Dear Parishioners,

I have some BIG NEWS to share with you! I have been appointed as the Pastor of Saint Mary's Church here in Pawtucket, while CONTINUING as your Pastor here at Saint John the Baptist Church. Also, I have been given an Assistant Pastor to help me with both parishes. Our new Assistant Pastor is Fr. Brendan Rowley. This new assignment for both of us will begin next weekend, on the Feast of Christ the King (November 20/21). What will change here in our parish? The schedule will not need to change at all. Fr. Rowley and myself will alternate the weekend Masses in English at both parishes. For example, next weekend, I will celebrate the 4pm Saturday Vigil Mass and the 9am Sunday Mass at St. Mary's, while Fr. Rowley will celebrate the 4:30pm Saturday Vigil Mass and 9:30am Sunday Mass here at our parish. Fr. Rowley doesn't know Spanish, so I will continue to celebrate both weekend Masses here in Spanish. The Confession times will remain the same on Saturdays at 3:30pm - 4:20pm, and from 5:30pm - 5:50pm. One of us priests will be available at those times, while the other will hear Confessions at St. Mary's from 3pm - 3:50pm. Both of our salaries will be split between both parishes, which probably means that we will save some money here, because our salaries are based on the number of years ordained as priests (18 years for me, and 2 years for Fr. Rowley). I believe that this new assignment for both Fr. Rowley and myself will benefit both our parish and St. Mary's Parish, since now, there will be two priests working at each parish. Please pray for both of us, as we continue to serve you as your priests, and as a parish family, we continue our pilgrimage together to the Kingdom of Heaven. God Bless!

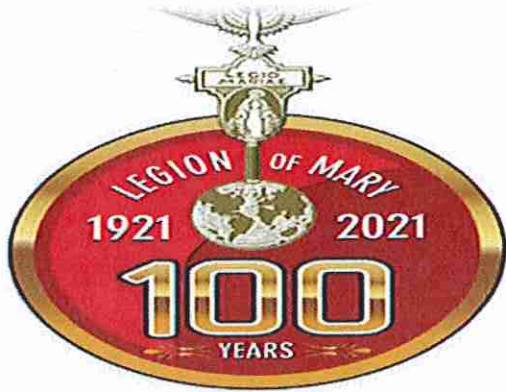

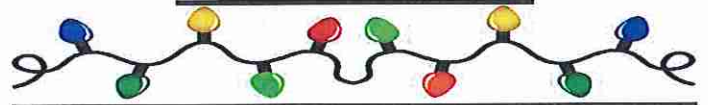

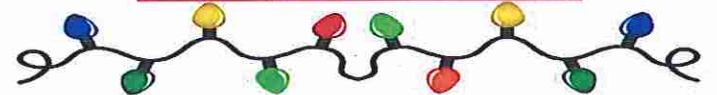

¡Tengo GRANDES NOTICIAS para compartir con ustedes! Fui nombrado Pastor de la Iglesia de Santa María aquí en Pawtucket, mientras CONTINUO como su Pastor aquí en la Iglesia de San Juan Bautista. Además, se me ha dado un pastor asistente para que me ayude con ambas parroquias. **Nuestro nuevo pastor asistente es el Padre Brendan Rowley.** Esta nueva asignación para ambos comenzará el próximo fin de semana, en la Fiesta de Cristo Rey (20/21 de Noviembre). ¿Qué cambiará aquí en nuestra parroquia? El horario no tendrá que cambiar en absoluto. Padre Rowley y yo alternaremos las Misas de fin de semana en inglés en ambas parroquias. Por ejemplo, el próximo fin de semana, celebraré la Misa de vigilia del sábado a las 4 p.m. y la Misa del Domingo a las 9 a.m. en St. Mary's, mientras que el Padre Rowley celebrará la Misa de vigilia del Sábado a las 4:30 pm y la Misa del Domingo a las 9:30 am aquí en nuestra parroquia. *Padre Rowley no sabe español, así que continuaré celebrando las dos Misas de fin de semana aquí en español.* El horario de las Confesiones seguirá siendo el mismo los sábados de 3:30 pm a 4:20 pm y de 5:30 pm a 5:50 pm. Uno de nosotros, sacerdotes, estará disponible en esos momentos, mientras que el otro escuchará Confesiones en St. Mary's de 3:00 p.m. a 3:50 p.m. Nuestros dos salarios se dividirán entre ambas parroquias, lo que probablemente significa que ahorraremos algo de dinero aquí, porque nuestros salarios se basan en la cantidad de años ordenados como sacerdotes (18 años para mí y 2 años para el Padre Rowley). Creo que este nuevo encargo tanto para el Padre Rowley y yo beneficiaremos tanto a nuestra parroquia como a la parroquia de St. Mary, ya que ahora habrá dos sacerdotes trabajando en cada parroquia. Ore por los dos, mientras continuamos sirviéndoles como sus sacerdotes, y como familia parroquial, continuamos nuestro peregrinaje juntos al Reino de los Cielos. ¡Dios les bendiga!

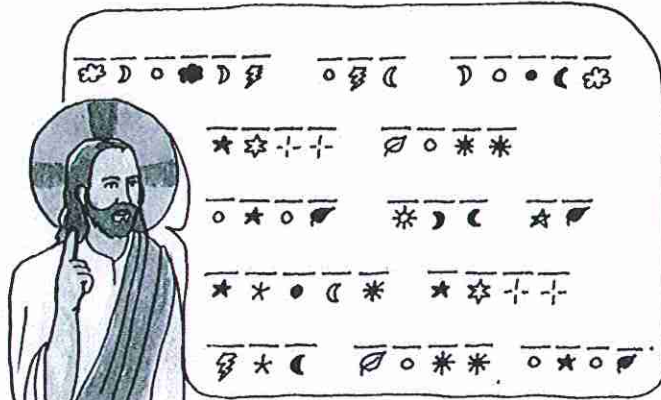
The End...

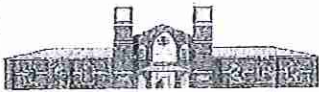
