants to provide our needs (Mt 7:7-11). Tomorrow Jesus promises us that if we give, God will provide for us lavishly (Lk 6:38). Do we believe God and His promises? Our lifestyle tells Him whether or not we trust His promises. For example, Abraham trusted God for his family even when he couldn’t see a way out of the test (Heb 11:8ff). This Lent, many are also being tested in the area of conceiving another child. Others will pay more attention to their financial situation or how much energy they have and pay little attention to God and His promises to provide for them. While it is wise to make prudent decisions (see Lk 14:28), this test is not about prudence. It is about trusting God and abandoning yourself into His hands. You can trust every one of God’s promises (Jos 23:14; 2 Cor 1:20). “No test has been sent you that does not come to all men. Besides, God keeps His promise. He will not let you be tested beyond your strength. Along with the test He will give you a way out of it so that you may be able to endure it” (1 Cor 10:13). The exam is beginning. Pass the trust test

Prayer: Father, the money in my pocket proclaims, “In God we trust.” May my life of trust in You speak louder than my money.

Promise: “If God is for us, who can be against us?” — Rm 8:31

Praise: “You need not be amazed! You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, the One Who was crucified. He has been raised up; He is not here. See the place where they laid Him” (Mk 16:6). Praise Jesus!

¿EN DIOS CONFIAMOS?

“Dios puso a prueba a Abraham” (Génesis 22:1).

La Cuaresma es una temporada para ser puesto a prueba (ver Mt 4:1; Gn 22:1). Dios, “que examina nuestros corazones” (1 Tes 2:4), nos lleva a la escuela de obediencia en esta Cuaresma. Él nos está probando para ver si confiamos en Sus promesas o si nuestros corazones están lejos de Él y hemos estado “honrando con los labios” (Mc 7:6). Hace tres días, la Iglesia proclamó la promesa de Jesús de que Dios quiere satisfacer nuestras necesidades (Mt 7:7-11). Mañana Jesús nos promete que, si damos, Dios nos proveerá generosamente (Lc 6:38). ¿Creemos a Dios y Sus promesas? Nuestro estilo de vida le dice si confiamos o no en Sus promesas. Por ejemplo, Abraham confió en Dios para su familia incluso cuando no pudo ver una salida de la prueba (Heb 11:8ss). Esta Cuaresma, muchos están siendo probados en el área de concebir otro hijo. Algunos prestarán más atención a su situación financiera o cuánta energía tienen y prestarán poca atención a Dios y Sus promesas de proveerles. Si bien es aconsejable tomar decisiones prudentes (ver Lc 14:28), esta prueba no se trata de prudencia. Se trata de confiar en Dios y abandonarse en Sus manos. Puedes confiar en cada una de las promesas de Dios (Jos 23:14; 2 Co 1:20) “Hasta ahora, ustedes no tuvieron tentaciones que superen sus fuerzas humanas. Dios es fiel, y Él no permitirá que sean tentados más allá de sus fuerzas. Al contrario, en el momento de la tentación, les dará el medio de librarse de ella, y los ayudará a soportarla” (1 Co 10:13). El examen está comenzando. Pasa la prueba de confianza.

Oración: Padre, el dinero en mi bolsillo proclama: “En Dios confiamos”. Que mi vida de confianza en Ti hable más fuerte que mi dinero.

Promesa: “Si Dios está con nosotros, ¿quién estará contra nosotros?” (Rom 8:31)

Alabanza: “No teman. Ustedes buscan a Jesús de Nazaret, el Crucificado. Ha resucitado, no está aquí. Miren el lugar donde lo habían puesto” (Mc 16:6). ¡Alabado sea Jesús!

Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma *Febrero 28, 2021*

Queridos feligreses,

El 8 de Diciembre de 2020, el Papa Francisco declaró un Año especial de San José hasta el 8 de Diciembre de 2021. Esto marca el 150 aniversario de la declaración de San José como Patrón de la Iglesia Universal por el Papa Pío IX. El Papa Francisco comenzó el año con una nueva Carta Apostólica titulada *Patris Corde (Con corazón de padre)*. El Papa Francisco dijo que estaba estableciendo el año para que *"cada miembro de los fieles, siguiendo su ejemplo, pueda fortalecer su vida de fe diariamente en el pleno cumplimiento de la voluntad de Dios"*. El Papa Francisco dijo que la pandemia de coronavirus ha aumentado su deseo de reflexionar sobre San José, ya que muchas personas durante la pandemia han hecho sacrificios ocultos para proteger a otros, al igual que San José protegió y cuidó en silencio a María y Jesús. *"Cada uno de nosotros puede descubrir en José, el hombre que pasa desapercibido, una presencia diaria, discreta y oculta, un intercesor, un apoyo y un guía en tiempos de angustia"*, escribió el Papa. También dijo que quería resaltar el papel de San José como un padre que sirvió a su familia con caridad y humildad, y agregó: *"Nuestro mundo de hoy necesita padres"*. Durante los próximos meses, compartiré la carta apostólica del Papa Francisco sobre San José. **También, habrá una vela de vigilia frente a la estatua de San José que se encenderá cada semana por una familia diferente de nuestra Parroquia y sus intenciones. 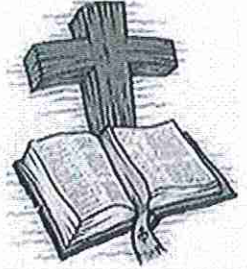

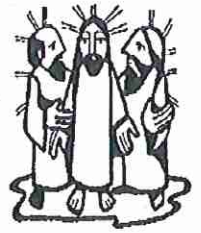
