Solemnity of Pentecost ***May 28, 2023***

Dear Parishioners,
 Happy and Blessed Birthday! Yes, in a sense today is **your** Birthday because **Pentecost is the day the Catholic Church was born.** *"On the day of Pentecost when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested, given, and communicated as a divine person: of His fullness, Christ, the Lord, pours out the Spirit in abundance. On that day, the Holy Trinity is fully revealed. Since that day, the Kingdom announced by Christ has been open to those who believe in Him: in the humility of the flesh and in faith, they already share in the communion of the Holy Trinity. By His coming, which never ceases, the Holy Spirit causes the world to enter into the 'last days', the time of the Church, the Kingdom already inherited though not yet consummated"* (Catechism of the Catholic Church #'s 731-732). In the Sacrament of Baptism, we were baptized in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and **of the Holy Spirit**, receiving the Seven Gifts of the **Holy Spirit**: wisdom, knowledge, counsel, understanding, fear of the Lord, fortitude, and piety. In the Sacrament of Confirmation, these same Gifts of the **Holy Spirit** were strengthened within us. As the Body of Christ with Jesus as our Head, let us continue to use these Gifts of the **Holy Spirit**. Let us continue to grow in our personal relationship with the Lord through daily prayer and reception of the Sacraments, especially with Holy Communion and Confession. Let us use these Gifts of the **Holy Spirit** to help one another on the way to salvation as well. God bless, and Happy Birthday!

MOUTH-TO-MOUTH

Jesus “breathed on them.” —John 20:22

In the beginning, “the Lord God formed man out of the clay of the ground and blew into his nostrils the breath of life, and so man became a living being” (Gn 2:7). The breath of the Father gives life where previously there was no life.

On His Resurrection evening, Jesus “breathed on” His disciples “and said: ‘Receive the Holy Spirit’ ” (Jn 20:22). The breath of Jesus brought the Holy Spirit and peace where previously there had been turmoil and fear.

On the day of Pentecost, “suddenly from up in the sky there came a noise like a strong, driving wind which was heard all through the house where they were seated. Tongues as of fire appeared, which parted and came to rest on each of them. All were filled with the Holy Spirit. They began to express themselves in foreign tongues and make bold proclamation as the Spirit prompted them” (Acts 2:2-4).

The breath of the Holy Spirit brings every good thing (see Jas 1:17). First the Spirit breathes on us, then He breathes through us. God’s words are given to us and spoken through us in the spiritual gifts such as teaching, evangelization, tongues, prophecy. etc. His breath brings life, peace, forgiveness, boldness, miraculous unity, and worldwide renewal (see Ps 104:30). The Spirit is breathing out. We just have to breathe in. It’s Pentecost! Take a deep breath and “receive the Holy Spirit” (Jn 20:22).

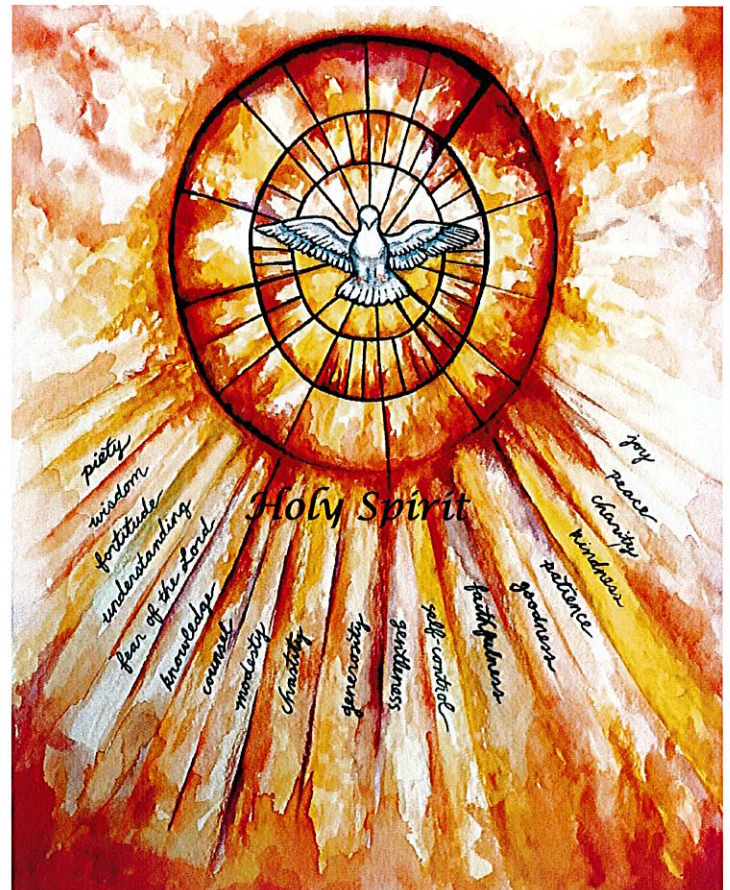
Prayer: Holy Spirit, You are Lord of my life (2 Cor 3:17-18). Do whatever You will with me. I love You.

Promise: To each person the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.” —1 Cor 12:7

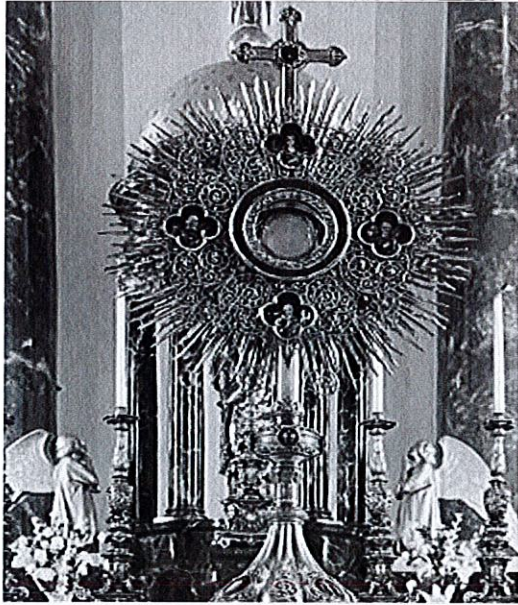
Praise: Praise Jesus, Who died, rose, and ascended so that we could be filled with the Holy Spirit!

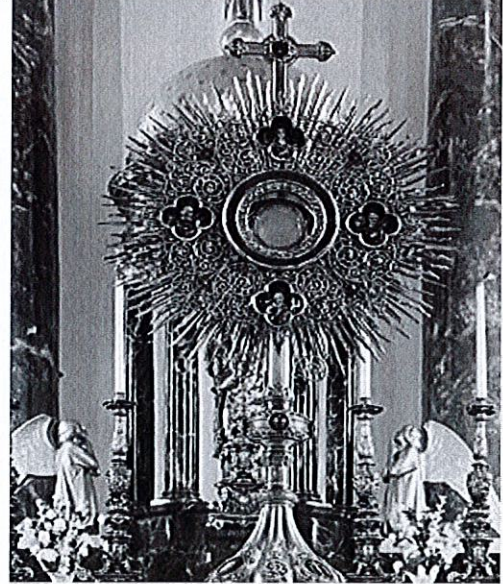
Eucharistic Adoration

Queridos feligreses,
 Feliz y bendito cumpleaños! Sí, en cierto sentido, hoy es su cumpleaños porque **Pentecostés es el día en que nació la Iglesia Católica.** *"En el día de Pentecostés, cuando las siete semanas de la Pascua habían llegado a su fin, la Pascua de Cristo se cumplió en el derramamiento del Espíritu Santo, se manifestó, se dio y se comunicó como una persona divina: de Su plenitud, Cristo, el Señor, derrama el Espíritu en abundancia. En ese día, la Santísima Trinidad se revela plenamente. Desde ese día, el Reino anunciado por Cristo ha estado abierto a aquellos que creen en Él: en la humildad de la carne y en la fe, ya participan en la comunión de la Santísima Trinidad. Por Su venida, que nunca cesa, el Espíritu Santo hace que el mundo entre en los 'últimos días', el tiempo de la Iglesia, el Reino ya heredado, aunque todavía no se ha consumado"* (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica #’s 731-732). En el Sacramento del Bautismo, fuimos bautizados en el Nombre del Padre, y del Hijo y del **Espíritu Santo**, recibiendo los Siete Dones del **Espíritu Santo**: sabiduría, conocimiento, consejo, entendimiento, temor del Señor, fortaleza, y piedad. En el Sacramento de la Confirmación, estos mismos dones del **Espíritu Santo** se fortalecieron dentro de nosotros. Como el Cuerpo de Cristo con Jesús como nuestra Cabeza, continuemos usando estos Dones del **Espíritu Santo**. Sigamos creciendo en nuestra relación personal con el Señor a través de la oración diaria y la recepción de los Sacramentos, especialmente con la Sagrada Comunión y la Confesión.

Usemos estos dones del **Espíritu Santo** para ayudarnos unos a otros también en el camino de la salvación. Dios les bendiga, y feliz cumpleaños!

BOCA A BOCA

Jesús “sopló sobre ellos” (Juan 20:22).

Al principio, “el Señor Dios modeló al hombre con arcilla del suelo y sopló en su nariz un aliento de vida. Así el hombre se convirtió en un ser viviente” (Gn 2:7). El soplo del Padre da vida donde antes no había vida.

En la tarde de Su Resurrección, Jesús “sopló sobre” Sus discípulos y dijo: “Reciban al Espíritu Santo” (Jn 20:22). El soplo de Jesús trajo el Espíritu Santo y la paz donde antes había confusión y miedo.

En el día de Pentecostés, “de pronto, vino del cielo un ruido, semejante a una ráfaga de viento, que resonó en toda la casa donde se encontraban. Entonces vieron aparecer unas lenguas como de fuego, que descendieron por separado sobre cada uno de ellos. Todos quedaron llenos del Espíritu Santo, y comenzaron a hablar en distintas lenguas, según el Espíritu les permitía expresarse” (Hch 2:2-4).

El soplo del Espíritu Santo trae todo bien (ver Stg 1:17). Primero el Espíritu sopla sobre nosotros, luego sopla por medio de nosotros. Las palabras de Dios nos son dadas y habladas a través de nosotros en los dones espirituales tales como enseñanza, evangelización, lenguas, profecía. Su aliento trae vida, paz, perdón, audacia, unidad milagrosa y renovación mundial (ver Sal 104:30). El Espíritu está exhalando. Solo tenemos

que respirar. ¡Es Pentecostés! Respira hondo y “reciban el Espíritu Santo” (Jn 20:22).

Oración: Espíritu Santo, Tú eres mi libertad (2 Co 3:17-18). Haz lo que quieras conmigo. Te quiero.

Promesa: “En cada uno, el Espíritu se manifiesta para el bien común” (1 Co 12:7).

Alabanza: ¡Alabado sea Jesús, Quien murió, resucitó y ascendió para que fuéramos llenos del Espíritu Santo!

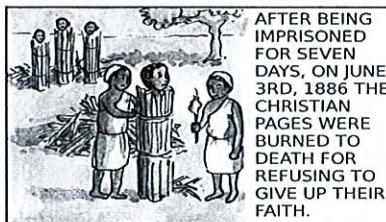
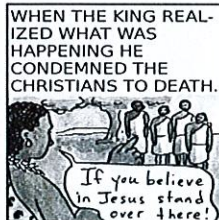
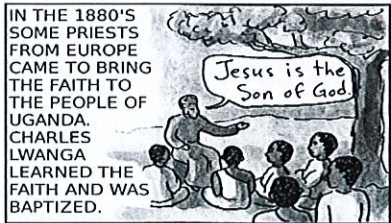


Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit as it was in the beginning, is now and will be forever! Amen.

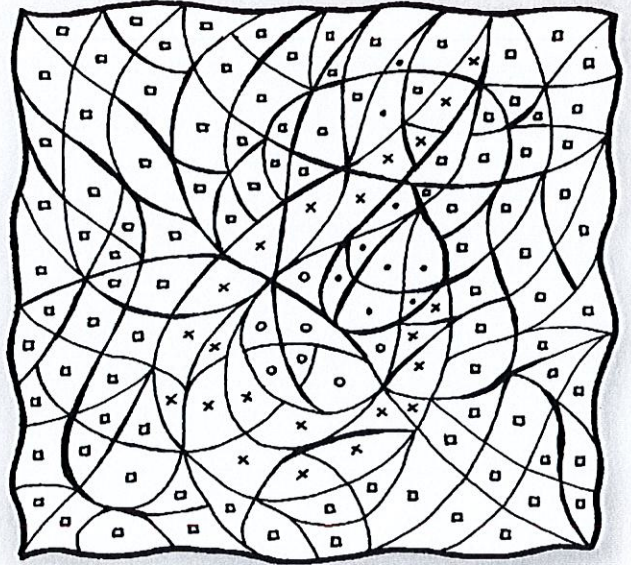
