Dear Parishioners,

### FILL UPS

“The disciples could not but be filled with joy and the Holy Spirit.” —Acts 13:52

What if the only thing you knew how to do was “to be filled with joy and the Holy Spirit”? After Sts. Paul and Barnabas were violently abused and thrown out of town, the disciples knew how to react in only one way — not with violence, fear, unforgiveness, or bitterness but “with joy and the Holy Spirit.” What if we were rejected, insulted, or falsely accused? We would probably know how to react with something other than joy. However, Jesus’ early disciples could be filled with joy even in terrible circumstances (Acts 5:41) because they were also filled with the Holy Spirit. The Spirit crucifies our flesh with its passions and desires (Gal 5:24). We no longer know how to react in our old carnal ways. The Spirit cries out “Abba” in our hearts (Rm 8:15; Gal 4:6), proclaims “Jesus is Lord” (1 Cor 12:3), and fills us with love (Rm 5:5). Under these circumstances, we forgive and love our enemies and know only how to be filled with joy. Only those filled with the Spirit can react to persecution this way. Therefore, “happy are you when you are insulted for the sake of Christ, for then God’s Spirit in Its glory has come to rest on you” (1 Pt 4:14).

**Prayer:** Father, may I react to my enemies in such a way as to puzzle non-Christians.

**Promise:** “My sheep hear My voice. I know them, and they follow Me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish.” —Jn 10:27

**Praise:** “The Lord shall reign forever; your God, O Zion, through all generations. Alleluia” (Ps 146:10). Praise the risen Jesus!

### RELLENOS

“Los discípulos, por su parte, quedaron llenos de alegría y del Espíritu Santo” (Hechos 13:52) ¿Y si lo único que supieras hacer fuera es “estar lleno de gozo y del Espíritu Santo”? Después de que san Pablo y Bernabé fueron violentamente abusados y expulsados de la ciudad, los discípulos supieron reaccionar de una sola manera: no con violencia, miedo, falta de perdón o amargura, sino “con gozo y el Espíritu Santo”. ¿Y si fuéramos rechazados, insultados o acusados falsamente? Probablemente sabríamos reaccionar con algo más que alegría. Sin embargo, los primeros discípulos de Jesús podían estar llenos de gozo incluso en circunstancias terribles (Hch 5:41) porque también estaban llenos del Espíritu Santo. El Espíritu crucifica nuestra carne con sus pasiones y deseos (Gál 5:24). Ya no sabemos cómo reaccionar a nuestras viejas formas carnales. El Espíritu clama “Abba” en nuestro corazón (Rom 8:15; Gál 4:6), proclama “Jesús es el Señor” (1 Co 12:3) y nos llena de amor (Rom 5:5). En estas circunstancias, perdonamos y amamos a nuestros enemigos y solo sabemos cómo llenarnos de gozo. Solo aquellos que están llenos del Espíritu pueden reaccionar a la persecución de esta manera. Por lo tanto, “felices si son ultrajados por el nombre de Cristo, porque el Espíritu de gloria, el Espíritu de Dios, reposa sobre ustedes” (1 Pe 4:14).

**Oración:** Padre, que pueda reaccionar ante mis enemigos de tal manera que desconcierte a los no cristianos.

**Promesa:** “Mis ovejas escuchan mi voz, Yo las conozco y ellas me siguen. Yo les doy vida eterna, y no perecerán jamás” (Jn 10:27-28).

**Alabanza:** “El Señor reina eternamente, reina tu Dios, Sion, a lo largo de las generaciones. ¡Aleluya!” (Sal 146:10). ¡Alabado sea Jesús resucitado!

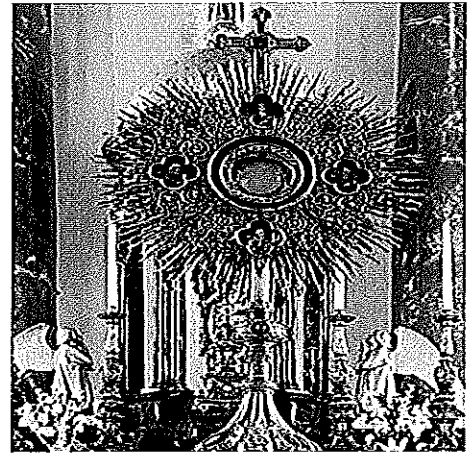

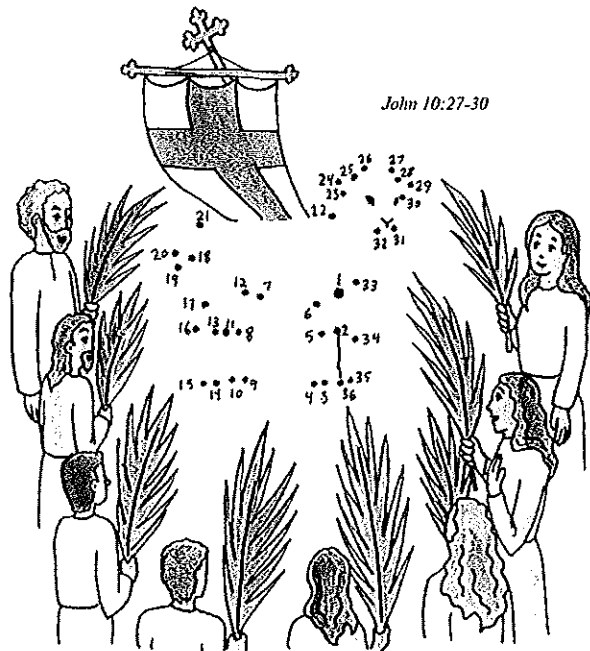

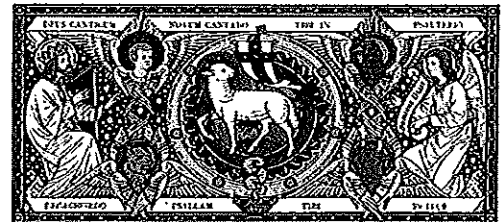

## Saint Damien of Molokai May 10

ST. DAMIEN WAS BORN IN BELGIUM IN 1840. HE HAD TO QUIT SCHOOL AT 13 TO WORK ON THE FARM. EVERY DAY HE PRAYED IN FRONT OF A PICTURE OF ST. FRANCIS XAVIER, PATRON OF MISSIONARIES.



HE JOINED A RELIGIOUS ORDER AND WHEN HIS BROTHER GOT SICK, HE TOOK HIS PLACE ON A MISSION TO HAWAII.



DAMIEN WAS ORDAINED A PRIEST IN HONOLULU AT THE AGE OF 24.



AT THAT TIME PEOPLE WITH LEPROSY WERE QUARANTINED ON THE ISLAND OF MOLOKAI.



DAMIEN VOLUNTEERED TO GO THERE, EVEN THOUGH HE KNEW HE MIGHT CATCH THE DISEASE.



HE CARED FOR THE PEOPLE AND BUILT CHURCHES AND HOSPITALS. HE MADE LIFE MUCH BETTER FOR THEM.

FATHER DAMIEN GOT LEPROSY HIMSELF WHEN HE WAS 45. HE CONTINUED TO WORK WITH THE PEOPLE AS LONG AS HE COULD. HE DIED AT AGE 49 AND WAS BURIED ON THE ISLAND.

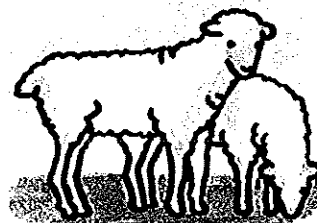
