# ***Solemnity Christ the King*** ***November 26, 2023***

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we celebrate the **Solemnity of Christ the King**. It is the last Sunday of the 2023 Liturgical Year. Next Sunday, we will begin our new Liturgical Year of 2024 with the First Sunday of Advent. What is the significance of today's Feast of Christ the King? I found the following reflection from "[Catholic Culture.org](http://CatholicCulture.org)": "The Feast of Christ the King was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living and organizes his life as if God did not exist. *The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's royalty over individuals, families, society, governments, and nations.*" In Pope Pius XI's own words: "*If to Christ our Lord is given all power in heaven and on earth; if all men, purchased by his precious blood, are by a new right subjected to his dominion; if this power embraces all men, it must be clear that not one of our faculties is exempt from his empire. He must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things, and cleave to him alone.*" (***Quas Primas***, 33). My brothers and sisters, let each of us allow Jesus Christ our King to reign in our minds, wills, and hearts. God bless!

## AT THE KING'S FEET

**“Christ must reign until God has put all enemies under His feet.” —1 Corinthians 15:25**

The Old Testament describes God's plan as making His enemies His footstool (Ps 110:1). Reigning kings in Old Testament days placed their feet on the prone bodies of their enemies as a sign of bringing them to submission. God's vanquished enemies would likewise be subject to His will (1 Cor 15:27-28).

In the New Testament, God's enemies are described as humbled beneath Jesus' feet (Mt 22:44). Jesus, God Himself, died on His cross for all His enemies (Rm 5:8). He reigns on His cross as crucified King (Jn 19:19).

We all were enemies of Christ the King as we lived in sin (Rm 5:10). Then we came to know Jesus as Savior, Lord, God, and King, and we repented. We came to the foot of His cross and were shocked speechless when we realized how much Jesus, King of the Universe, suffered out of love for us (Is 52:15). We humbled ourselves at His crucified feet (Mt 22:44), and we fell at His feet to worship, thank, and praise Him (Lk 17:16).

King Jesus washed our feet; now we “must wash each other's feet” (Jn 13:14). We wash King Jesus' feet by feeding the hungry, welcoming strangers, visiting prisoners, and comforting the ill, etc. (Mt 25:35ff).

Have you subjected everything to King Jesus? Give Him your all. Place “all things under His feet” (1 Cor 15:27).

**Prayer:** Jesus, “King of kings” (Rv 19:16), I rejoice to be Your subject. To You “be honor and everlasting rule!” (1 Tm 6:16)

**Promise:** “Thus says the Lord God: I Myself will look after and tend My sheep.” —Ez 34:11

**Praise:** Lord Jesus, risen King of the Universe, how beautiful are Your feet, which bring Good News to the world (Is 52:7).

Este fin de semana, celebramos la **Solemnidad de Cristo Rey**. Es el último domingo del año litúrgico 2023. El próximo domingo, comenzaremos nuestro nuevo año litúrgico de 2024 con el primer domingo de Adviento. ¿Cuál es el significado de la fiesta de Cristo Rey de hoy? Encontré la siguiente reflexión de "[Catholic Culture.org](http://CatholicCulture.org)": *"La fiesta de Cristo Rey fue establecida por el Papa Pío XI en 1925 como un antídoto contra el secularismo, una forma de vida que deja a Dios fuera del pensamiento y la vida del hombre y organiza su vida como si Dios no existiera. La fiesta pretende proclamar de manera llamativa y efectiva la realeza de Cristo sobre los individuos, las familias, la sociedad, los gobiernos y las naciones."* En las propias palabras del Papa Pío XI: *"Si a Cristo nuestro Señor se le da todo poder en el cielo y en la tierra; si todos los hombres, comprados por su preciosa sangre, están sometidos por un nuevo derecho a su dominio; si este poder abarca a todos los hombres, debe quedar claro que ninguna de nuestras facultades está exenta de su imperio. Él debe reinar en nuestras mentes, que deben asentir con sumisión perfecta y creencia firme a las verdades reveladas y a las doctrinas de Cristo. Él debe reinar en nuestras voluntades, las cuales deben obedecer las leyes y preceptos de Dios. Él debe reinar en nuestros corazones, los cuales deben rechazar los deseos naturales y amar a Dios sobre todas las cosas, y adherirse solo a él."* (Quas Primas, 33). ## A LOS PIES DEL REY

**“Porque es necesario que Cristo reine hasta que ponga a todos los enemigos debajo de sus pies” (1 Corintios 15:25).**

El Antiguo Testamento describe el plan de Dios como poniendo a sus enemigos por estrado de Sus pies (Sal 110:1). Los reyes reinantes en los días del Antiguo Testamento ponían sus pies sobre los cuerpos inclinados de sus enemigos como una señal de llevarlos a la sumisión. Los enemigos vencidos de Dios también estarían sujetos a Su voluntad (1 Co 15:27-28). En el Nuevo Testamento, los enemigos de Dios son descritos como humillados debajo los pies de Jesús (Mt 22:44). Jesús, Dios mismo, murió en su cruz por todos Sus enemigos (Rom 5:8). Él reina en Su cruz como Rey crucificado (Jn 19:19). Todos éramos enemigos de Cristo Rey mientras vivíamos en pecado (Rom 5:10). Luego llegamos a conocer a Jesús como Salvador, Señor, Dios y Rey, y nos arrepentimos. Llegamos al pie de Su cruz y nos quedamos sin palabras cuando nos dimos cuenta de cuánto sufrió Jesús, Rey del universo, por amor a nosotros (Is 52:15). Nos humillamos a Sus pies crucificados (Mt 22:44), y nos inclinamos para adorarle, agradecerle y alabarle (Lc 17:16). El rey Jesús nos lavó los pies; ahora debemos lavarnos los pies unos a otros (Jn 13:14). Lavamos los pies del Rey Jesús alimentando a los hambrientos, dando la bienvenida a los extraños, visitando a los prisioneros y consolando a los enfermos (Mt 25:35ss). ¿Has sometido todo al Rey Jesús? Entrégalo todo. Somete "todas las cosas bajo Sus pies" (1 Co 15:27).

**Oración:** Jesús, “Rey de los reyes” (Ap 19:16), me regocijo de ser Tu súbdito. Para Ti “¡A Él sea el honor y el poder para siempre!” (1 Tim 6:16).

Imagine a king who came to see every one of his subjects to make sure that they were doing okay. Well, Jesus does more than that- He died for us on the cross! He looks after us all the time, and He says that anyone who is unkind to us will be judged as being unkind to Him.

Christ the King is the just judge. How do you think you will be judged when you die, or at the end of time? Are you kind to others? Do you ever think about how you would treat Jesus if He were here? Do you treat other people the way you would treat Jesus?
