Dear Parishioners,

This month of October is designated in the Catholic Church as "**Respect Life Month**". We respect ALL human life from the moment of conception till natural death. As our Holy Father Pope Francis has said, challenging each one of us: *"We are called to defend and safeguard human life, especially in the mother's womb, in infancy, old age and physical or mental disability."* Respect for life begins in the womb where God has fashioned each one of us in His Own Image and Likeness. At the same time, we must remember that at the core of the Gospel of Life is **the Sacrament of Matrimony**: *"therefore a man leaves his father and his mother and cleaves to his wife, and they become one flesh"* (Gen 2:24). Marriage, between one man and one woman, is a BIG part of God's Plan. In fact, the devil first appears in the Sacred Scriptures by trying to separate the first Marriage between Adam and Eve. He tricks Eve into eating the forbidden fruit. Eve then gives some of the fruit to her husband to eat, which he gladly accepts. The Lord asks them what happened, and why they had disobeyed Him, to which Adam blames his wife, who in turn blames the devil. The devil was right in the middle of that original sin, trying to cause division between husband and wife, and even more so, between the Lord and His people. My brothers and sisters, we live in a time where Marriage is being attacked aggressively by the devil. Many in our society, including many Catholics, are confused about God's very definition of Marriage, which is ONLY between one man and one woman. As Christians who believe in God, we are ostracized and persecuted for upholding this Divine teaching. Another attack by the devil on Marriage has to do with many couples who are cohabiting, living in unions that are not Sacramental. If there are any couples that are currently in this situation, PLEASE come and see me, so that we can work on getting your "marriage" blessed by God in the church. A civil "marriage" is just that - "civil". To be able to receive Jesus in His Body and Blood at Mass, you want to make sure that you are living without serious sin in your life. Each one of us must strive for holiness every day, preparing ourselves for the Wedding Feast of Heaven, where our Divine Spouse Jesus is waiting to be united with each one of us. God bless!

DOMINGO 28 DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO OCTUBRE 10, 2021

Queridos feligreses,

Este mes de Octubre está designado en la Iglesia Católica como "Mes del Respeto a la Vida". Respetamos TODA la vida humana desde el momento de la concepción hasta la muerte natural. Como ha dicho nuestro Santo Padre el Papa Francisco, desafiándonos a cada uno de nosotros: *"Estamos llamados a defender y salvaguardar la vida humana, especialmente en el vientre de la madre, en la infancia, la vejez y la discapacidad física o mental"*. El respeto por la vida comienza en el seno materno donde Dios nos ha formado a cada uno a su imagen y semejanza. Al mismo tiempo, debemos recordar que en el centro del Evangelio de la vida está el **Sacramento del Matrimonio**: *"por tanto, el hombre se va su padre y su madre, y se une a su mujer, y son una sola carne"* (Gen 2:24). El matrimonio, entre un hombre y una mujer, es una parte GRANDE del Plan de Dios. De hecho, el diablo aparece por primera vez en el Sagradas Escrituras al tratar de separar el primer matrimonio entre Adán y Eva. Engaña a Eva para que coma la fruta prohibida. Eva luego le da algo de la fruta a su esposo para que la coma, que él acepta con gusto. El Señor les pregunta qué sucedió y por qué lo habían desobedecido, a lo que Adán culpa a su esposa, quien a su vez culpa al diablo. El diablo estaba justo en medio de ese pecado original, tratando de causar división entre esposo y esposa, y más aún, entre el Señor y Su Mis hermanos y hermanas, vivimos en una época en la que el matrimonio se ataca. atacado agresivamente por el diablo. Muchos en nuestra sociedad, incluidos muchos católicos, están confundidos acerca de la definición misma de matrimonio de Dios, que es SÓLO entre un hombre y una mujer. Como cristianos que creemos en Dios, somos condenados al ostracismo y perseguidos por defender esta enseñanza divina. Otro ataque del diablo al matrimonio tiene que ver con muchas parejas que conviven, que viven en uniones que no son sacramentales. Si hay parejas que se encuentran actualmente en esta situación, POR FAVOR vengan a verme, para que podamos trabajar para que su "matrimonio" sea bendecido por Dios en la iglesia. Un "matrimonio" civil es solo eso - "civil". Para poder recibir a Jesús en Su Cuerpo y Sangre en la Misa, debes asegurarte de que estás viviendo sin pecados graves en tu vida. Cada uno de nosotros debe luchar por la santidad todos los días, preparándonos para la Fiesta de las Bodas del Cielo, donde nuestro Divino Esposo Jesús espera para unirse con cada uno de nosotros.

MARK 10:27

LOVING GOD IS NOT ENOUGH

“Jesus looked at him with love and told him, ‘There is one thing more you must do.’ ” —Mark 10:21

The Lord’s will is not only that we love Him but that we love Him with all our hearts, all our souls, all our strength, and all our minds (Lk 10:27). It is relatively easy to give ninety-five percent, even ninety-eight percent, of our lives to the Lord. However, the great decision and the fiercest battle is about giving that last percent or two of our lives to God. That last percent is our all, the “one thing” more we must do (Mk 10:21). Your one thing more may be to “sell what you have and give to the poor” (Mk 10:21). Other examples of “one thing more” are:

- *forgiving (Eph 4:32),
 - *loving an enemy (Mt 5:44),
 - *admitting an addiction and taking it to the Lord,
 - *repenting and going to Confession,
 - deciding to stop contracepting,
 - *starting to evangelize,
 - *tithing,
 - *serving and washing the feet of others (Jn 13:5),
 - *saying “yes” to a particular vocation, and
 - *entering into Christian community.
- *At this moment, Jesus is looking at you with love.
*Give Him the “one thing more.” Give Him all your love.

Prayer: Father, I am all Yours.

Promise: “Indeed, God’s word is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword.” — Heb 4:12

Praise: “Tell me, if Christ is preached as raised from the dead, how is it that some of you say there is no resurrection of the dead?” (1 Cor 15:12) Risen Jesus, illuminate my mind! Presentation Ministries

AMAR A DIOS NO ES SUFICIENTE

“Jesús lo miró con amor y le dijo, ‘Solo te falta una cosa’ ” (Marcos 10:21).

La voluntad del Señor no es solo que lo amemos, sino que lo amemos con todo nuestro corazón, con toda nuestra alma, con todas nuestras fuerzas y con toda nuestra mente (Lc 10:27). Es relativamente fácil dar el noventa y cinco por ciento, incluso el noventa y ocho por ciento de nuestras vidas al Señor. Sin embargo, la gran decisión y la batalla más feroz se trata de entregar ese último por ciento o dos de nuestras vidas a Dios. Ese último porcentaje es nuestro todo, la “única cosa” que debemos hacer (Mc 10:21).

Tu única cosa puede ser “vende lo que tienes y dalo a los pobres” (Mc 10:21). Otros ejemplos de “una cosa más” son:

- perdonar (Ef 4:32),
- amar al enemigo (Mt 5:44),
- admitir una adicción y llevársela al Señor,
- arrepentirse e ir a la Confesión,
- decidir dejar de usar anticonceptivos,
- comenzar a evangelizar,
- dar el diezmo,
- servir y lavar los pies de los demás (Jn 13:5),
- decir “sí” a una vocación en particular, y entrar en comunidad cristiana.

En este momento, Jesús te mira con amor. Dale “una cosa más”. Dale todo tu amor.

Oración: Padre, soy todo Tuyo.

Promesa: “Porque la Palabra de Dios es viva y eficaz, y más cortante que cualquier espada de doble filo” (Heb 4:12).

Alabanza: “Si se anuncia que Cristo resucitó de entre los muertos, ¿cómo algunos de ustedes afirman que los muertos no resucitan?” (1 Co 15:12) ¡Jesús resucitado, ilumina mi mente!

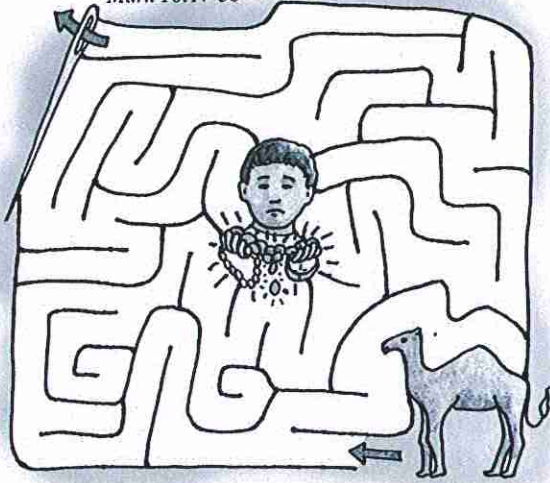

God calls some people to give up all their things so they can live a special life for Him, like religious brothers and sisters.



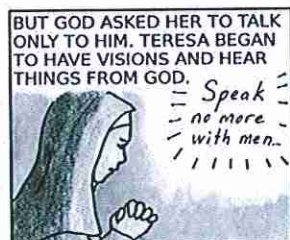
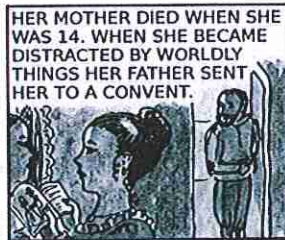
But God also wants people who are rich to use their money and things for Him- to help the poor and the Church.

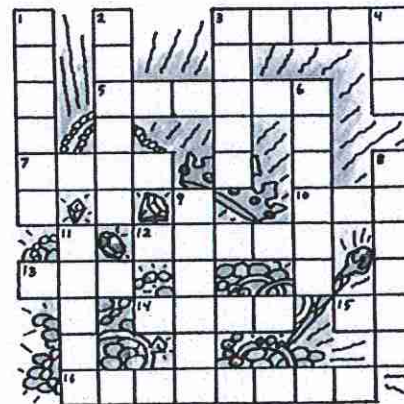

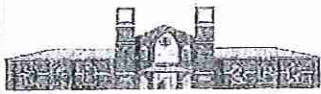


Wisdom Cross- Word Puzzle
