THE MOST HOLY TRINITY ***JUNE 12, 2022***

Dear Parishioners,

"In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit". We begin and end the Mass with these words. We were baptized with these words. We receive the absolution for the forgiveness of our sins from the priest in the Sacrament of Confession with these words. We begin and end all of our prayers with these words: *What do these words mean?* They are the confession of our faith in the **Holy Trinity** - the three Divine Persons of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit ("Tri-"), united together as One God ("Unity"). We celebrate this beautiful mystery of our Catholic Faith this weekend with the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**. It is a mystery that we can sometimes take for granted. When I was at St. Joseph Seminary in Yonkers, NY, I had a class taught by a wonderful religious sister. One of the many important things that I learned from that class was something that she mentioned about making the sign of the cross. She said that every time we make the sign of the cross, we should say to ourselves the following: "In the Name of the Father - *who created me in love*, and of the Son - *who redeemed me in love*, and of the Holy Spirit - *who sanctifies me in love*". Adding these little phrases quietly to ourselves every time we make the sign of the cross, helps us not only appreciate more this sign of our Faith, but also helps us understand this Divine Mystery better. The Most Holy Trinity is all about love, about sacrificial love in which the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit are constantly loving one another selflessly, as well as pouring their love upon each one of us. In return, we are called to love the Most Holy Trinity back in the same way, "with all our heart and all our soul, and all our mind", as well as love our neighbor as ourselves (*Matthew 22:35-40*). As we celebrate this great feast this weekend, let us commit ourselves to love. God Bless!

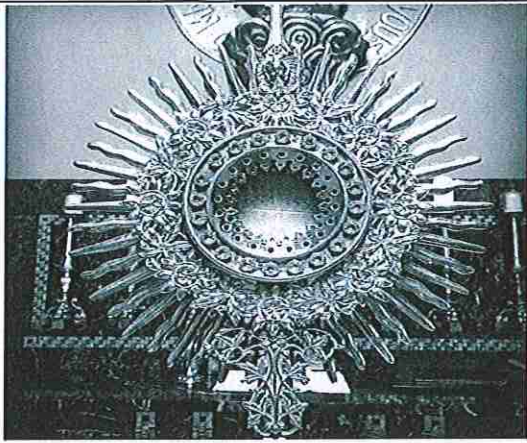

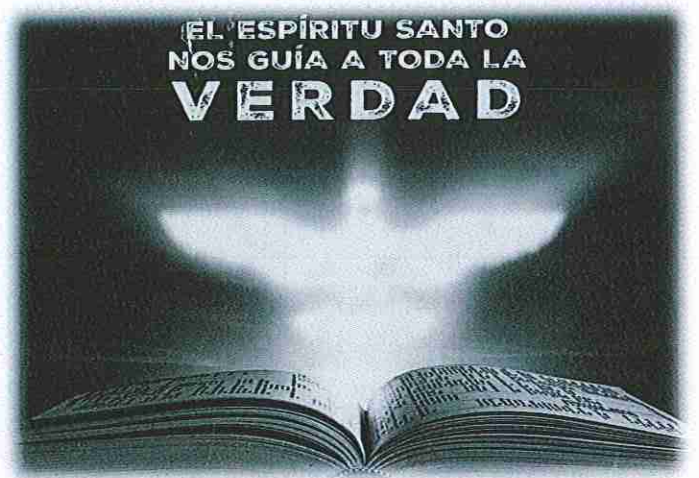

LOVE TIMES THREE

“When He established the heavens, I was there.” – Proverbs 8:27 Where is the word Trinity in the Bible? You won’t find it! The Trinity is a mystery revealed by God and handed on to us through Sacred Tradition (see Catechism of the Catholic Church, 78, 234). Jesus provides trinitarian clues in the Bible. “If you love Me and obey the commands I give you, I will ask the Father and He will give you another Paraclete — to be with you always: the Spirit of truth, Whom the world cannot accept, since it neither sees Him nor recognizes Him; but you can recognize Him, because He remains with you and will be within you” (Jn 14:15-17). God is one essence in three Persons. The greatest minds in the history of the Church have wrestled with understanding the Trinity. We’ll never be able to fully grasp this divine truth. But as beloved children of the Father (1 Jn 3:2), our starting point is trust. Let the Lord speak to your heart; focus on the relationships. God is eternal community. Love best illuminates the nature of the Trinity (see 1 Jn 4:8, 16). God the Father chose us (Eph 1:4). Jesus, our older Brother, leads us (Heb 2:10-11). The Holy Spirit resides within us (1 Cor 6:19). Grow strong through prayer in the Holy Spirit, persevere in God’s love, and welcome the mercy of Jesus (see Jude 20-21). Immerse yourself in the Trinitarian love of God.

Prayer: Father, on this Trinity Sunday, I will pray the Glorious Mysteries of the Rosary.

Promise: “All that the Father has belongs to Me.” —Jn 16:15

Praise: “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all!” (2 Cor 13:13)

TRES VECES AMOR

“Cuando Él afianzaba el cielo, yo estaba ahí” (Proverbios 8:27). ¿Dónde está la palabra Trinidad en la Biblia? ¡No, la encontrarás! La Trinidad es un misterio revelado por Dios y entregado a nosotros por medio de la Sagrada Tradición (ver Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 78, 234). Jesús proporciona pistas trinitarias en la Biblia. “Si ustedes me aman, cumplirán Mis mandamientos. Y Yo rogaré al Padre y Él les dará otro Paráclito, para que esté siempre con ustedes: el Espíritu de la Verdad, a quien el mundo no puede recibir, porque no lo ve ni lo conoce. Ustedes, en cambio, lo conocen, porque Él permanece con ustedes y estará en ustedes” (Jn 14:15-17). Dios es una esencia en tres Personas. Las mentes más grandes de la historia de la Iglesia han luchado por comprender la Trinidad. Nunca seremos capaces de comprender completamente esta verdad divina. Pero como hijos amados del Padre (1 Jn 3:2), nuestro punto de partida es la confianza. Deja que el Señor hable a tu corazón; céntrate en las relaciones. Dios es comunidad eterna. El amor ilumina mejor la naturaleza de la Trinidad (ver 1 Jn 4:8, 16). Dios Padre nos eligió (Ef 1:4). Jesús, nuestro hermano mayor, nos guía (Heb 2:10-11). El Espíritu Santo reside dentro de nosotros (1 Co 6:19). Crece fuerte por la oración en el Espíritu Santo, persevera en el amor de Dios y recibe la misericordia de Jesús (ver Jud 20-21). Sumérgete en el amor trinitario de Dios.

Oración: Padre, en este domingo de la Trinidad, rezaré los Misterios Gloriosos del Rosario.

Promesa: “Todo lo que es del Padre es Mío” (Jn 16:15).

Alabanza: “La gracia del Señor Jesucristo, el amor de Dios, y la comunión del Espíritu Santo permanezcan con todos ustedes” (2 Co 13:13)

SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD JUNIO 12, 2022

Queridos feligreses,

"En el Nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo". Comenzamos y terminamos la Misa con estas palabras. Fuimos bautizados con estas palabras. Recibimos la absolución para el perdón de nuestros pecados del sacerdote en el Sacramento de la Confesión con estas palabras. Comenzamos y terminamos todas nuestras oraciones con estas palabras. ¿Qué significan estas palabras? Son la confesión de nuestra fe en la **Santísima Trinidad**: las tres Personas Divinas del Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo ("Tri-"), unidas como Un Dios ("Unidad"). Celebramos este hermoso misterio de nuestra Fe Católica este fin de semana con la **Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad**. Es un misterio que a veces podemos dar por sentado. Cuando estaba en el Seminario St. Joseph en Yonkers, NY, tuve una clase impartida por una hermana religiosa maravillosa. Una de las muchas cosas importantes que aprendí de esa clase fue algo que ella mencionó acerca de hacer la señal de la cruz. Ella dijo que cada vez que hacemos la señal de la cruz, debemos decirnos a nosotros mismos lo siguiente: "En el Nombre del Padre, que me creó en el amor, y del Hijo, que me redimió en el amor, y del Santo Espíritu, que me santificas en el amor". Agregar estas pequeñas frases en voz baja para nosotros mismos cada vez que hacemos la señal de la cruz, nos ayuda no solo a apreciar más esta señal de nuestra Fe, sino que también nos ayuda a comprender mejor este Misterio Divino. La Santísima Trinidad tiene que ver con el amor, con el amor sacrificial en el que el Padre y el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo se aman constantemente, desinteresadamente, y derraman su amor sobre cada uno de nosotros. A cambio, estamos llamados a amar a la Santísima Trinidad de la misma manera, "con todo nuestro corazón y con toda nuestra alma y con toda nuestra mente", así como a amar a nuestro prójimo como a nosotros mismos (Mateo 22:35-40). Mientras celebramos esta gran fiesta este fin de semana, comprometámonos con el amor. ¡Dios les bendiga!

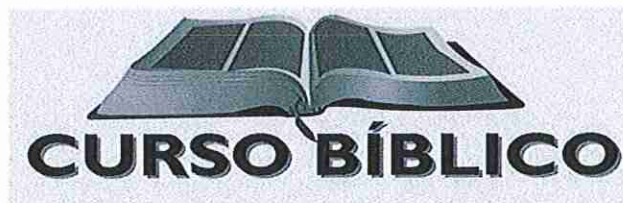

Today we celebrate the feast day of the Blessed Trinity. The word Trinity is a title for God that tells us that He is three Persons in one God.

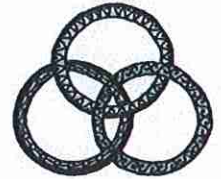

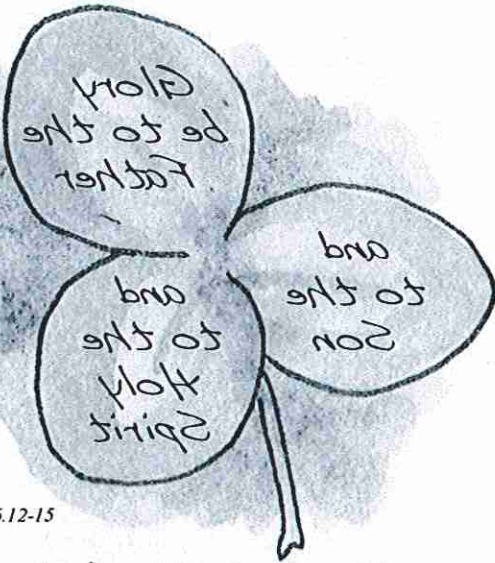
