# Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

## June 30, 2024

Dear Parishioners,

During this coming month of July dedicated to **Devotion to the Precious Blood of Jesus**, I would like to share the following reflection by Brian Smith, from the website: teachingcatholickids.com: *“Each of us has blood that flows through our body. Blood allows our body to work as God intended. Without blood we cannot run outside, play with our favorite toys, or even breathe! Blood, then, is what allows us to live each day to the fullest. Without blood, we could not live. Jesus desperately wants us to spend eternity in heaven. When we sin, we turn our backs to God. This makes God sad. And so, to redeem us in the eyes of God, Jesus chose to shed his own blood as a sacrifice for our sins! Jesus wants us to go to heaven so much that he was willing to suffer a long and harsh death. Jesus shed his blood seven times during his life for us:*

1. *The Presentation of the Lord (Jesus was circumcised)*
2. *The Agony in the Garden (Jesus' sweat turned into blood)*
3. *The Scourging at the Pillar (Jesus was whipped)*
4. *The Crowning of Thorns (thorns were pressed into Jesus' head)*
5. *The Way of the Cross (onlookers punched and kicked Jesus)*
6. *The Crucifixion (Jesus is nailed to the cross)*
7. *The Piercing of His Heart (a soldier placed his sword through Jesus' side, causing all of Jesus' blood to spill out upon the ground)*

*As Catholics, we recognize all of Jesus' suffering and believe that he truly died for us in hope that we might go to heaven one day. Just because Jesus died for our sins does not mean that we can live and do whatever we want. Every day, we must try to be pleasing to God. This includes our thoughts, words, and actions. Sometimes we make mistakes. God invites us to*

*the Sacrament of Reconciliation to amend our sins. When we recognize our sins, we are joined with the Precious Blood of Jesus as we promise to God that we will try to live a better life.”* As we prepare once again to receive the Body and Blood of Jesus at Mass, let us pray for the grace to follow Him more closely. God bless!

## TWELVE

**“There was a woman in the area who had been afflicted with a hemorrhage for a dozen years.”**

**—Mark 5:25**

In the Scriptures, the number twelve signifies fullness. There were “twelve tribes of Israel” (Gn 49:28). Jesus chose “twelve apostles” (Mt 10:2) and made them into the new Israel, the Church. The heavenly city has “twelve courses of stones as its foundation, on which were written the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb” (Rv 21:14). The woman clothed with the sun in Revelation 12:1 wears “a crown of twelve stars.” This woman, symbolizing Israel, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the Church, is fully victorious over the kingdom of darkness (Rv 12:1-17).

However, in today’s Gospel passage, the number twelve is associated with desperation and dying. The woman in today’s gospel passage suffered twelve years from a hemorrhage (Mk 5:25), the same timeframe that Jairus’ daughter had been alive (Mk 5:42). The hemorrhage made the woman ritually impure, unable to approach communal gatherings such as the meetings held in Jairus’ synagogue (Mk 5:22). After twelve years, the woman was broke and desperate, growing worse (Mk 5:26) and Jairus’ daughter died. Jesus redeemed and fulfilled the twelfth year, bringing both healing and new life.

Is there anything in your life that is dying or worn out? Are you “desperate” to the full? Bring your desperation to Jesus. In Him is “absolute fullness” (Col 1:19). He came “to fulfill” (Mt 5:17), to give you life “to the full” (Jn 10:10). Bring Jesus your emptiness, and let Him fill you.

**Prayer:** Jesus, thank You for coming to fill and to fulfill. I give You my emptiness. Fill me with Yourself. Jesus, I trust in You.

**Promise:** “God formed man to be imperishable; the image of His own nature He made him.” —Wis 2:23

**Praise:** Praise You, Lord, for loving the world so much as to become one of us. Alleluia!

## DOCE

**“Se encontraba allí una mujer que desde hacía doce años padecía de hemorragia” (Marcos 5:25).**

En las Escrituras, el número doce significa plenitud. Eran “doce tribus de Israel” (Gn 49:28). Jesús escogió a “doce Apóstoles” (Mt 10:2) y los convirtió en el nuevo Israel, la Iglesia. La ciudad celestial “se asentaba sobre doce cimientos y cada uno de ellos tenía el nombre de uno de los doce Apóstoles del Cordero” (Ap 21:14). La mujer vestida del sol en Apocalipsis 12:1 lleva “una corona de doce estrellas”. Esta mujer, que simboliza a Israel, la Santísima Virgen María y la Iglesia, es plenamente victoriosa sobre el reino de las tinieblas (Ap 12:1-17).

En el pasaje evangélico de hoy, el número doce está asociado con la desesperación y la muerte. La mujer del pasaje evangélico de hoy sufrió una hemorragia durante doce años (Mc 5:25), el mismo tiempo que llevaba viva la hija de Jairo (Mc 5:42). La hemorragia hizo a la mujer ritualmente impura, incapaz de acercarse a las reuniones comunitarias como las celebradas en la sinagoga de Jairo (Mc 5:22). Después de doce años, la mujer estaba arruinada y desesperada, cada vez peor (Mc 5:26) y la hija de Jairo murió. Jesús redimió y cumplió el año doce, trayendo sanidad y vida nueva.

¿Hay algo en tu vida que se está muriendo o desgastando? ¿Estás “desesperado” al máximo? Lleva tu desesperación a Jesús. En Él está “toda la Plenitud” (Col 1:19). Vino “a dar cumplimiento” (Mt 5:17), a daros vida “en abundancia” (Jn 10:10). Lleva a Jesús tu vacío, y deja que Él te llene.

**Oración:** Jesús, gracias por venir a llenar y a cumplir. Te doy mi vacío. Lléname de Ti mismo. Jesús, en Ti confío.

**Promesa:** “Dios creó al hombre para que fuera incorruptible y lo hizo a imagen de Su propia naturaleza” (Sab 2:23).

**Alabanza:** Te alabo, Señor, por amar tanto al mundo que te has hecho uno de nosotros.

6. *La crucifixión (Jesús es clavado en la cruz)*
7. *La Perforación de Su Corazón (un soldado colocó su espada en el costado de Jesús, causando que toda la sangre de Jesús se derramara en el suelo)*

*Como católicos, reconocemos todo el sufrimiento de Jesús y creemos que realmente murió por nosotros con la esperanza de poder ir al cielo algún día. Solo porque Jesús murió por nuestros pecados no significa que podamos vivir y hacer lo que queramos. Todos los días, debemos tratar de agradar a Dios. # When People are Sick...

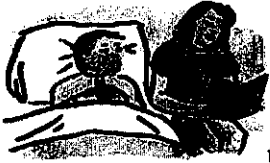

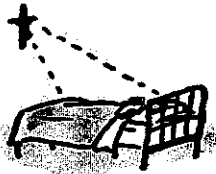
What can we do?

Here are some ideas:

1. If someone in your family is sick, maybe you can help them out! Ask if you could read them a story, or help them by bringing them anything they need. A 'Get Well' card would be nice too!



2. Always pray for people who are sick. Your prayers can help them get better, or they might help your sick friend to understand why God is letting them suffer.



What about when you are sick? When you are sick or hurt, think about Jesus suffering on the cross. Offer your pain to Him and tell Him that you want to suffer with Him so that people will be saved from their sins. Be thankful for people who help you when you are sick. Remember, they take Jesus' place!

The king has agreed to the terms of peace.

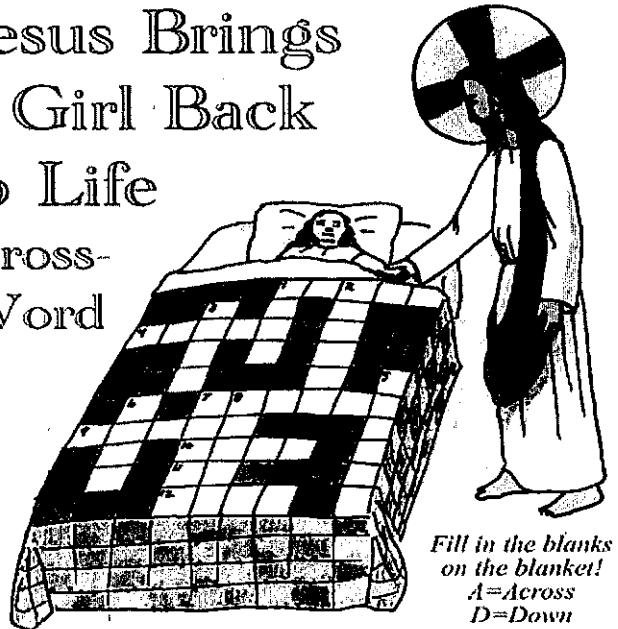
