Dear Parishioners,

As we continue this month of October dedicated to our Blessed Mother, I would like to share the following article entitled **Mary's Shield**, by Carol Monaco (7/22/2019): *"How often do we seek the protection of our Blessed Mother as we go about our daily living? Seeing and sharing in the suffering of her Son Jesus Christ - suffering caused by the sins of the world - **Mary provides us her greatest shield - her heart.** Truly, the depth of Mary's loving character protects us against sinful temptations, helping us to live life to the best of our ability. Being pure in heart, Mary was able to accept the fullness of God's love and graces. The love and grace endowed by God provides strength of mind and spirit that protects our heart from hardening, particularly in times of great difficulty and sacrifice. Only with an open heart can one withstand hatred and remain loving in this world. Surely, Mary faced such pressures as she gave birth and raised our Savior, with her husband Joseph, shielding Jesus from those who wanted to destroy Him and sharing Him with those who wanted to adore Him. October the Month of the Holy Rosary

The month of October is dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. October was also the month in which Mary appeared for the last time to shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal, urging them to "say the rosary every day to obtain peace for the world." Pray the Rosary!

"As long as Moses kept his hands raised up, Israel had the better of the fight." —Exodus 17:11

We are in a war against demons (Eph 6:12). As the Church, we are attacking the gates of hell which cannot prevail against us (Mt 16:18). By the power of the Holy Spirit, we are claiming Jesus' victory over Satan and applying it to our lives and our world.

Our sword is the Spirit using God's Word (Eph 6:17) and helping us to pray in our weakness (Rm 8:26). Therefore, "preach the word, [staying] with this task whether convenient or inconvenient" (2 Tm 4:2). Also, accompany the proclamation of God's Word by praying as Moses did (Ex 17:11-13). "At every opportunity pray in the Spirit, using prayers and petitions of every sort. Pray constantly and attentively for all in the holy company" (Eph 6:18). Pray with and for the ministry of God's Word. "Pray for us that the word of the Lord may make progress and be hailed by many others, even as it has been by you" (2 Thes 3:1). Pray "that God may put His word" on our lips that we "may have courage to proclaim it as" we ought (Eph 6:19, 20).

On this World Mission Sunday, fight in the power of the Spirit the world war of words — words of witnessing, preaching, teaching, and praying.

And sometimes He doesn't give us what we are asking for because He has a better plan for us.



So always persevere when you're praying for something. God hears you and you can trust Him to do what is the very best for you!

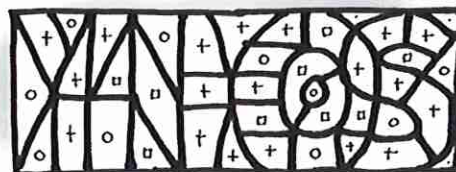

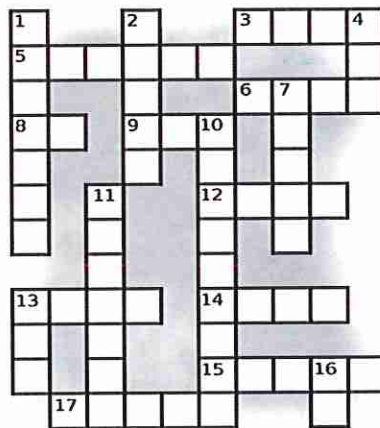

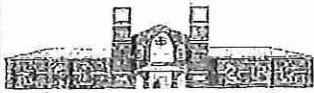
