Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord

January 7, 2024

Dear Parishioners,

The Magi have finally arrived at the Creche! As you may have noticed over the past few weeks in the church, the three kings have been inching closer and closer to the Manger. Today, as we celebrate **the Feast of the Epiphany** (meaning "manifestation"), their journey ended as they were led by the star to where Joseph and Mary were with their newborn Child. The Magi from the East had an "epiphany" as Jesus was "manifested" to them. They came to the Creche with their three gifts of frankincense, gold, and myrrh for the Child Jesus. The gold represented the Divinity of Jesus, the frankincense represented the Kingship of Jesus, and the myrrh represented Jesus' humanity. **There is so much to contemplate on this Feast of the Epiphany**, as we continue to celebrate our Lord's Birth.

First and foremost, we contemplate the fact that we are all still on a journey back to our Father in Heaven. Even the Magi were still on a journey after the initial meeting with Baby Jesus. Daily, they had to renew their relationship with Him, just like we must do every day, until we finally arrive Home and are with our Lord in Heaven. Secondly, on this Feast of the Epiphany, we contemplate the fact that Jesus is the Savior for all. When He was manifested to the Magi, who were Gentiles, the Lord showed that salvation is a gift for anyone who truly accepts Jesus into their lives, which happens through the Sacraments of our Catholic Church. Finally, on this Feast of the Epiphany, we contemplate those three gifts that the Magi brought before the Lord. We bring the Lord our three gifts of "time, talent, and treasure", as we worship Him as a parish community. Spiritually, physically, and financially, we can show our love for God and one another. May we continue to draw closer to Jesus our Newborn King as we begin this new year of 2024. God bless!

THE WISDOM OF ABANDONMENT

“Nations shall walk by your light, and kings by your shining radiance.” — Isaiah 60:3

Wise men and women, like the wise men of the first Christmas, prostrate themselves before Jesus, do Him homage, and give themselves to Him (Mt 2:11). This total abandonment is not a one-time experience, but a way of life — forever.

Wise men and women are great-souled individuals who begrudge nothing to God. They're not looking for the quickest Mass to fulfill their Sunday obligation. Rather, they consider it a privilege to worship the Lord as long as possible. Wise men and women don't ask if they have to go to Confession annually, but they rejoice in celebrating frequently the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Wise men and women consider it a privilege to share their faith in Jesus, especially in situations where they may be persecuted (see Acts 5:41; 13:52). Wisdom is not doing the minimum but always searching for new opportunities to surrender to the love and will of God. Wise men and women transcend their natural inclinations to selfishness, laziness, and fear. They live supernaturally — by grace through faith (Eph 2:8, RSV-CE).

The Lord wants to make you a wise man or woman. Are you willing to become wise, to follow the star, to give all to Jesus?

Prayer: Father, on this Epiphany, give me the fear of the Lord, which is the beginning of wisdom (see Ps 111:10).

Promise: “See, darkness covers the earth, and thick clouds cover the peoples; but upon

you the Lord shines, and over you appears His glory.” —Is 60:2

Praise: Praise Jesus, “manifested in the flesh, vindicated in the Spirit; seen by the angels; preached among the Gentiles, believed in throughout the world, taken up into glory” (1 Tm 3:16).

Epiphany Blessing of the Home



It has been a tradition in the Catholic Church to bless chalk at the Masses for Epiphany, and then use the blessed chalk as part of blessing one's home in the New Year. The home blessing can be done as follows: Use the blessed chalk to write 20+C+M+B+24 above the doorways. 2024 for the year; C, M, B for the Magi—Casper, Melchior, and Balthasar—and for "Christus Mansionem Benedicat", Latin for "May Christ Bless this House." As you are writing, pray the following prayer: *"May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, that same Jesus who is Lord, forever and ever. Amen."*

Please make sure to pick up your **budget envelopes** as well as the **calendar** for this year as you leave church this weekend.

Epifanía Bendición de la Casa

Ha sido una tradición en la Iglesia Católica bendecir la tiza en las Misas para la Epifanía, y luego usar la tiza bendita como parte de la bendición del hogar en el Año Nuevo. La bendición del hogar se puede hacer de la siguiente manera: Use la tiza bendecida para escribir 20 + C + M + B + 24 sobre las puertas. 2023 para el año; C, M, B para los Reyes Magos (Casper, Melchior y Balthasar) y para "Christus Mansionem Benedicat", en latín para "Que Cristo bendiga esta casa". Mientras escribe, ore la siguiente oración: *"Que todos los que vengan a nuestro hogar este año se regocija al encontrar a Cristo viviendo entre nosotros; y que busquemos y sirvamos, en todos los que encontramos, ese mismo Jesús que es Señor, por los siglos de los siglos. Amén."*

Solemnidad de la Epifanía del Señor ***7 de enero, 2024***

Queridos feligreses,
¡Los Reyes Magos finalmente han llegado al pesebre! Como habrás notado en las últimas semanas en la iglesia, los tres reyes se han acercado cada vez más al pesebre. Hoy, cuando celebramos **la Fiesta de la Epifanía** (que significa "manifestación"), su viaje terminó cuando fueron guiados por la estrella a donde estaban José y María con su Hijo recién nacido. Los magos de Oriente tuvieron una "epifanía" cuando Jesús se les "manifestó". Llegaron al pesebre con sus tres regalos de incienso, oro y mirra para el Niño Jesús. El oro representaba la Divinidad de Jesús, el incienso representaba la realeza de Jesús, y la mirra representaba la humanidad de Jesús. **Hay mucho que contemplar en esta Fiesta de la Epifanía**, mientras continuamos celebrando el Nacimiento de nuestro Señor. *En primer lugar, contemplamos el hecho de que todos estamos todavía en un viaje de regreso a nuestro Padre Celestial.* Incluso los Reyes Magos seguían en viaje después del encuentro inicial con el Niño Jesús. Diariamente, tenían que renovar su relación con Él, tal como lo debemos hacer todos los días, hasta que finalmente lleguemos a casa y estemos con Nuestro Señor en el Cielo. *En segundo lugar, en esta Fiesta de la Epifanía, contemplamos el hecho de que Jesús es el Salvador de todos.* Cuando se manifestó a los Reyes Magos, que eran Gentiles, el Señor mostró que la salvación es un regalo para cualquiera que realmente acepte a Jesús en sus vidas, lo que sucede a través de los Sacramentos de nuestra Iglesia Católica. *Finalmente, en esta Fiesta de la Epifanía, contemplamos esos tres regalos que los Reyes Magos trajeron ante el Señor.* Le traemos al Señor nuestros tres dones de "tiempo, talento y tesoro", mientras lo adoramos como comunidad parroquial. Espiritual, física y financieramente, podemos mostrar nuestro amor por Dios y por los demás. Que sigamos acercándonos a Jesús, nuestro Rey recién nacido, al comenzar este año nuevo de 2024. ¡Dios los bendiga!

LA SABIDURÍA DEL ABANDONO

"Las naciones caminarán a Tu luz y los reyes, al esplendor de Tu aurora" (Isaías 60:3).

Los sabios, como los sabios de la primera Navidad, se postran ante Jesús, le rinden homenaje y se entregan a Él (Mt 2:11). Este abandono total no es una experiencia de una sola vez, sino una forma de vida, para siempre.

Los hombres y mujeres sabios son individuos de gran alma que no le envidian nada a Dios. No están buscando la misa más rápida para cumplir con su obligación dominical. Más bien, consideran un privilegio adorar al Señor el mayor tiempo posible. Los hombres y mujeres sabios no preguntan si tienen que ir a la confesión anual, pero se regocijan en celebrar con frecuencia el Sacramento de la Reconciliación. Los hombres y mujeres sabios consideran un privilegio compartir su fe en Jesús, especialmente en situaciones en las que pueden ser perseguidos (ver Hch 5:41; 13:52). La sabiduría no es hacer lo mínimo, sino buscar siempre nuevas oportunidades para rendirse al amor y la voluntad de Dios. Los hombres y mujeres sabios trascienden sus inclinaciones naturales al egoísmo, la pereza y el miedo. Viven sobrenaturalmente, por gracia mediante la fe (Ef 2:8).

El Señor quiere hacerte un hombre sabio o una mujer sabia. ¿Estás dispuesto a ser sabio, a seguir la estrella, a darlo todo a Jesús?

Oración: Padre, en esta Epifanía, dame el temor del Señor, que es el principio de la sabiduría (ver Sal 111:10).

Promesa: "Porque las tinieblas cubren la tierra y una densa oscuridad, a las naciones, pero sobre ti brillará el Señor y su gloria aparecerá sobre ti" (Is 60:2).

Alabanza: Alabado sea Jesús, "se manifestó en la carne, fue justificado en el Espíritu; contemplado por los ángeles; proclamado a los paganos, creído en el mundo, elevado a la gloria" (1 Tim 3:16).


The Magi Come to Worship Jesus
