# Palm Sunday

## March 24, 2024

Dear Parishioners,

We begin **Holy Week** this weekend with **Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord**. Jesus triumphantly enters Jerusalem, riding on a donkey with the people placing palm branches in front of Him. At the Masses this weekend, we have the blessing of palm branches, and we participate in the reading of one of the Gospel accounts of the Passion of our Lord. On **Holy Tuesday**, we will have Eucharistic Adoration from 9am - 6pm, and then there will be the *Chrism Mass at the Cathedral at 7pm*, celebrated by Bishop Henning, with our new Bishop elect Fr. Ruggieri giving the homily. Myself, along with the other priests from our Diocese, will renew our priestly vows, and the sacred oils used in the Sacraments of Baptism, Anointing of the Sick, and Holy Orders, will be blessed at this Mass. "**Spy Wednesday**" is the day in which Judas visits the chief priests of the Temple and promises to give them Jesus in exchange for 30 pieces of silver. Judas is "spying" on Jesus, looking for an opportunity to betray Him. We will have the Mass of the Lord's Supper on **Holy Thursday at 7pm**. This is the night that Jesus celebrated the Last Supper with his Apostles, thus instituting the Holy Eucharist. Jesus also institutes the Sacrament of Holy Orders (the priesthood) on this night, as well as giving the command to His disciples to serve one another, leading by His Own example in washing the feet of the twelve Apostles. We will conclude this Mass with a brief procession in the church with the Blessed Sacrament, before then placing Jesus on the "altar of repose" for private adoration **until 11pm**, in memory of Jesus' Agony in the Garden on that night. On **Good Friday**, there is no celebration of Mass. We will have Bilingual Stations of the Cross outside of the church at **1:30pm**, and then commemorations of the Lord's Passion at **3pm** (Spanish) and at **7pm** (English). At these liturgies, we will all participate in the Passion narrative, venerate the cross (with a simple sign of reverence), and receive Holy Communion from the Hosts that were consecrated on Holy Thursday. **Holy Saturday** is a day of "waiting," remembering Jesus descent into the dead to bring the just souls who died before His Sacrifice on the Cross to the glory of Heaven. We conclude the Sacred Triduum (the "three holy days") with the **Easter Vigil**. Three of our parishioners will receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation on this holy

night, with three others receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation as well. This will begin our 50-day celebration of Easter - the Lord's Resurrection. My brothers and sisters, my sincere hope is that each of us take time this Holy Week to grow in "holiness", allowing the Lord's Passion, Death, and Resurrection, to change us. God bless!

## “OH SAY, CAN YOU SEE?”

“All who see Me scoff at Me.” —Psalm 22:8  
Although the crowd’s acclamation of “Hosanna” (Mk 11:9) would soon change to furious shouts of “Crucify Him” (Mk 15:13), Jesus loved each person in the crowd. Jesus has eyes of love to see each person, both from the vantage point atop the donkey and that of hanging from the cross. Jesus knew that He could not be swayed by the temporary acclamation of human praise (Jn 2:25; Jn 5:41-42). He had His face set like flint to proceed to Calvary (Is 50:7), but His heart was not hard; it was full of love for the broken and wounded (Mt 9:36).

Jesus’ eyes have always been looking at us (Ps 33:13-15, 18), searching the world. The Lord Jesus looks for all who would worship Him in spirit and in truth (Jn 4:23-24). Yet for a time during His Passion, His eyes were blinded as His Precious Blood covered His face. Nevertheless, Jesus fixed His eyes on you as He died to save you.

Will you fix your eyes on Jesus? (Heb 3:1) Will you look upon the Crucified One? Holy Week is the time to look at Jesus, as He truly is, the Suffering Servant Who gave His body and blood for you. It’s not automatic that a disciple fixes his or her eyes on Jesus. Judas took his eyes off Jesus during Holy Week. Fix your eyes on Jesus.

**Prayer:** Father, today I make a covenant with my eyes (Jb 31:1) to gaze daily upon Jesus (Ps 27:4).

**Promise:** “At Jesus’ name every knee must bend in the heavens, on the earth, and under the earth, and every tongue proclaim to the glory of God the Father: JESUS CHRIST IS LORD!” —Phil 2:10-11

**Praise:** “You who fear the Lord, praise Him; all you descendants of Jacob, give glory to Him” (Ps 22:24).

# ***Domingo de Ramos*** ***24 de marzo, 2024***

Queridos feligreses,

Comenzamos **la Semana Santa** este fin de semana con el **Domingo de Ramos de la Pasión del Señor**. Jesús entra triunfalmente en Jerusalén, montado en un burro con la gente colocando ramas de palmas delante de él. En las Misas de este fin de semana, tenemos la bendición de las ramas de palma y participamos en la lectura de uno de los relatos del Evangelio de la Pasión de nuestro Señor. **El Martes Santo**, tendremos Adoración Eucarística de **9am-6pm**, y luego habrá *la Misa del Crisma en la Catedral a las 7pm*. Yo, al igual que otros sacerdotes de nuestra diócesis, renovaremos nuestros votos sacerdotales, y los aceites sagrados utilizados en los Sacramentos de Bautismo, Unción de los Enfermos y Orden Sagrado, serán bendecidos en esta Misa. "**El Miércoles de Espías**" es el día en Judas visita a los sumo sacerdotes del templo y promete darles a Jesús a cambio de 30 piezas de plata. Judas está "espiondo" a Jesús, en busca de una oportunidad para traicionarlo. Tendremos **la Misa de la Cena del Señor el Jueves Santo a las 7pm**. Esta es la noche en que Jesús celebró la Última Cena con sus Apóstoles, instituyendo así la Sagrada Eucaristía. Jesús también instituye el Sacramento del Orden Sagrado (el sacerdocio) en esta noche, además de dar el mandato a Sus discípulos de servirse unos a otros, predicando con Su propio ejemplo al lavar los pies de los doce Apóstoles. Concluiremos esta Misa con una breve procesión en la iglesia con el Santísimo Sacramento, antes de colocar a Jesús en el "altar del reposo" para la adoración privada hasta las **11pm**, en memoria de la Agonía de Jesús en el Huerto esa noche. **El Viernes Santo** no se celebra la Misa. Tendremos el Via Crucis Bilingüe afuera de la iglesia a la **1:30pm**, y luego las conmemoraciones de la Pasión del Señor a las **3pm** (español) y a las **7pm** (inglés). En estas liturgias, todos participaremos en la narrativa de la Pasión, veneraremos la cruz (con un simple signo de reverencia), y recibiremos la Sagrada Comunión de las Hostias que fueron consagrados el Jueves Santo. **El Sábado Santo** es un día de "espera", recordando a Jesús descendiendo a los muertos para llevar a las almas justas que murieron antes de Su Sacrificio en la Cruz a la gloria del Cielo. Concluimos el Triduo Sagrado (los "tres días santos") con **la Vigilia Pascual**. Tres de nuestros feligreses recibirán los Sacramentos del Bautismo, la Primera Comunión y la Confirmación en esta noche santa, y otros tres adultos también recibirán el Sacramento de la Confirmación. Esto comenzará nuestra celebración de

50 días de Pascua: la Resurrección del Señor. Mis hermanos y hermanas, mi sincera esperanza es que cada uno de nosotros tome tiempo en esta Semana Santa para crecer en "santidad", permitiendo que la Pasión, la Muerte y la Resurrección del Señor nos cambien. ¡Dios los bendiga!

# “¿OH DECIDME, PUEDES VER?”

“Los que me ven, se burlan de Mí” (Salmos 22:8).

Aunque la aclamación de la multitud era “Hosanna” (Mc 11:9) pronto cambiarían a gritos furiosos de “Crucifícalo” (Mc 15:13), Jesús amaba a cada una persona entre aquella multitud. Jesús tiene amor en sus ojos al mirar a cada persona, ya sea desde sentado en el burro o colgando de la cruz. Jesús sabía que no podría ser convencido por la aclamación pasajera de la alabanza humana (Jn 2:25; Jn 5:41-42). Tenía su mirada fija como una piedra para dirigirse al Calvario (Is 50:7), pero su corazón no estaba endurecido; estaba repleto de amor para los estropeados y heridos (Mt 9:36).

Los ojos de Jesús siempre están fijos en nosotros (Sal 33:13-15, 18), buscándonos por todo el mundo. Nuestro Señor Jesucristo busca a todos los que lo adoren en espíritu y en verdad (Jn 4:23-24). Sin embargo, durante Su Pasión, Sus ojos estaban cegados por su Preciosísima Sangre que cubría Su rostro. A pesar de todo, Jesús fijaba Sus ojos en ti mientras moría para salvarte.

¿Fijarás tus ojos en Jesús? (Heb 3:1)  
¿Mirarás sobre el rostro del Hijo de Dios crucificado? La Semana Santa es el tiempo de mirar a Cristo como Él realmente es, el servidor sufriente que entregó Su cuerpo y derramó Su sangre por ti. El hecho de ser un discípulo no garantiza que ese discípulo vaya a fijar su mirada en Jesús. Judas dejó de fijar su mirada en Jesús durante la Semana Santa. Mantén tus ojos fijos en Jesús.

**Oración:** Padre, hoy hago un pacto con mis ojos (Jb 31:1) para mirar diariamente el rostro de Jesús (Sal 27:4).

**Promesa:** “Para que, al nombre de Jesús, se doble toda rodilla en el cielo, en la tierra y en los abismos, y toda lengua proclame para gloria de Dios Padre: ¡JESUCRISTO ES EL SEÑOR!” (Fil 2:10-11)

**Alabanza:** “Alábenlo, los que temen al Señor; glorifiquenlo” (Sal 22:24).

# Holy Week

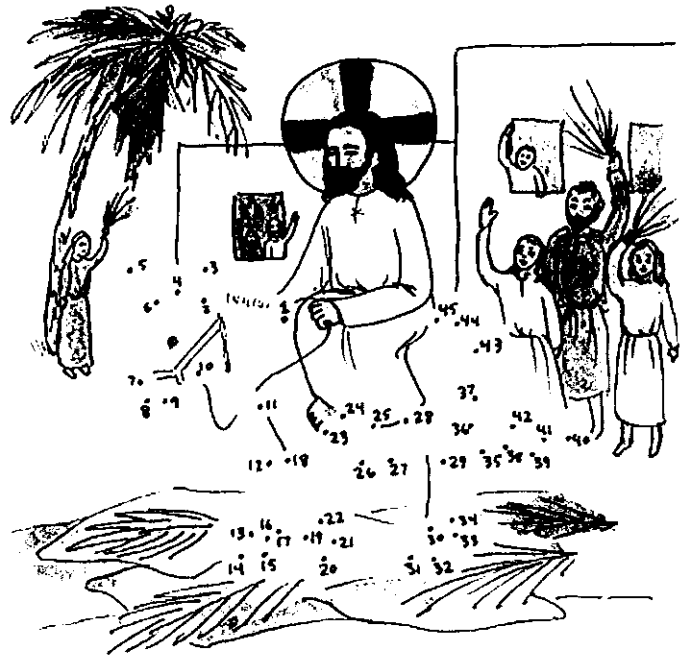

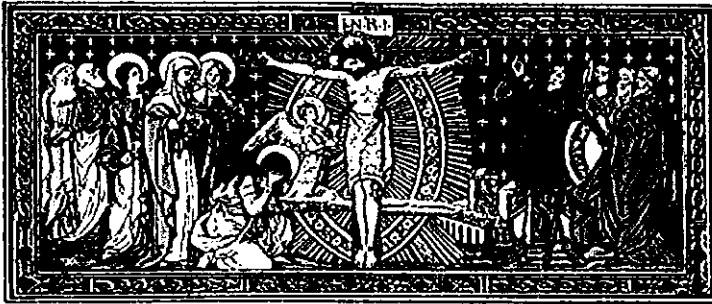

## The Passion of Jesus

Holy Thursday and Good Friday

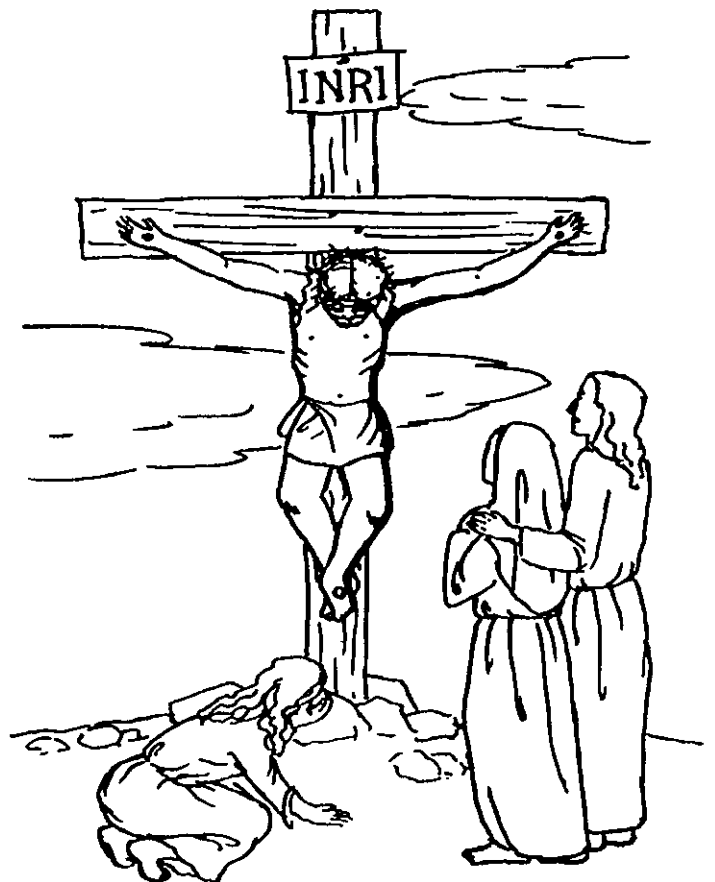
*It is finished!*
