Dear Parishioners,

I love sports. I grew up both playing and watching many different sports. The best part of any sport is the **victory**, and the celebration that follows it. This Monday we celebrate the victory of Jesus' death and Resurrection over sin, death, and the devil, and the sharing in that victory, through the **Assumption of our Blessed Mother** body and soul into Heaven. On November 1st, 1950, in the Apostolic Constitution Munificentissimus Deus, Pope Pius XII **infallibly** declared: "*after having completed the course of her earthly life, Mary was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory*". He said "*that what is commemorated in this feast of the Assumption of Mary is not simply the total absence of corruption from the dead body of the Blessed Virgin Mary but also her triumph over death and her glorification in Heaven, after the pattern set by her only Son, Jesus Christ*". In this beautiful document, Pope Pius XII uses the word "**victory**" many times, in speaking of Jesus' victory over sin and death with His Crucifixion and Resurrection, as well as our Blessed Mother sharing in this **victory** of her Son through being assumed body and soul into Heaven. The Lord wants us also to share in His Victory over sin and death. He desires that we seek a closer relationship with Him every day, so that we may share Eternal Life with Him forever in Heaven. We can accomplish this through a greater devotion to our Blessed Mother Mary. As our guide, intercessor, and example, our Blessed Mother can help us draw closer to her Son Jesus and the Kingdom of Heaven, avoiding the occasions and temptations of sin. Mary's sole desire for each one of us, is to lead us to Heaven, to share in that **victory** of her Son Jesus over sin, death, and the devil. Let us ask our Blessed Mother to pray for us, and let us imitate her faithful example here on earth – her holiness and devotion to the Lord; her virtues of humility, kindness toward others, patience, love for those who are difficult to love; her silence and refraining from gossip and talking about others; her constant attitude of gratitude, praise, and thanksgiving to God; and her constant "yes" to the Will of God in her life. Mary will help us get to Heaven if we allow her to lead us. The devil will throw obstacles in our way, trying to lead us astray, and to distract us from the path to Eternal Life. We just need to call on Mary, and ask her to help us: "*Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen*". God Bless!

ADD WATER

“There was no water in the cistern, only mud, and Jeremiah sank into the mud.” — Jeremiah 38:6

“No water, only mud” — is that a description of your life? Are you in a hole, sinking in the mud, starving to death spiritually? (see Jer 38:9) You need to add water to turn your mud into a mud puddle, and your mud puddle into a fountain of living waters (see Jn 4:14).

Most of us have already received the life-giving waters of Baptism, but we should renew our baptismal promises. We have already done that on Easter Sunday, but maybe we didn't realize what we were doing or have stifled the Spirit since then (see 1 Thes 5:19). So let's renew our baptismal promises and let the living waters flow and lift us out of the mud of sin.

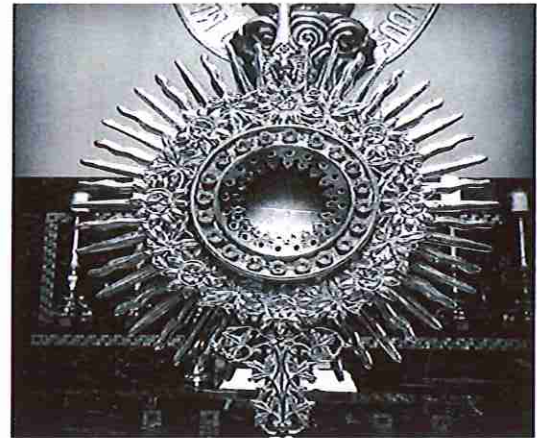
Jesus proclaimed that He had a Baptism to receive (Lk 12:50). By this, He was referring to the Baptism in the bath of pain on Calvary (see Mk 10:38). When we renew our baptismal promises, we are also committing ourselves to suffer with Jesus and for love of Him. Aware of the suffering involved, renew your baptismal promises now. Reject Satan, his works, and his empty promises. Profess your faith in your loving Father; in Jesus as your Savior, Lord, and God; and in the Holy Spirit. Sprinkle yourself with holy water. Get out of the mud, out of sin, and out of prison. By faith, add water.

Prayer: Father, as the deer “longs for the running waters, so my soul longs for You, O God” (Ps 42:2)

Promise: “Remember how He endured the opposition of sinners; hence do not grow despondent or abandon the struggle.” —Heb 12:3

Praise: Praise You, Jesus our Savior! Your love washes us clean, and You lead us to risen life. Alleluia! Presentations Ministries

Queridos feligreses,
Amo los deportes. Crecí jugando y viendo muchos deportes diferentes. La mejor parte de cualquier deporte es la victoria y la celebración que le sigue. Este lunes celebramos la victoria de la Muerte y Resurrección de Jesús sobre el pecado, la muerte y el diablo, y la participación en esa victoria, a través de la Asunción de nuestra Santísima Madre, cuerpo y alma al Cielo. El primer de Noviembre de 1950, en la Constitución Apostólica Munificentissimus Deus, el Papa Pío XII declaró infaliblemente: "después de haber completado el curso de su vida terrenal, María asumió cuerpo y alma en la gloria celestial". Él dijo "que lo que se conmemora en esta fiesta de la Asunción de María no es simplemente la ausencia total de corrupción del cadáver de la Santísima Virgen María, sino también su triunfo sobre la muerte y su glorificación en el Cielo, después del patrón establecido por ella Hijo único, Jesucristo". En este hermoso documento, el Papa Pío XII usa la palabra "victoria" muchas veces, al hablar de la victoria de Jesús sobre el pecado y la muerte con Su crucifixión y resurrección, así como a nuestra Santísima Madre compartiendo esta victoria de su Hijo al asumir el cuerpo y alma al cielo. El Señor quiere que también compartamos su victoria sobre el pecado y la muerte. Él desea que busquemos una relación más cercana con Él todos los días, para que podamos compartir la Vida Eterna con Él para siempre en el Cielo. Podemos lograr esto a través de una mayor devoción a nuestra Santísima Madre María. Como nuestra guía, intercesora y ejemplo, nuestra Santísima Madre puede ayudarnos a acercarnos a su Hijo Jesús y al Reino de los Cielos, evitando las ocasiones y las tentaciones del pecado. El único deseo de María para cada uno de nosotros es llevarnos al Cielo, a compartir esa victoria de su Hijo Jesús sobre el pecado, la muerte y el diablo. Pidámosle a nuestra Santísima Madre que ore por nosotros, e imitemos su fiel ejemplo aquí en la tierra: su santidad y devoción al Señor; sus virtudes de humildad, amabilidad hacia los demás, paciencia, amor por aquellos que son difíciles de amar, su silencio y abstenerse de chismear y hablar sobre los demás; su actitud constante de gratitud; alabanza y acción de gracias a Dios; y su constante "sí" a la Voluntad de Dios en su vida. María nos ayudará a llegar al cielo si permitimos que ella nos guíe. El diablo lanzará obstáculos en nuestro camino, tratando de desviarnos y distraernos del camino hacia la Vida Eterna. Solo necesitamos llamar a María y pedirle que nos ayude: "Santa María, Madre de Dios, ruega por nosotros pecadores, ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte. Amén". Dios los bendiga!

AGREGA AGUA

“En el aljibe no había agua sino solo barro, y Jeremías se hundió en el barro” (Jeremías 38:6).

“No había agua sino solo barro” ¿es esa una descripción de tu vida? ¿Estás en un hoyo, hundiéndote en el barro, muriendo de hambre espiritualmente? (ver Jer 38:9). Necesitas agregar agua para convertir tu barro en un charco de barro, y tu charco de barro en una fuente de aguas vivas (ver Jn 4:14).

La mayoría de nosotros ya hemos recibido las vivificantes aguas del bautismo, pero debemos renovar nuestras promesas bautismales. Ya lo hicimos el Domingo de Resurrección, pero tal vez no nos dimos cuenta de lo que estábamos haciendo o hemos sofocado al Espíritu desde entonces (ver 1 Tes. 5:19). Así que renovemos nuestras promesas bautismales y dejemos que las aguas vivas fluyan y nos saquen del barro del pecado.

Jesús proclamó que tenía que recibir un bautismo (Lc 12:50). Con esto, se estaba refiriendo al bautismo en el baño de sufrimiento en el Calvario (ver Mc 10:38). Cuando renovamos nuestras promesas bautismales, también nos comprometemos a sufrir con Jesús y por amor a Él. Consciente del sufrimiento que implica, renueva ahora tus promesas bautismales. Rechaza a Satanás, sus obras y sus promesas vacías. Profesa tu fe en tu Padre amoroso; en Jesús como tu Salvador, Señor y Dios; y en el Espíritu Santo. Rocíate con agua bendita. Sal del barro, del pecado y de la prisión. Por fe, agrega agua.

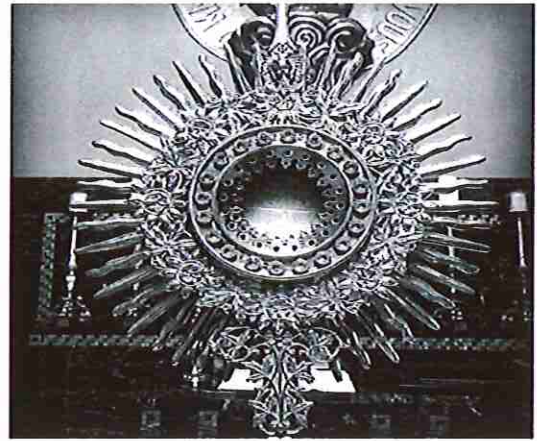
Oración: Padre, “como la cierva sedienta busca las corrientes de agua, así mi alma suspira por Ti, mi Dios” (Sal 42:2).

Fire in Our Hearts

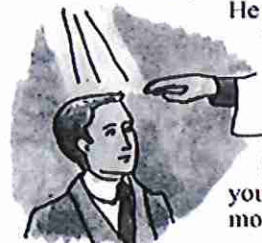

What do you think happens when the Holy Spirit is in someone's soul? The Holy Spirit pulls us closer to Himself and God the Father and Jesus. When we are closer to God that means we love Him more, and the more we love God the more we will love other people too. We were made to love God and be happy with Him, so we want the Holy Spirit to live in us and bring us close to Him!

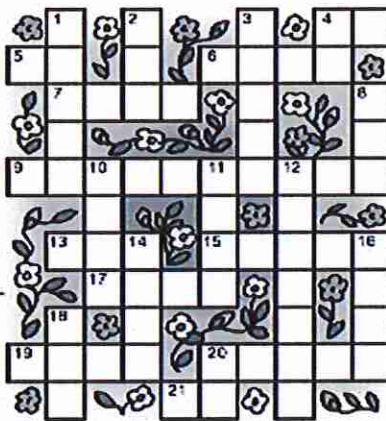

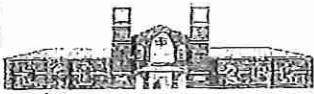
