Fourth Sunday of Lent

March 10, 2024

Dear Parishioners,

You may have heard the phrase that *"God gave us two ears and only one mouth for a reason"*.

We are called to listen more than we speak. I believe that this is especially true when it comes to our relationship with our Lord.

Prayer is talking to God, as well as listening to Him speak to us. As we approach the second half of our Lenten season this Thursday, we should ask ourselves how our prayer life is doing. Is it just a one-way street in which we are doing all the talking to God? Or are we allowing God to talk to us, making our prayer a two-way relationship with Him? As a former religious with the Community of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal, we had the blessing of a daily prayer schedule. We would pray our Liturgy of the Hours together at 6am, 7:30am, 12pm, 5pm, and lastly at 9:15pm. In between the 6am and 7:30am prayer times, we had time for personal prayer. Most of us would go back to our "cells"(rooms), and do spiritual reading, listening to God speaking to us. At the 5pm prayer time, we gathered together in a Holy Hour before Jesus exposed in the Blessed Sacrament. After beginning with our Evening Prayer, we would then have 45 minutes of silence - another time to just listen to the Lord. Although we may have busy schedules, let us not forget to take time with the Lord, not just speaking to Him, but also in listening to Him. Whether it be coming early to Mass, staying after the Mass, visiting Jesus in the church during the week, or finding some quiet place in our homes, let us take time for silence. Let us turn off the technology, and tune into God.

GOD IS RICH

“God is rich in mercy; because of His great love for us He brought us to life with Christ when we were dead in sin. By this favor you were saved.” —Ephesians 2:4-5

Today is traditionally called “Laetare Sunday.” “Laetare” means “rejoice,” for Lent is half over and Easter is only three weeks away. We rejoice not because we don’t have to fast for much longer but because God has already done marvelous works this Lent, and this is only the beginning.

What are you expecting for Holy Week and the Easter season? Do you expect a fifty-day Sunday for the Easter season? No matter how high your hopes, the Lord will do more than you could ever ask or imagine (Eph 3:20). “Is it possible that He Who did not spare His own Son but handed Him over for the sake of us all will not grant us all things besides?” (Rm 8:32)

After God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son (Jn 3:16), we can only underestimate the love, grace, and glory God has in store for us (1 Cor 2:9). He “gave us a place in the heavens, that in the ages to come He might display the great wealth of His favor” (Eph 2:6-7). We are so small and closed in on ourselves. God is so great and lavish in His love. How can the ocean of God’s love be poured into the thimble of our selfishness? “Open wide your hearts!” (2 Cor 6:13)

Prayer: Father, I’m sorry I’ve been too self-centered to receive Your love. I repent. Do anything You want to open wide my heart.

Promise: “Whoever, therefore, among you belongs to any part of His people, let him go up, and may his God be with him!” —2 Chr 36:23

Praise: “Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good, for His kindness endures forever” (Ps 106:1).

 Es posible que hayas escuchado la frase de que "*Dios nos dio dos oídos y una sola boca por una razón*". Estamos llamados a escuchar más de lo que hablamos. Creo que esto es especialmente cierto cuando se trata de nuestra relación con nuestro Señor. **La oración** es hablar con Dios, así como escucharlo hablar con nosotros. A medida que nos acercamos a la segunda mitad de nuestro tiempo de Cuaresma este jueves, debemos preguntarnos cómo va nuestra vida de oración. ¿Nuestras oraciones son solo nosotros hablando con Dios, o también estamos permitiendo que Dios nos hable? Cuando era un fraile franciscano con la Comunidad de los Frailes Franciscanos de la Renovación, tuvimos la bendición de un horario de oración diario. Rezabamos juntos nuestra Liturgia de las Horas a las 6am, 7:30am, 12pm, 5pm y finalmente a las 9:15pm. Entre los tiempos de oración de las 6am y las 7:30am, teníamos tiempo para la oración personal. DIOS ES RICO

“Pero Dios, que es rico en misericordia, por el gran amor con que nos amó, precisamente cuando estábamos muertos a causa de nuestros pecados, nos hizo revivir con Cristo –¡Ustedes han sido salvados gratuitamente!” (Efesios 2:4-5)

El día de hoy lo llamamos, “Laetare de domingo”. “Laetare”, significa “regocijarse”, debido a que la Cuaresma está por terminar; ya va en la mitad, y solo quedan tres semanas para la Pascua. Nos regocijamos no porque no tengamos que ayunar por más tiempo, sino porque Dios ya ha hecho milagros maravillosos en esta Cuaresma, y esto es solo el comienzo.

¿Qué esperas para La Semana Santa y la temporada de Pascua? ¿Esperas cincuenta domingos para el tiempo de Pascua? No importa que tan grandes sean tus esperanzas, el Señor hará más de lo que le puedas pedir o imaginar (Ef 3:20). “Él que no escatimó a su propio Hijo, sino que lo entregó por todos nosotros, ¿no nos concederá con Él toda clase de favores?” (Rom 8:32)

Si Dios amó tanto al mundo, que entregó a Su Hijo único (Jn 3:16), solo podemos sobrestimar el amor, la gracia, y la gloria que Dios tiene para nosotros (1 Co 2:9). Él “nos hizo reinar con Él en el Cielo, y ha querido demostrar a los tiempos futuros la inmensa riqueza de Su gracia por el amor que nos tiene en Cristo Jesús” (Ef 2:6-7). Somos tan pequeños y nos encerramos en nosotros mismos. Dios es tan grandioso y bondadoso con Su amor. ¿Cómo puede el océano del gran amor de Dios ser derramado dentro nuestro pequeño dedal de egoísmo? “Ustedes abran su corazón” (2 Co 6:13).

Oración: Padre, perdóname porque he sido demasiado egocéntrico para recibir Tu amor.

Yo me arrepiento. Haz todo lo que quieras para ampliar mi corazón.

Promesa: “Si alguno de ustedes pertenece a ese pueblo, ¡que el Señor, su Dios, ¡lo acompañe y que suba...!” (2 Cr 36:23)

Alabanza: “¡Den gracias al Señor, porque es bueno, porque es eterno Su amor!” (Sal 106:1)

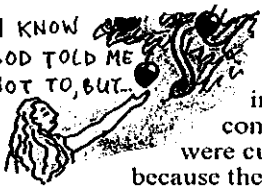

2. Every day look at a crucifix (a cross with Jesus on it.) Think about how much Jesus loves us. How much do we love Him back?



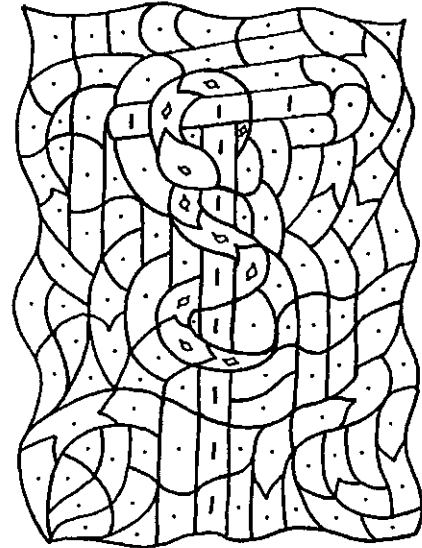
