Dear Parishioners,
 I have a prayer card in my breviary. The breviary is the prayer book that priests and religious use each day to pray the "Liturgy of the Hours". The prayer on the prayer card says: *"O Most Holy Heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing, I adore you, I love you, and with lively sorrow for my sins I offer you this poor heart of mine. Make me humble, patient, pure and wholly obedient to your will. Grant, Good Jesus, that I may live in you and for you. Protect me in the midst of danger. Comfort me in my afflictions. Give me health of mind and body, assistance in my temporal and spiritual needs, your blessing on all that I do, and the grace of a holy death. Amen."* On the other side of the prayer card is a photo of a young man kneeling in prayer with a Rosary in his hands. This young man is Joseph Reali from Long Island, NY. When I was with the Franciscans in New York, I led Holy Hours in honor of Saint Padre Pio on the First Fridays of the month. I would have dinner at the Reali's house before going to the Church. Joseph was a very nice, young man who took his Catholic faith seriously. He prayed this beautiful prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus every day. One morning, while sitting down for breakfast at his parent's home, Joseph suddenly collapsed and died. The cause of his death at 25 years old, was an enlarged heart. This past Friday (June 7th) was the celebration of **the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, and this whole month of June is dedicated to His Sacred Heart.** Jesus' heart was enlarged, full of love and mercy for us human beings. Jesus is the Good Shepherd who loves all of His sheep, and He will always look for that one lost sheep who has gone astray from His Love. Jesus' side was pierced on the Cross, and love and water was poured out for us - the blood and water being symbols of the Sacraments of

Jesus' Body and Blood in the Holy Eucharist, and of Baptism. Let us adore the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, and let us pray to have a heart like His. ***Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!*** God Bless!

A WAR WORTH SEEING

“He will strike at your head, while you strike at his heel.” —Genesis 3:15

A war rages between the kingdom of God and the kingdom of darkness. Because it is a spiritual war, it cannot be viewed with physical eyesight (see 1 Cor 2:12-15). It's critical to know we are in a war and act accordingly. Imagine walking through a war zone unaware that bullets and bombs are buzzing nearby. This would put us at risk of becoming a casualty since we wouldn't defend ourselves and our loved ones.

This spiritual war has many casualties: widespread hunger, divorce, millions of aborted babies, rampant sexual sin, greed, injustice, selfishness, substance abuse, acts of violence, and much more. The natural man views the casualties without thinking of God — unless it's to blame God. The spiritual man sees the spiritual war and responds with spiritual weapons as listed in Ephesians 6:10-20. “Our battle is not against human forces but against the principalities and powers, the rulers of this world of darkness, the evil spirits in regions above” (Eph 6:12).

Once the land of Israel was under attack. The servant of the prophet Elisha lamented that the forces of the invading Aramean army surrounded the city, which did not have enough troops to withstand them (2 Kgs 6:14-15). “ ‘Do not be afraid,’ Elisha answered, ‘Our side outnumbers theirs.’ Then he prayed, ‘O Lord, open his eyes, that he may see.’ And the Lord opened the eyes of the servant, so that he saw the mountainside filled with horses and chariots around Elisha” (2 Kgs 6:16-17). Beg the Lord for the grace to see the war, fight properly, and trust that the battle belongs to Him (1 Sm 17:47).

Prayer: Father, may I “walk by faith, not by sight” (2 Cor 5:7). Give me eyes to fight “the good fight” of faith (2 Tm 4:7).

Promise: “Everything is ordered to your benefit.” —2 Cor 4:15

Queridos feligreses,
Tengo una tarjeta de oración en mi breviario. El breviario es el libro de oraciones que los sacerdotes y religiosos utilizan cada día para rezar la "Liturgia de las Horas". La oración en la tarjeta dice: *Oh, Santísimo Corazón de Jesús, fuente de toda bendición, te adoro, te amo, y con dolor vivo por mis pecados, te ofrezco este pobre corazón mío. Hazme humilde, paciente, puro y totalmente obediente a tu voluntad. Concédeme, buen Jesús, que pueda vivir en Ti y pora Ti. Protégeme en medio del peligro. Consuélame en mis aflicciones. Dame salud mental y corporal, asistencia en mis necesidades temporales y espirituales, Tu bendición en todo lo que hago y la gracia de una muerte santa. Amén*". En el otro lado de la tarjeta, hay una foto de un joven arrodillado en oración con un Rosario en sus manos. Este joven es Joseph Reali de Long Island, Nueva York. Cuando estaba con los Franciscanos en Nueva York, dirigía las Horas Santas en honor a San Padre Pío los primeros viernes de cada mes. Cenaba en casa de la familia Reali antes de ir a la Iglesia. Joseph era un joven muy agradable que tomaba en serio su Fe Católica. Todos los días rezaba esta hermosa oración al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús. Una mañana, mientras se sentaba a desayunar en la casa de sus padres, Joseph se desplomó repentinamente y murió. La causa de su muerte, a los 25 años de edad, fue un corazón agrandado. El pasado viernes (7 de Junio) fue la celebración de **la Solemnidad del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, y todo este mes de Junio está dedicado a Su Sagrado Corazón.** El Corazón de Jesús se ensanchó, lleno de amor y misericordia para con nosotros los seres humanos. Jesús es el Buen Pastor que ama a todas Sus ovejas, y El siempre buscará aquella oveja perdida que se ha desviado de Su Amor. El costado de Jesús fue traspasado en la Cruz, y amor y agua fueron derramados por nosotros; la sangre y el agua son

símbolos de los Sacramentos del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesús en la Sagrada Eucaristía y del Bautismo. Adoremos al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y oremos para tener un corazón como el suyo. **¡El Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, ten piedad de nosotros!** ¡Dios los bendiga!

UNA GUERRA DIGNA DE VER

“Él te aplastará la cabeza y tú le acecharás el talón” (Génesis 3:15).

Una guerra ruge entre el reino de Dios y el reino de las tinieblas. Por ser una guerra espiritual, no se puede ver con la vista física (ver 1 Co 2:12-15). Es fundamental saber que estamos en una guerra y actuar en consecuencia. Imagínese caminar por una zona de guerra sin darse cuenta de que las balas y las bombas zumban cerca. Esto nos pondría en riesgo de convertirnos en una víctima, ya que no nos defenderíamos a nosotros mismos ni a nuestros seres queridos.

Esta guerra espiritual tiene muchas bajas: hambre generalizada, divorcio, millones de bebés abortados, pecado sexual desenfrenado, codicia, injusticia, egoísmo, abuso de sustancias, actos de violencia y mucho más. El hombre natural ve las bajas sin pensar en Dios, a menos que sea para culpar a Dios. El hombre espiritual ve la guerra espiritual y responde con armas espirituales como se enumera en Efesios 6:10-20. “Porque nuestra lucha no es contra enemigos de carne y sangre, sino contra los Principados y Potestades, contra los Soberanos de este mundo de tinieblas, contra los espíritus del mal que habitan en el espacio” (Ef 6:12).

Una vez la tierra de Israel estuvo bajo ataque. El siervo del profeta Eliseo se lamentó de que las fuerzas del ejército arameo invasor rodearan la ciudad, que no tenía tropas suficientes para hacerles frente (2 Re 6:14-15). “No temas, respondió Él, porque los que están con nosotros son más que los que están con ellos”. Luego Eliseo oró, diciendo: ‘Señor, ábrele los ojos para que vea’. El Señor abrió los ojos del servidor, y él vio que la montaña estaba repleta de caballos y carros de guerra alrededor de Eliseo” (2 Re 6:16-17).

Ruega al Señor la gracia de ver la guerra, pelear como es debido y confiar en que la batalla le pertenece a Él (1 Sm 17:47).

Oración: Padre, que pueda “caminar por fe, y no por vista” (2 Co 5:7). Dame ojos para “el buen combate” de fe (2 Tim 4:7).

Promesa: “Todo esto es por ustedes” (2 Co 4:15).

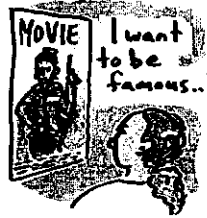

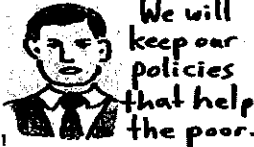
Does Being Famous Matter?

You are very important to God!

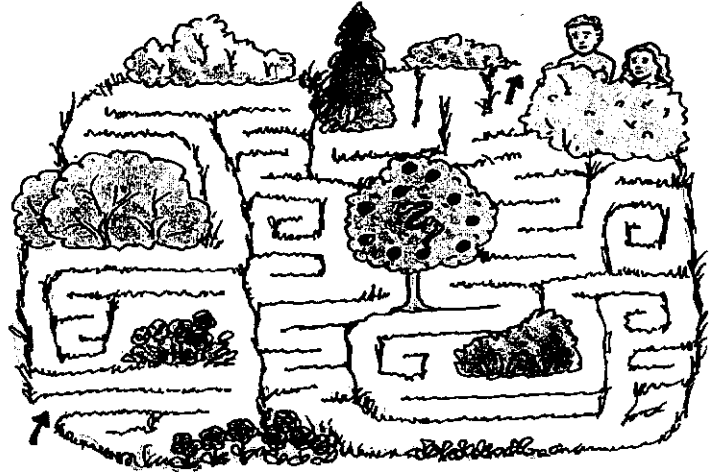
